**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels snapped a season-high-tying six-game losing streak with a 4-2 win over the Harrisburg Senators on Sunday afternoon at FNB Field. Nick Banks gave Harrisburg the game's first run in the first inning with an RBI single. Richmond's **Bryce Johnson** answered with a two-out, two-run double in the second to put Richmond ahead, 2-1. Harrisburg tied the game in the third with a solo homer by Drew Ward. In the seventh, **Peter Maris** came through with a pinch-hit RBI triple to put the Flying Squirrels back ahead, 3-2. **Ryan Howard** extended the lead to 4-2 in the eighth with an RBI groundout. **Brandon Lawson** allowed two runs over 6.0 innings to pick up his third win of the year. **Melvin Adon** closed out his 12th save, recording the final two outs in the ninth.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a three-game road series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. It is also the fifth of a seven-game road trip to Harrisburg (1-3) and Hartford. The series is Richmond's second and final trip to Hartford this season. In their last visit, Hartford took two of three. The Flying Squirrels won three games in a four-game set against Hartford to open the season at The Diamond from April 4-7. The two teams split a four-game set in Richmond from June 27-30. The Flying Squirrels are 13-19 this season in games following a win and 6-8 in road series openers.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have lost nine of 12 since June 30 after going 7-3 in the previous ten games from June 20-29. Over the last 11 games, the Flying Squirrels have been outscored 54-21 (40-17 by Harrisburg and 14-4 by Reading). The series is Richmond's second and final trip to Hartford this season. In their last visit, Hartford took two of three. The Flying Squirrels won three games in a four-game set against Hartford to open the season at The Diamond from April 4-7. The two teams split a four-game set in Richmond from June 27-30. The Flying Squirrels are 13-19 this season in games following a win and 6-8 in road series openers.

**THE YARD GOATS** have won two straight games since Saturday and six of the last nine since July 3. In the four games of their current homestand, the Yard Goats have hit .326 (45-for-138) with seven home runs and have scored 27 runs (6.8 runs per game). For the season, Hartford is batting .230 as a team, which is tied for second-lowest in the league ahead of Richmond. The Yard Goats lead the Eastern League with a 3.12 team ERA, but they are 11th in July with a 4.59 ERA. Hartford's bullpen has a 2.60 ERA this year, second in the league, and leads the league with 35 saves. The Hartford roster includes XX of MLB.com's top-30 Rockies prospects, including Colton Welker (No. 2, NO. 6 3B, No. 57 overall), Tyler Nevin (No. 6, NO. 8 1B), Justin Lawrence (No. 12), Reid Humphreys (No. 17 - on IL), Vince Fernandez (No. 24 - suspended) and Bret Boswell (No. 25).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander **Caleb Baragar** makes his 12th start and 13th overall appearance for the Flying Squirrels this season. He last pitched on Wednesday in the Eastern League All-Star Game at The Diamond. As the game's starting pitcher, he picked up a strikeout in one scoreless inning and picked up the winning decision. In his most recent regular-season start, Baragar allowed three runs over 5.2 innings in a loss against Reading on July 5. Over his last three starts, Baragar has gone 0-2 with a 4.41 ERA (8 ER/16.1 IP). In his previous seven starts from May 19-June 20, Baragar went 2-0 with a 2.27 ERA (10 ER/39.2 IP). Baragar faced Hartford at The Diamond on June 30 and pitched 6.1 innings, allowing one run on three hits seven strikeouts in a no-decision. Prior to joining Richmond, Baragar made one start with Triple-A Sacramento on May 2 and allowed five runs over 4.1 innings in a no-decision. He began the season with A-Adv. San Jose and went 0-1 with a 2.70 ERA in four starts and one relief outing. Baragar was drafted by the Giants in the ninth round in 2016 out of Indiana University and is in his fourth professional season. **For more on Baragar, see page two.**

**FOR HARTFORD:** Left-hander Matt Whitehouse makes his fourth start of the season for the Yard Goats. He last pitched on Thursday in a relief outing and allowed six runs over 3.0 innings against New Hampshire. His best start with Hartford came on June 30 at Richmond, when he allowed one run over 4.0 innings, tied for his longest outing this season. Whitehouse began the year with Triple-A Columbus in the Indians organization and posted a 3.00 ERA in four outings before being sent to Double-A Akron in late-April. He bounced between Akron and Columbus before being released on June 17. The Rockies signed Whitehouse as a free agent on June 23 and assigned him to Hartford.

**HEADING EAST:** This series marks the final road set of the season for the Flying Squirrels against the Eastern Division. Dating back to June 20, Richmond has won four straight road games against the opposite division. Richmond is 4-1 against Eastern Division opponents away from The Diamond in the second half and 9-11 overall this season.

**GOING UNDER:** Thursday's loss by the Flying Squirrels against the Harrisburg Senators dropped the team's overall record to 32-55, marking the first time the team had ever held a record 23 games under .500. Saturday's loss pushed the mark further below to 25 games under .500, a new franchise-worst. The mark surpasses the previous low at 22 games under .500, which was reached three separate times during the 2016 season, most recently on August 10, 2016. The Flying Squirrels' -103 run differential is the worst in Double-A.

**SEARCHING FOR HITS:** Since resuming play out of the All-Star Break, the Flying Squirrels have combined to hit .167 (21-for-126) as a team and have scored 10 runs (2.5 per game). In the month of July, the Flying Squirrels are batting .185 (61-for-330) and have scored 21 runs (1.9 per game).

**A LITTLE RELIEF:** Over the last 32 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 1.89 ERA (23 ER/109.2 IP). On the season, Richmond's 3.58 bullpen ERA is the second-highest in the league. Since May 5 in 17 games, **Ryan Halstead** has gone 1-2 with a 1.08 ERA (3 ER/25.0 IP). In his last 16 outings since May 19, **Melvin Adon** has posted a 1.13 ERA (3 ER/24.0 IP) with 11 walks and 34 strikeouts, and he has gone 9-for-10 in save attempts. **Chase Johnson** has a 1.90 ERA (4 ER/19.0 IP) in his last 11 appearances since May 31. **Tyler Cyr** has a 1.08 ERA (2 ER/16.2 IP) in his last 12 appearances since June 5. **Dillon McNamara** has a 1.59 ERA in his six appearances for the Flying Squirrels since joining the team on June 17. **Carlos Navas** has a 0.54 ERA (1 ER/16.2) overall with Richmond in nine outings. **Frank Rubio** has posted a 1.29 ERA (1 ER/7.0 IP) over his last five appearances since June 22. **Raffi Vizcaino** has a 1.23 ERA (2 ER/14.1 IP) ERA in his last nine games since June 11. **Sam Moll** has a 2.25 ERA (2 ER/8.0 IP) in his last eight games since June 20. **Caleb Simpson** has a 1.35 ERA (1 ER/6.2) in his last six outings.

**STARTING OFF:** The Richmond starting rotation has a 3.87 ERA this season, which is eighth in the league. **Caleb Baragar** is 2-2 with a 2.89 ERA (18 ER/56.0 IP) over his last ten starts since May 19. **Brandon Lawson** has gone 2-4 with a 4.20 ERA (23 ER/49.1 IP) in his last nine starts since May 28. **Garrett Williams** is 2-1 with a 2.19 ERA (9 ER/37.0 IP) in his last six starts dating back to June 6. **Alfred Gutierrez** is 5-2 with a 3.48 ERA (16 ER/41.1 IP) in his last eight starts since May 26.

**NICE START, BRYCE:** Outfielder **Bryce Johnson** was promoted to the Flying Squirrels on June 25 from A-Adv. San Jose. After going 0-for-4 in his Double-A debut on June 26, Johnson collected seven hits over his next three days. In his current 15-game on-base streak, Johnson is batting .313 (15-for-48) with four doubles, a triple, two homers and eight RBIs. He is batting .288 overall since joining the Eastern League.

**GRAND LARCENY:** This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 85 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Farag** leads the league with 35 steals this year. **Jalen Miller** is third with 20. In 10 games dating back to July 1, the Flying Squirrels have stolen five bases. After stealing 37 bases in June, the Flying Squirrels did not pick up a steal in their first six games in July. Over the three games since, the Flying Squirrels have picked up five stolen bases, including two by Miller.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels' roster features five of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), infielder **Ryan Howard** (24) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Five players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Adon (15), Williams (20), Howard (27), Miller (28) and **Jacob Heyward** (30).
