YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Harrisburg Senators, 10-2. The Flying Squirrels started the game with three straight singles but failed to score. In the bottom of the first, Ian Sagdal hit a three-run homer with two out. Harrisburg scored two runs in the third, one in the fourth and four in the fifth to open a 10-0 lead. **Brandon Beachy** allowed a career-high nine runs. Richmond broke onto the scoreboard with a pair of solo home runs by **Jacob Heyward** and **Hamlet Marte** in the sixth. Relievers **Tyler Cyr** and **Raffi Vizcaino** each pitched 2.0 scoreless innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a three-game road series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. This series is final road series before the All-Star Break. This series is Richmond's first trip to FNB Field this season. The Flying Squirrels play back-to-back road sets on City Island, returning to Harrisburg for a four-game series from July 11-14 after the All-Star Break. In the only previous meetings between the two teams prior to this series, the Senators won two of three at The Diamond from June 11-13, with the Flying Squirrels' lone win coming in avoiding a no-hitter with a walk-off single by **Jalen Miller** in the 10th on June 12. The Flying Squirrels are 17-32 in games following a loss this season.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 7-5 in the last 12 games after losing nine of the previous ten games from June 8-19. Richmond won the final four games of the last road trip, their longest winning streak of the year, and swept Binghamton in three games to finish the trip, their first series sweep of the season. Over the last 12 games, the Flying Squirrels have hit .223 (87-for-390) and the pitching staff has combined for a 2.81 ERA (34 ER/109.0 IP). Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .222 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.70 team ERA, which is tenth in the circuit. Richmond's -78 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Portland at -40).

THE SENATORS have gone 4-9 in their last 13 games since June 18 and have lost five of seven since June 25. Harrisburg has lost five consecutive series since winning two of three in Richmond from June 11-13. The Senators clinched the Western Division First-Half title on June 12 in Richmond to lock up a spot in the Eastern League playoffs. The Senators opened the season with a 21-4 record through the end of April, their best start in franchise history. Harrisburg ranks tied for seventh in the league with a .238 team batting average and second with a 3.30 team ERA. The Harrisburg roster includes six of MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects, including Luis Garcia (2, 61 TP 100), Will Crowe (4), Sterling Sharp (8 - on IL), Tres Barrera (19), Taylor Guilbeau (22) and Jackson Tetreault (25). The Senators landed five players in the upcoming Eastern League All-Star Game: Pitchers Ben Braymer and Aaron Barrett, catcher Tres Barrera, infielder Ian Sagdal and outfielder Rhett Wiseman.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Brandon Lawson** makes his 12th start with the Flying Squirrels and his second against Harrisburg. In each of his last two starts at Trenton and against Hartford, Lawson has worked 6.0 innings and allowed three runs on seven hits. He faced the Senators on June 13 at The Diamond and pitched 7.0 scoreless innings in a no-decision, his longest outing of the year. Lawson was signed as a minor-league free agent by the Giants on April 23 after being released by the Tampa Bay Rays near the end of spring training. He was originally drafted by the Rays in the 12th round in 2016 out of the University of South Florida and reached Double-A for 14 outings (five starts) last season with the Montgomery Biscuits. **For more on Lawson, see page two.**

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Jackson Tetreault makes his 11th start of the season for the Senators and his second against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, Tetreault allowed three earned runs over 6.0 innings in a loss at Erie on Thursday. He faced Richmond on June 11 at The Diamond and worked 2.0 IP on 63 pitches, allowing two runs with five walks. Tetreault is ranked by MLB.com as the Nationals' No. 25 prospect. He was drafted by the Nationals in the seventh round in 2017.

SHINING STARTS: Six members of the Flying Squirrels have been selected to represent Richmond in the Eastern League All-Star Game at The Diamond on Wednesday, July 10: RHP **Melvin Adon**, LHP **Caleb Baragar**, 3B **Jonah Arenado**, 1B **Zach Houchins**, 2B **Jalen Miller** and OF **Jacob Heyward**. Six All-Stars ties the most in franchise history and is the most of any team in the Eastern League this season. Richmond's coaching staff, led by manager **Willie Harris**, will be the staff for the Western Division All-Stars in the Eastern League All-Star Game.

A LITTLE RELIEF: Over the last 21 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 1.87 ERA (16 ER/76.1 IP). On the season, Richmond's 3.77 bullpen ERA is the second-highest in the league. Since May 5, **Ryan Halstead** has gone 1-2 with a 1.14 ERA (3 ER/23.2 IP). In his last 14 outings since May 19, **Melvin Adon** has posted a 1.33 ERA (3 ER/20.1 IP) with nine walks and 27 strikeouts, and he has gone 7-for-8 in save attempts. **Chase Johnson** has a 0.60 ERA (1 ER/15.0 IP) in his last eight appearances since May 31. **Tyler Cyr** has a 1.35 ERA (2 ER/13.1 IP) in his last eight appearances since June 5.

STARTING OFF: The Richmond starting rotation has a 3.69 ERA this season, which is fourth in the league. **Caleb Baragar** is 2-1 with a 2.68 ERA (15 ER/50.1 IP) over his last nine starts since May 19. **Brandon Lawson** has gone 1-2 with a 3.41 ERA (13 ER/34.1 IP) in his last six starts since May 28. **Garrett Williams** is 1-1 with a 1.33 ERA (4 ER/27.0 IP) in his last four starts dating back to June 6. **Alfred Gutierrez** is 5-1 with a 3.13 ERA (13 ER/37.1 IP) in his last seven starts since May 26.

THE NEW GUYS: Last Tuesday, **Bryce Johnson** and **Peter Maris** were assigned to the Flying Squirrels from A-Adv. San Jose. After going 0-for-4 in his Double-A debut on Wednesday, Johnson has hit .500 (8-for-16) with a homer, a triple, a double and two RBIs in his last five games. Maris collected an RBI in three of his five games with the Flying Squirrels and is batting .333.

MILLER TIME: Eastern League All-Star **Jalen Miller** has hit .300 (6-for-20) over his last six games with a homer, a triple and three RBIs. He has knocked two homers in his last nine games and has nine on the season, which leads the team.

FARGAS ON FIRE: Over his last 12 games since June 20, **Johneshwy Fargas** has hit .344 (11-for-32) with a double, a triple and five RBIs. He went 4-for-4 on Friday, tied for the most hits in a game by a Flying Squirrels batter this season. He has added seven stolen bases over his last 12 games.

GRAND LARCENY: This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 80 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 34 steals this year, followed by **Jalen Miller** with 18. Over the last 23 games, the team has combined for 30 steals. The Flying Squirrels stole 37 bases in 29 games in the month of June. Fargas had 20 steals in his 28 games in June, the most in a single month in franchise history, and his season total of 34 is fourth-most in a single season in franchise history.

HITS FOR HOUCHINS: Over his last 32 games since May 29, **Zach Houchins** has hit .317 (39-for-123) with six homers, seven doubles and 21 RBIs. He has multiple hits in five of his last 10 games since June 21 and his 16 multi-hit games with Richmond which leads the team. On June 10, Houchins was named Eastern League Player of the Week after hitting .423 with four homers and 12 RBIs from June 3-9. He began the season in the Angels organization with Double-A Mobile, but was released on May 8. In his first nine games with the Flying Squirrels, Houchins hit .097 (3-for-31).

FREQUENT FLYERS: In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 39 homers on the road (2nd in EL) in 38 games (1.03 per game - 2nd in EL). Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game). The Flying Squirrels have hit 16 home runs at home this season through 42 games (0.38 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features six of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), infielder **Ryan Howard** (24) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Six players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20), Howard (27), Miller (28) and **Jacob Heyward** (30).
