YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels split a double-header with the Reading Fightin Phils. In Game 1, the Flying Squirrels pulled ahead, 3-0, with a two-out, bases-clearing triple by **Ryan Howard** in the bottom of the second inning. Reading chipped away with single runs in the third and sixth. **Garrett Williams** pitched 5.2 innings and allowed two runs with six strikeouts to pick up his third win. **Ryan Halstead** worked out of the sixth. **Raffi Vizcaino** worked around a walk in the seventh to pick up his second save in a 3-0 win. In Game 2, Reading broke a scoreless tie in the sixth inning with a two-run single by Luke Williams and added a third run on a single by Arquimedes Gamboa to pull ahead, 3-0. The Flying Squirrels were held to three hits in the shutout loss.

TODAY'S GAMES: The Flying Squirrels play the third of a four-game home series against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia. This series is final set before the All-Star Break. This is the fifth and final series between Richmond and Reading this season. The two teams split a rain-shortened, two-game set in Reading from April 13-14. Reading swept a three-game set at The Diamond from April 22-24. Reading won two of three in Richmond from May 21-23 and three of five at FirstEnergy Stadium from May 31-June 3.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost four of six after going 7-3 in the previous ten games from June 20-29. In the last series against the Senators, the Flying Squirrels were outscored 22-7. Over the last 16 games, the Flying Squirrels have hit .218 (110-for-504) and the pitching staff has combined for a 2.76 ERA (43 ER/140.0 IP). Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .221 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.65 team ERA, which is ninth in the circuit. Richmond's -87 run differential is last in the league (next closest is New Hampshire at -33).

THE FIGHTIN PHILS have won four of five games and eight of their last ten since June 27. Reading finished tied for first in the Eastern Division in the first half but lost out on the playoff spot to Trenton on a tiebreaker. The Fightin Phils lead the Eastern Division's second-half standings by two games over Portland. On the year, Reading's .230 team batting average is tenth in the league and their 3.36 ERA is third. Reading's roster includes eight of MLB.com's top-30 Phillies prospects, including Alec Bohm (1), Adonis Medina (2), JoJo Romero (7), Mickey Moniak (9), Arquimedes Gamboa (13), Mauricio Llovera (15), David Parkinson (21) and Cornelius Randolph (25). Reading landed four players in next week's Eastern League All-Star Game: Adonis Medina, Addison Russ, Darick Hall and Mickey Moniak.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Brandon Beachy** makes his ninth start of the season for the Flying Squirrels and his eighth overall appearance. In his most recent start on Monday at Harrisburg, Beachy allowed a career-high nine runs (eight earned) over 4.0 innings with a career-high five walks. He had won each of his previous two starts, combining for a 2.45 ERA (3 ER/11.0 IP). He has faced the Fightin Phils once this season, working four innings and allowing two runs on June 1 at FirstEnergy Stadium. Beachy made his MLB debut with the Atlanta Braves in 2010 and spent three seasons in the Majors with them, totaling 46 starts with a 14-11 record and 3.23 ERA. His best season came in 2012, when he went 5-5 with a 2.00 ERA over 13 starts, posting the best ERA in the majors until his season ended with an elbow injury, requiring Tommy John surgery. He returned in 2013 but had to undergo Tommy John surgery again prior to the 2014 season. Beachy signed with the Dodgers in 2015 and briefly returned to the majors that year. He was held to one appearance in 2016 and did not pitch at all in 2017. Last year, he made 12 appearances for the independent New Britain Bees, going 0-1 with a 3.55 ERA in 12 appearances (two starts). **For more on Beachy, see page two.**

FOR READING: Left-hander Bailey Falter makes his 14th start of the season for the Fightin Phils and his third against the Flying Squirrels. Falter last pitched on Sunday against Portland and tied a season-high eight strikeouts over 7.0 innings, his longest outing of the season, and allowed two runs. His first outing against Richmond came at The Diamond on April 24 and he allowed two unearned runs while issuing a season-high three walks in 4.0 innings, tied for his shortest start this year. He pitched at The Diamond again on May 23 worked six scoreless innings with eight strikeouts. On the year, Falter's 1.66 BB/9 IP ratio is the fourth-best in the league, and he's tied for the fewest walks issued among qualified EL pitchers with 13. Falter was drafted by the Phillies in the fifth round in 2015.

SHINING STARS: Seven members of the Flying Squirrels have been selected to represent Richmond in the Eastern League All-Star Game at The Diamond on Wednesday, July 10: RHP **Melvin Adon**, LHP **Caleb Baragar**, RHP **Tyler Cyr**, 3B **Jonah Arenado**, 1B **Zach Houchins**, 2B **Jalen Miller** and OF **Jacob Heyward**. Seven All-Stars is the most in franchise history and is the most of any team in the Eastern League this season. Richmond's coaching staff, led by manager **Willie Harris**, will be the staff for the Western Division All-Stars in the Eastern League All-Star Game.

A LITTLE RELIEF: Over the last 25 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 1.67 ERA (16 ER/86.1 IP). On the season, Richmond's 3.65 bullpen ERA is the second-highest in the league. Since May 5, **Ryan Halstead** has gone 1-2 with a 1.14 ERA (3 ER/23.2 IP). In his last 15 outings since May 19, **Melvin Adon** has posted a 1.21 ERA (3 ER/22.1 IP) with nine walks and 31 strikeouts, and he has gone 8-for-9 in save attempts. **Chase Johnson** has a 0.56 ERA (1 ER/16.0 IP) in his last nine appearances since May 31. **Tyler Cyr** has a 1.32 ERA (2 ER/13.2 IP) in his last nine appearances since June 5.

STARTING OFF: The Richmond starting rotation has a 3.70 ERA this season, which is third in the league. **Caleb Baragar** is 2-2 with a 2.89 ERA (18 ER/56.0 IP) over his last ten starts since May 19. **Brandon Lawson** has gone 1-3 with a 3.69 ERA (16 ER/39.0 IP) in his last seven starts since May 28. **Garrett Williams** is 2-1 with a 1.65 ERA (6 ER/32.2 IP) in his last five starts dating back to June 6. **Alfred Gutierrez** is 5-1 with a 3.13 ERA (13 ER/37.1 IP) in his last seven starts since May 26.

NICE START, BRYCE: Outfielder **Bryce Johnson** was promoted to the Flying Squirrels on June 25 from A-Adv. San Jose. After going 0-for-4 in his Double-A debut on June 26, Johnson collected seven hits over his next three days. Over his last nine games, Johnson is batting .379 (11-for-29) with three doubles, a triple, a homer and four RBIs. He is batting .333 overall since joining the Eastern League.

RETURN OF RYAN HOWARD: Shortstop **Ryan Howard** rejoined the Flying Squirrels on June 25 after playing 40 games with Triple-A Sacramento, where he batted .230 over 40 games. Howard went 0-for-18 in his first six games back with Richmond from June 23-June 29. Since then, he has compiled a six-game hitting streak dating back to June 30, during which he is batting .349 (8-for-23) with three doubles, a triple and four RBIs. He hit a bases-clearing, three-run triple in the first game of Friday's double-header, the Flying Squirrels' only three runs in a 3-2 victory over Reading.

GRAND LARCENY: This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 80 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 34 steals this year. **Jalen Miller** is tied for third with 18. The Flying Squirrels stole 37 bases in 29 games in the month of June. Fargas had 20 steals in his 28 games in June, the most in a single month in franchise history, and his season total of 34 is fourth-most in a single season in franchise history. In six games dating back to July 1, the Flying Squirrels have not stolen a base.

HITS FOR HOUCHINS: Over his last 36 games since May 29, **Zach Houchins** has hit .313 (42-for-146) with six homers, eight doubles and 22 RBIs. He has multiple hits in six of his last 14 games since June 21 and his 17 multi-hit games with Richmond which leads the team. He has four RBIs in his last eight games since June 27.

FREQUENT FLYERS: In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 39 homers on the road (2nd in EL) in 40 games (0.98 per game - 2nd in EL). Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game). The Flying Squirrels have hit 16 home runs at home this season through 44 games (0.36 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features six of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), infielder **Ryan Howard** (24) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Six players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20), Howard (27), Miller (28) and **Jacob Heyward** (30).
