YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels were held to three hits and lost, 5-0, to the Reading Fightin Phils. Richmond starter **Brandon Beachy** worked four scoreless innings before the Fightin Phils broke into the scoring with a bases-loaded walk by Darick Hall in the of the fifth. The next batter, Grenny Cumana, hit a grand slam to cap the five-run frame. Reading starter Bailey Falter pitched seven scoreless innings. Aaron Brown finished the shutout. Richmond relievers **Dillon McNamara**, **Chase Johnson** and **Caleb Simpson** combined for 4.1 scoreless innings of work.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a four-game home series against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia, leading into the All-Star break. This is the fifth and final series between Richmond and Reading this season. The two teams split a rain-shortened, two-game set in Reading from April 13-14. Reading swept a three-game set at The Diamond from April 22-24. Reading won two of three in Richmond from May 21-23 and three of five at FirstEnergy Stadium from May 31-June 3.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost five of seven after going 7-3 in the previous ten games from June 20-29. Over the last six games, the Flying Squirrels have been outscored 32-10 (22-7 by Harrisburg and 10-3 by Reading), and the Richmond offense has not scored a run in 20.1 straight innings. Over the last 17 games, the Flying Squirrels have hit .212 (113-for-532) and the pitching staff has combined for a 2.90 ERA (48 ER/149.0 IP). Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .220 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.67 team ERA, which is ninth in the circuit. Richmond's -92 run differential is last in the league (next closest is New Hampshire at -31).

THE FIGHTIN PHILS have won five of six games and nine of their last 11 since June 27. Reading finished tied for first in the Eastern Division in the first half but lost out on the playoff spot to Trenton on a tiebreaker. The Fightin Phils lead the Eastern Division's second-half standings by three games over Portland and Hartford. On the year, Reading's .229 team batting average is tenth in the league and their 3.32 ERA is third. Reading's roster includes eight of MLB.com's top-30 Phillies prospects, including Alec Bohm (1), Adonis Medina (2), JoJo Romero (7), Mickey Moniak (9), Arquimedes Gamboa (13), Mauricio Llovera (15), David Parkinson (21) and Cornelius Randolph (25). Reading landed five players in next week's Eastern League All-Star Game: Adonis Medina, Addison Russ, Darick Hall, Mickey Moniak and Grenny Cumana.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Brandon Lawson makes his 13th start with the Flying Squirrels and his third against Reading. He has allowed three earned runs in each of his last three starts since June 19. Last time out, Lawson worked 4.2 innings at Harrisburg and allowed 10 total runs, tied for second-most in a game in franchise history, in a loss. Lawson was signed as a minor-league free agent by the Giants on April 23 after being released by the Tampa Bay Rays near the end of spring training. He was originally drafted by the Rays in the 12th round in 2016 out of the University of South Florida and reached Double-A for 14 outings (five starts) last season with the Montgomery Biscuits. For more on Lawson, see page two.

FOR READING: Right-hander Seth McGarry makes his first start of the season and his third overall appearance for Reading. On the year, he has made 20 total appearances between Reading, A-Adv. Clearwater and Triple-A Lehigh Valley. McGarry is making his first start since August 26, 2015 with short-season West Virginia as a member of the Pirates organization, one of 12 starts he made in his first pro season. He moved into a relief role the following season. Last year, he made 45 appearances for Reading, going 2-4 with a 3.99 ERA.

**BLANK SPACE:** The Flying Squirrels have been shut out in back-to-back games for the second time this season. In the first game of a double-header on Friday, **Ryan Howard** hit a two-out, three-run triple for Richmond's only runs in a 3-2 win. Since then, the Flying Squirrels have gone 20.1 consecutive innings without scoring. The team is batting .158 (12-for-76) over the last three games.

SHINING STARS: Seven members of the Flying Squirrels have been selected to represent Richmond in the Eastern League All-Star Game at The Diamond on Wednesday, July 10: RHP Melvin Adon, LHP Caleb Baragar, RHP Tyler Cyr, 3B Jonah Arenado, 1B Zach Houchins, 2B Jalen Miller and OF Jacob Heyward. Seven All-Stars is the most in franchise history and is the most of any team in the Eastern League this season. Richmond's coaching staff, led by manager Willie Harris, will be the staff for the Western Division All-Stars in the Eastern League All-Star Game.

A LITTLE RELIEF: Over the last 26 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 1.59 ERA (16 ER/90.2 IP). On the season, Richmond's 3.60 bullpen ERA is the second-highest in the league. Since May 5, Ryan Halstead has gone 1-2 with a 1.14 ERA (3 ER/22.1 IP). In his last 15 outings since May 19, Melvin Adon has posted a 1.21 ERA (3 ER/22.1 IP) with nine walks and 31 strikeouts, and he has gone 8-for-9 in save attempts. Chase Johnson has a 0.50 ERA (1 ER/18.0 IP) in his last ten appearances since May 31. Tyler Cyr has a 1.32 ERA (2 ER/13.2 IP) in his last nine appearances since June 5. Dillon McNamara has a 1.59 ERA in his six appearances for the Flying Squirrels since joining the team on June 17. Carlos Navas has a 0.69 ERA (1 ER/13.0) overall with Richmond in seven outings. Frank Rubio has posted a 1.80 ERA (1 ER/5.0 IP) over his last four appearances since June 22. Raffi Vizcaino has not allowed an earned run in his last eight games since June 11, totaling 12.1 IP. Sam Moll has a 1.93 ERA (1 ER/4.2 IP) in his last six games since June 20. Caleb Simpson has worked five straight scoreless outings since June 18, totaling 5.2 innings.

STARTING OFF: The Richmond starting rotation has a 3.70 ERA this season, which is third in the league. Caleb Baragar is 2-2 with a 2.89 ERA (18 ER/56.0 IP) over his last ten starts since May 19. Brandon Lawson has gone 1-3 with a 3.69 ERA (16 ER/39.0 IP) in his last seven starts since May 28. Garrett Williams is 2-1 with a 1.65 ERA (6 ER/32.2 IP) in his last five starts dating back to June 6. Alfred Gutierrez is 5-1 with a 3.13 ERA (13 ER/37.1 IP) in his last seven starts since May 26.

**NICE START, BRYCE:** Outfielder **Bryce Johnson** was promoted to the Flying Squirrels on June 25 from A-Adv. San Jose. After going 0-for-4 in his Double-A debut on June 26, Johnson collected seven hits over his next three days. Over his last ten games, Johnson is batting .355 (11-for-31) with three doubles, a triple, a homer and four RBIs. He is batting .314 overall since joining the Eastern League.

**RETURN OF RYAN HOWARD:** Shortstop **Ryan Howard** rejoined the Flying Squirrels on June 25 after playing 40 games with Triple-A Sacramento, where he batted .230 over 40 games. Howard went 0-for-18 in his first six games back with Richmond from June 23-June 29. He followed with a six-game hitting streak from June 30-July 5, during which he hit .349 (8-for-23) with three doubles, a triple and four RBIs. He hit a bases-clearing, three-run triple in the first game of Friday's double-header, the Flying Squirrels' only three runs in a 3-2 victory over Reading.

**GRAND LARCENY:** This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 80 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 34 steals this year. **Jalen Miller** is tied for third with 18. The Flying Squirrels stole 37 bases in 29 games in the month of June. Fargas had 20 steals in his 28 games in June, the most in a single month in franchise history, and his season total of 34 is fourth-most in a single season in franchise history. In seven games dating back to July 1, the Flying Squirrels have not stolen a base.

HITS FOR HOUCHINS: Over his last 37 games since May 29, **Zach Houchins** has hit .309 (42-for-136) with six homers, eight doubles and 22 RBIs. He has multiple hits in six of his last 15 games since June 21 and his 17 multi-hit games with Richmond which leads the team. He has four RBIs in his last nine games since June 27.

FREQUENT FLYERS: In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 39 homers on the road (2nd in EL) in 40 games (0.98 per game - 2nd in EL). Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game). The Flying Squirrels have hit 16 home runs at home this season through 45 games (0.36 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels' roster features six of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), infielder **Ryan Howard** (24) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Six players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20), Howard (27), Miller (28) and **Jacob Heyward** (30).
