YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Senators, 6-3, for their fifth straight loss. In the first inning, **Peter Maris** hit an RBI double and **Gio Brusa** added an RBI single to put Richmond ahead, 2-0. In the bottom of the inning, **Dante Bichette Jr.** got the Senators on the board with a run-scoring groundout. Harrisburg tied the score on a throwing error in the third and moved ahead, 3-2, with an RBI single by **Nick Banks**. The Flying Squirrels tied the score at 3-3 in the sixth when **Brett Austin** reached on a throwing error attempting a sac bunt. In the seventh, Banks put Harrisburg back ahead with a triple and later scored on a wild pitch. He added his third RBI of the night with a single in the eighth to open a 6-3 lead. **Garrett Williams** tied a franchise record with six walks in the game, allowing three runs over 4.1 innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the third of a four-game road series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. It is also the third of a seven-game road trip to Harrisburg (0-2) and Hartford. Harrisburg has taken two of three in each of the two previous series between the two teams. The Flying Squirrels are currently riding their fourth losing streak of five or more games this year. A loss today would tie the longest losing streak of the season at six games, which has happened two previous times. In eight games against the Senators this year, the Flying Squirrels are batting .179 and have a 4.24 ERA. The Senators have a .256 average against Richmond and a 1.96 ERA on the season.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost eight of ten since June 30 after going 7-3 in the previous ten games from June 20-29. Over the last nine games, the Flying Squirrels have been outscored 49-16 (35.12 by Harrisburg and 14-4 by Reading). In the last ten games since June 30, Richmond batters have combined to hit .187 (.56-for-300) and scored 17 runs (1.7 per game). The pitching staff has combined to post a 4.33 ERA (40 ER/83.0 IP). Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .218 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.75 team ERA, which is tenth in the circuit. Richmond's -103 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Portland at -32).

THE SENATORS snapped a five-game losing streak with Thursday's win over the Flying Squirrels and have now won two straight. The Senators clinched the Western Division First-Half title on June 12 in Richmond to lock up a spot in the Eastern League playoffs. The Senators opened the season with a 21-4 record through the end of April, their best start in franchise history. Harrisburg has the fifth-best ERA in the league this year at 3.46. The Senators' offense is batting .241 for the year, which is tied for sixth in the league. The Harrisburg roster includes three of MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects, including Luis Garcia (2), Sterling Sharp (8 - on IL) and Tres Barrera (19). The Harrisburg roster also includes 11 players with previous MLB experience, including Rafael Bautista, Kyle Barraclough, Aaron Barrett, Brad Boxberger, Tyler Goeddel, Erick Fedde, Spencer Kieboom, Justin Miller, Luis Sardinas, Michael A. Taylor and Austin Voth.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Brandon Beachy** makes his tenth start of the season for the Flying Squirrels and his second against the Senators. Last time out, he allowed five runs over 4.2 innings in a loss against Reading on Saturday. In his previous start on July 1 in Harrisburg, Beachy allowed career highs in runs (9) and walks (5) over 4.0 innings in a loss. Beach has gone 0-2 with a 13.50 ERA (13 ER/8.2 IP) in his last two starts after starting the season 3-3 with a 3.93 ERA in his first eight outings. Beachy made his MLB debut with the Atlanta Braves in 2010 and spent three seasons in the Majors with them, totaling 46 starts with a 14-11 record and 3.23 ERA. His best season came in 2012, when he went 5-5 with a 2.00 ERA over 13 starts, posting the best ERA in the majors until his season ended with an elbow injury, requiring Tommy John surgery. He returned in 2013 but had to undergo Tommy John surgery again prior to the 2014 season. Beachy signed with the Dodgers in 2015 and briefly returned to the majors that year. He was held to one appearance in 2016 and did not pitch at all in 2017. Last year, he made 12 appearances for the independent New Britain Bees, going 0-1 with a 3.55 ERA in 12 appearances (two starts). **For more on Beachy, see page two.**

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander **Mario Sanchez** makes his 11th start of the season for the Senators and his against the Flying Squirrels. In his most recent start on Saturday at Bowie, Sanchez picked up a season-high eight strikeouts but allowed three runs in 4.1 innings and was charged with a loss. He faced the Flying Squirrels on July 1 at FNB Field and allowed two runs over 5.1 innings to pick up his sixth win of the year. Sanchez began the season with Harrisburg and went 3-0 with a 1.04 ERA in six games (two starts) before earning a promotion to Triple-A Fresno. In his four games (three starts) in the PCL, Sanchez went 0-2 with an 11.85 ERA, and he returned to the Double-A roster on May 27. Sanchez signed with the Nationals in 2012 as an international free agent and was traded to the Phillies on December 12, 2016. He rejoined the Nationals as a free agent in December.

GOING UNDER: Thursday's loss by the Flying Squirrels against the Harrisburg Senators dropped the team's overall record to 32-55, marking the first time the team had ever held a record 23 games under .500. Friday's loss pushed the mark further below to 24 games under .500, a new franchise-worst. The mark surpasses the previous low at 22 games under .500, which was reached three separate times during the 2016 season, most recently on August 10, 2016. The Flying Squirrels' -103 run differential is the worst in Double-A and their .364 winning percentage is the worst of all Double-A and Triple-A teams.

BLANK SPACE: The Flying Squirrels were shut out in back-to-back games for the second time this season during the last series. Over the last six games, the Flying Squirrels have scored nine runs. Over the last ten games since June 30, Richmond is averaging 1.7 runs per game (17 total runs).

BESTED BY THE WEST: In their last 12 games against Western Division opponents, the Flying Squirrels have gone 3-9. That includes losing two-of-three against Harrisburg from June 11-13, two-of-three against Altoona from June 24-26 and two-of-three in Harrisburg from July 1-3.

A LITTLE RELIEF: Over the last 30 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 2.01 ERA (23 ER/103.0 IP). On the season, Richmond's 3.66 bullpen ERA is the second-highest in the league. Since May 5 in 16 games, **Ryan Halstead** has gone 1-2 with a 1.11 ERA (3 ER/24.1 IP). In his last 16 outings since May 19, **Melvin Adon** has posted a 1.16 ERA (3 ER/23.1 IP) with 10 walks and 33 strikeouts, and he has gone 8-for-9 in save attempts. **Chase Johnson** has a 1.90 ERA (4 ER/19.0 IP) in his last 11 appearances since May 31. **Tyler Cyr** has a 1.23 ERA (2 ER/14.2 IP) in his last 10 appearances since June 5. **Dillon McNamara** has a 1.59 ERA in his six appearances for the Flying Squirrels since joining the team on June 17. **Carlos Navas** has a 0.61 ERA (1 ER/14.2) overall with Richmond in eight outings. **Frank Rubio** has posted a 1.29 ERA (1 ER/7.0 IP) over his last five appearances since June 22. **Raffi Vizcaino** has a 1.23 ERA (2 ER/14.1 IP) ERA in his last nine games since June 11. **Sam Moll** has a 2.70 ERA (2 ER/6.2 IP) in his last eight games since June 20. **Caleb Simpson** has a 1.35 ERA (1 ER/6.2) in his last six outings.

STARTING OFF: The Richmond starting rotation has a 3.86 ERA this season, which is eighth in the league. **Caleb Baragar** is 2-2 with a 2.89 ERA (18 ER/56.0 IP) over his last ten starts since May 19. **Brandon Lawson** has gone 1-4 with a 4.36 ERA (21 ER/43.1 IP) in his last eight starts since May 28. **Garrett Williams** is 2-1 with a 2.19 ERA (9 ER/37.0 IP) in his last six starts dating back to June 6. **Alfred Gutierrez** is 2-5 with a 3.48 ERA (16 ER/41.1 IP) in his last eight starts since May 26.

NICE START, BRYCE: Outfielder **Bryce Johnson** was promoted to the Flying Squirrels on June 25 from A-Adv. San Jose. After going 0-for-4 in his Double-A debut on June 26, Johnson collected seven hits over his next three days. In his current 13-base streak, Johnson is batting .325 (13-for-40) with three doubles, a triple, two homers and six RBIs. He is batting .295 overall since joining the Eastern League.

GRAND LARCENY: This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 85 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 35 steals this year. **Jalen Miller** is third with 20. In 10 games dating back to July 1, the Flying Squirrels have stolen five bases. After stealing 37 bases in June, the Flying Squirrels did not pick up a steal in their first six games in July. Over the three games since, the Flying Squirrels have picked up five stolen bases, including two by Miller.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features five of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), infielder **Ryan Howard** (24) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Five players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Adon (15), Williams (20), Howard (27), Miller (28) and **Jacob Heyward** (30).



- Brandon Alan Beachy
- Attended Northwestern High School in Kokomo, Ind.
- Attended Indiana Wesleyan University, where he was a third baseman and a closer
- Originally signed by the Braves as a non-drafted free agent in 2008
- Made MLB debut with Atlanta on Sept. 20, 2010
- In 2011, led Braves staff and ranked second among MLB rookies with 169 strikeouts, the most by a Braves rookie in modern-era franchise history at the time and 10.74 K/9 IP was fourth all-time among rookie starting pitchers (min. 25 starts) in MLB history behind Kerry Wood (1998), Dwight Gooden (1984) and Hideo Nomo (1995)
- Made 13 MLB starts in 2012 and went 5-5 with a 2.00 ERA (T-1st in MLB at time) and .171 BAA (1st in MLB) before being placed on DL on 6/16, undergoing Tommy John surgery on 6/21
- Had second Tommy John surgery in March 2014
- Signed with Dodgers for 2015 and made two MLB starts
- Limited to one appearance in AZL in 2016 with elbow injury
- Made only 25 total appearances from 2014-2017
- Spent 2018 season with independent New Britain Bees of the Atlantic League and made 12 appearances (2 starts), going 0-1 with a 3.55 ERA in 12.2 IP
