YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Hartford Yard Goats, 2-1, in ten innings. Manny Melendez brought in the go-ahead run in the tenth on a fielder's choice that scored Brian Serven. Richmond scored first in the first inning on a sac fly by **Zach Houchins**. The Flying Squirrels loaded the bases with no outs that inning but only scored the one run. In the fifth, Hartford tied the score with a pinch-hit RBI single by Arvinct Perez. **Caleb Baragar** allowed one run with seven strikeouts over 6.1 innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a three-game road series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. This series is final road series before the All-Star Break. On the year, the Flying Squirrels are 10-11 in series openers and 6-5 in road series openers. This series is Richmond's first trip to FNB Field this season. The Flying Squirrels play back-to-back road sets on City Island, returning to Harrisburg for a four-game series from July 11-14 after the All-Star Break. In the only previous meetings between the two teams prior to this series, the Senators won two of three at The Diamond from June 11-13, with the Flying Squirrels' lone win coming in avoiding a no-hitter with a walk-off single by **Jalen Miller** in the 10th on June 12. The Flying Squirrels are 17-31 in games following a loss this season.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 7-4 in the last 11 games after losing nine of the previous ten games from June 8-19. Richmond won the final four games of the last road trip, their longest winning streak of the year, and swept Binghamton in three games to finish the trip, their first series sweep of the season. Over the last 11 games, the Flying Squirrels have hit .217 (77-for-355) and the pitching staff has combined for a 2.32 ERA (26 ER/101.0 IP). Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .221 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.64 team ERA, which is ninth in the circuit. Richmond's -70 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Portland at -46).

THE SENATORS have gone 3-9 in their last 12 games since June 18 and have lost five of six since June 25. Harrisburg has lost five consecutive series since winning two of three in Richmond from June 11-13. The Senators clinched the Western Division First-Half title on June 12 in Richmond to lock up a spot in the Eastern League playoffs. The Senators opened the season with a 21-4 record through the end of April, their best start in franchise history. Harrisburg ranks sixth in the league with a .239 team batting average and third with a 3.32 team ERA. The Harrisburg roster includes six of MLB.com's top-30 National prospects, including Luis Garcia (2, 61 Top 100), Will Crowe (4), Sterling Sharp (8 - on IL), Tres Barrera (19), Taylor Guilbeau (22) and Jackson Tetreault (25). The Senators landed five players in the upcoming Eastern League All-Star Game: Pitchers Ben Braymer and Aaron Barrett, catcher Tres Barrera, infielder Ian Sagdal and outfielder Rhett Wiseman.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Brandon Beachy** makes his eighth start of the season for the Flying Squirrels and his ninth overall appearance. Last time out, Beachy allowed two runs over 5.0 innings against Altoona on Wednesday to pick up his second straight win. Beachy made his MLB debut with the Atlanta Braves in 2010 and spent three seasons in the Majors with them, totaling 46 starts with a 14-11 record and 3.23 ERA. His best season came in 2012, when he went 5-5 with a 2.00 ERA over 13 starts, posting the best ERA in the majors until his season ended with an elbow injury, requiring Tommy John surgery. He returned in 2013 but had to undergo Tommy John surgery again prior to the 2014 season. Beachy signed with the Dodgers in 2015 and briefly returned to the majors that year. He was held to one appearance in 2016 and did not pitch at all in 2017. Last year, he made 12 appearances for the independent New Britain Bees, going 0-1 with a 3.55 ERA in 12 appearances (two starts). **For more on Beachy, see page two.**

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander **Mario Sanchez** makes his ninth start and 13th overall appearance for the Senators this season. In his last start, he pitched 5.0 innings and allowed three runs in a no-decision against Akron on Wednesday. He began the season splitting between starting and relieving, going 3-0 with a 1.04 ERA through May 1. He was promoted to Triple-A Fresno and went 0-2 with an 11.85 ERA in four games (three starts). He returned to Harrisburg on May 29 and has gone 2-1 with a 4.50 ERA (17 ER/34.0 IP) in six starts.

JUNE WRAP: The Flying Squirrels went 12-17 in the month of June. The pitching staff combined for a 3.05 ERA, tied for third in the league, and had the third-most strikeouts with 244. The Richmond offense hit .203 in the month, last in the league, ranked second with 102 walks and led the circuit with 37 stolen bases. **Zach Houchins** ranked third in the league in total bases (51), tied for third in homers (5), tied for fourth in RBIs (17), **Jacob Heyward** ranked tied for second with 17 walks. **Johneshwy Fargas** led the league with 21 steals. **Garrett Williams** was second in the league with a 1.67 ERA. **Melvin Adon** was tied for fifth with four saves. **Caleb Baragar** ranked tied for fifth with 34.1 IP. Baragar and Williams were tied for second with 35 strikeouts. Williams had the best BAA (.152) and Baragar was second (.174).

SHINING STARTS: Six members of the Flying Squirrels have been selected to represent Richmond in the Eastern League All-Star Game at The Diamond on Wednesday, July 10: RHP **Melvin Adon**, LHP **Caleb Baragar**, 3B **Jonah Arenado**, 1B **Zach Houchins**, 2B **Jalen Miller** and OF **Jacob Heyward**. Six All-Stars ties the most in franchise history and is the most of any team in the Eastern League this season. Richmond's coaching staff, led by manager **Willie Harris**, will be the staff for the Western Division All-Stars in the Eastern League All-Star Game.

A LITTLE RELIEF: Over the last 20 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 1.99 ERA (16 ER/72.1 IP). On the season, Richmond's 3.82 bullpen ERA is the second-highest in the league. Since May 5, **Ryan Halstead** has gone 1-2 with a 1.14 ERA (3 ER/23.2 IP). In his last 14 outings since May 19, **Melvin Adon** has posted a 1.33 ERA (3 ER/201 IP) with nine walks and 27 strikeouts, and he has gone 7-for-8 in save attempts. **Chase Johnson** has a 0.60 ERA (1 ER/15.0 IP) in his last eight appearances since May 31. **Tyler Cyr** has a 1.58 ERA (2 ER/11.1 IP) in his last seven appearances since June 5.

STARTING OFF: The Richmond starting rotation has a 3.54 ERA this season, which is third in the league. **Caleb Baragar** is 2-1 with a 2.68 ERA (15 ER/50.1 IP) over his last nine starts since May 19. **Brandon Lawson** has gone 1-2 with a 3.41 ERA (13 ER/34.1 IP) in his last six starts since May 28. **Garrett Williams** is 1-1 with a 1.33 ERA (4 ER/27.0 IP) in his last four starts dating back to June 6. **Alfred Gutierrez** is 5-1 with a 3.13 ERA (13 ER/37.1 IP) in his last seven starts since May 26. **Brandon Beachy** is 2-0 with a 2.46 ERA (3 ER/11.0 IP) in his last two starts since June 21.

A LITTLE EXTRA: The Flying Squirrels have played 12 extra-inning games this season, tied for second-most in the league, and have a 3-9 record in extra-inning games on the year. In extras, the Richmond offense is batting .075 (3-for-40) with 16 strikeouts. Of the 15 extra innings played this season, the Flying Squirrels have failed to score in 10 of them.

TROUBLE AT HOME: Since May 22, the Flying Squirrels have gone 4-14 in the last 18 home games at The Diamond. In that same time frame, the Flying Squirrels have gone 11-9 in road games. Richmond had lost five consecutive home series dating back to May 16-19 prior to splitting a four-game set with Hartford last weekend. They also lost the previous four home series from April 18-May 8. The only home series win for the Flying Squirrels was the first one of the season, when they won three-of-four against Hartford from April 4-7.

THE NEW GUYS: On Tuesday, **Bryce Johnson** and **Peter Maris** were assigned to the Flying Squirrels from A-Adv. San Jose. After going 0-for-4 in his Double-A debut on Wednesday, Johnson has hit .533 (8-for-15) with a homer, a triple, a double and two RBIs in his last four games. Maris collected an RBI in three of his four games with the Flying Squirrels.

MILLER TIME: Eastern League All-Star **Jalen Miller** has hit .316 (6-for-19) over his last five games with a homer, a triple and three RBIs. He has knocked two homers in his last eight games and has nine on the season, which leads the team.

FARGAS ON FIRE: Over his last 11 games since June 20, **Johneshwy Fargas** has hit .355 (11-for-31) with a double, a triple and five RBIs. He went 4-for-4 on Friday, tied for the most hits in a game by a Flying Squirrels batter this season. He has added seven stolen bases over his last 11 games.

GRAND LARCENY: This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 80 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 33 steals this year, followed by **Jalen Miller** with 18. Over the last 22 games, the team has combined for 30 steals. The Flying Squirrels stole 37 bases in 29 games in the month of June. Fargas had 20 steals in his 28 games in June, the most in a single month in franchise history, and his season total of 34 is fourth-most in a single season in franchise history.

HITS FOR HOUCHINS: Over his last 31 games since May 29, **Zach Houchins** has hit .305 (36-for-118) with six homers, six doubles and 21 RBIs. He has multiple hits in four of his last nine games since June 21 and his 15 multi-hit games with Richmond are tied for first on the team. On June 10, Houchins was named Eastern League Player of the Week after hitting .423 with four homers and 12 RBIs from June 3-9. He began the season in the Angels organization with Double-A Mobile, but was released on May 8. In his first nine games with the Flying Squirrels, Houchins hit .097 (3-for-31).

FREQUENT FLYERS: In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 37 homers on the road (2nd in EL) in 37 games (1.00 per game - 2nd in EL). Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game). The Flying Squirrels have hit 13 home runs at home this season through 35 games (0.37 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features six of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), infielder **Ryan Howard** (24) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Six players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20), Howard (27), Miller (28) and **Jacob Heyward** (30).



- Attended Northwestern High School in Kokomo, Ind.
- Attended Indiana Wesleyan University, where he was a third baseman and a closer
- Originally signed by the Braves as a non-drafted free agent in 2008
- Made MLB debut with Atlanta on Sept. 20, 2010
- In 2011, led Braves staff and ranked second among MLB rookies with 169 strikeouts, the most by a Braves rookie in modern-era franchise history at the time and 10.74 K/9 IP was fourth all-time among rookie starting pitchers (min. 25 starts) in MLB history behind Kerry Wood (1998), Dwight Gooden (1984) and Hideo Nomo (1995)
- Made 13 MLB starts in 2012 and went 5-5 with a 2.00 ERA (T-1st in MLB at time) and .171 BAA (1st in MLB) before being placed on DL on 6/16, undergoing Tommy John surgery on 6/21
- Had second Tommy John surgery in March 2014
- Signed with Dodgers for 2015 and made two MLB starts
- Limited to one appearance in AZL in 2016 with elbow injury
- Made only 25 total appearances from 2014-2017
- Spent 2018 season with independent New Britain Bees of the Atlantic League and made 12 appearances (2 starts), going 0-1 with a 3.55 ERA in 12.2 IP
