**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels won their second straight game with a 6-5 win on the road against the Hartford Yard Goats. **Ryan Howard, Zach Houchins and Johneshwy Fargas** each picked up RBI hits in the first inning to open a 3-0 lead. In the second, Howard singled in another run and **Jacob Heyward** added an RBI double to extend the lead to 5-0. Hartford closed within two runs with a three-run homer by Alan Trejo in the fourth, the Yard Goats' first hit of the game. In the fifth, Vance Vizcaino brought Hartford within a run with an RBI single. **Bryce Johnson** hit an RBI single in the sixth to pad the lead back to two runs at 6-4. Hartford closed within one run in the ninth, but **Melvin Adon** worked a double play from Arivcent Perez to end the ballgame and strand the tying run at third base.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a four-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. It's also the first of a seven-day, eight-game homestand against Erie and Bowie. This series is the first of two trips to The Diamond for the SeaWolves. They return for a three-game set from August 19-21. The two teams previously met for a three-game series at Erie's UPMC Park from April 13-15, when Richmond won the first game but Erie walked off in each of the final two games of the series.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have won two games in a row and three of the last five four games since Sunday. Over the previous 11 games from June 30-July 13, the Flying Squirrels went 2-9 and lost six straight games from July 5 (G2)-July 13, tied for the longest losing streak of the year. Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .221 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.75 team ERA, which is tenth in the circuit. Richmond's -100 run differential is last in the league (next closest is New Hampshire at -32).

**THE SEAWOLVES** have won four straight games since Sunday, including a three-game home sweep over Akron from Monday through Wednesday. During their current four-game winning streak, Erie pitchers have combined for a 3.25 ERA (13 ER/36.0 IP). Over their last five games since Saturday, the SeaWolves have hit .274 (45-for-164) and have scored 29 runs (5.8 per game). For the season, the SeaWolves have the best run differential in the league (+52). Erie's pitching staff has a 3.30 ERA this year, tied for second-best in the league. The SeaWolves offense leads the league with a .248 team batting average and is tied for third with 73 home runs. Erie's roster includes 11 of MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects, including Matt Manning (No. 2, No. 32 overall, No. 10 RHP), Isaac Paredes (No. 4, No. 83 overall), Alex Faedo (No. 9), Kyle Funkhouser (No. 10), Sergio Alcantara (No. 14), Logan Shore (No. 15), Tarik Skubal (No. 17), Anthony Castro (No. 21), Derek Hill (No. 23), Zac Houston (No. 24) and Jose Azocar (No. 29).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Keyvius Sampson** makes his Flying Squirrels and Eastern League debut. He made three starts and one relief appearance in the Arizona League with the AZL Giants Black on a rehab assignment. After allowing four runs in his first 1.2 innings, Sampson did not allow a run in his final 9.1 innings on the mound. Sampson spent the 2018 season in the Korea Baseball Organization with the Hanwha Eagles, where he went 13-8 with a 4.68 ERA. He led the league with 195 strikeouts and led all pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) with 10.86 SO/9 IP. Sampson was originally drafted by the San Diego Padres in the fourth round in 2009 and made his MLB debut with the Cincinnati Reds in 2015. **For more on Sampson, see page two.**

**FOR ERIE:** Right-hander **Spenser Watkins** makes his seventh start and eighth overall appearance for the SeaWolves this season. He last pitched on Saturday against Altoona and allowed a season-high-tying seven runs (most in an EL start) in 5.0 innings. Over his first five outings with Erie through June 23, Watkins posted a 2.78 ERA. Over his last three starts (two with Erie and one with Triple-A Toledo), Watkins has gone 0-1 with a 9.00 ERA (16 ER/16.0 IP). Watkins was a Florida State League Mid-Season All-Star last year with Lakeland. He was drafted by the Tigers in the 30th round in 2014 out of NCAA DII Western Oregon University.

**HIT PARADE:** The Flying Squirrels matched a season high with 13 hits in Tuesday afternoon's win at Hartford and then set a new season high with 15 hits in Wednesday's win at Dunkin Donuts Park. Over the last three games, the Flying Squirrels have hit .327 (37-for-113) and homered four times while averaging 5.7 runs per game (17 total runs). Over the previous seven games (1-6 record) dating back to July 5 (G2), the Flying Squirrels hit .154 (31-for-202).

**A SERIES OF UNFORTUNATE EVENTS:** On the season, the Flying Squirrels have won five series, lost 19 and split five. Four of their five series wins have come on the road. Richmond had lost three straight series prior to winning two-of-three in Hartford this week, their first series win since a three-game sweep in Binghamton from June 21-23.

**TROUBLE AT HOME:** Since May 22, the Flying Squirrels have gone 5-17 in 23 home games. Richmond has lost six of the last seven home series since May 21, with the only exception being a four-game split against Hartford from June 27-30. After starting the year 5-2 at home through April 18, Richmond has posted a 9-30 record in 39 games at The Diamond since April 20. Richmond's only home series win the year was their first set of the season when they won three-of-four against Hartford from April 4-7. Away from The Diamond, the Flying Squirrels are 8-6 in their last 14 road games since June 20.

**GOING UNDER:** Saturday's loss Flying Squirrels loss in Harrisburg pushed the team's overall record 25 games under .500, a new franchise-worst at 32-57 (Matched again at 33-58 following Monday's loss at Hartford). The mark surpassed the previous low at 22 games under .500, which was reached three separate times during the 2016 season, most recently on August 10, 2016. The Flying Squirrels' -100 run differential is the worst in Double-A.

**A LITTLE RELIEF:** Over the last 34 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 1.83 ERA (25 ER/122.2 IP) with 122 strikeouts and 50 walks while not allowing a single home run. On the season, Richmond's 3.50 bullpen ERA is the second-highest in the league. **Ryan Halstead** has gone 1-2 with a 1.03 ERA (3 ER/26.1 IP) in his last 18 games since May 5. **Melvin Adon** has posted a 1.08 ERA (3 ER/25.0) in 20 games since May 19 with 10 saves in 11 attempts, adding 34 strikeouts and 11 walks. **Tyler Cyr** has posted a 0.96 ERA (2 ER/18.2 IP) in his last 13 games since June 5. **Raffi Vizcaino** has a 1.10 ERA (2 ER/16.1 IP) in his last 10 appearances since June 11. **Caleb Simpson** has a 1.04 ERA (1 ER/8.2 IP) in his last seven outings since June 18. **Sam Moll** has a 2.00 ERA (2 ER/9.0 IP) in his last 10 outings since June 20. **Frank Rubio** has a 1.13 ERA (1 ER/8.0 IP) in his last six outings since June 22. **Carlos Navas** has combined for a 0.95 ERA (2 ER/19.0 IP) in his 10 total appearances with the Flying Squirrels this year. **Chase Johnson** has a 2.29 ERA (5 ER/19.2 IP) in his last 12 games since May 31.

**NICE START, BRYCE:** Outfielder **Bryce Johnson** was promoted to the Flying Squirrels on June 25 from A-Adv. San Jose. After going 0-for-4 in his Double-A debut on June 26, Johnson collected seven hits over his next three days. In his current 18-game on-base streak, Johnson is batting .356 (21-for-59) with five doubles, a triple, three homers and 13 RBIs. He is batting .333 overall since joining the Eastern League.

**MEET PETE MARIS:** Over his last eight games since July 7, **Pete Maris** is batting .333 (9-for-27) with two doubles, two triples and three RBIs. He collected a season-high three hits on Tuesday at Hartford. In his 17 games since he joined the Flying Squirrels, Maris is batting .298.

**MILLER TIME:** In his last eight games since July 7, **Jalen Miller** has hit .280 (7-for-28) with two doubles and a triple. Miller has at least one hit in six of his last seven games started.

**HEYWARD MOVING FORWARD:** Eastern League All-Star Game MVP **Jacob Heyward** is currently on a four-game hitting streak since Sunday. In that span, Heyward is batting .333 (5-for-15) with three doubles, three RBIs and two walks. On the year, Heyward ranks third in the league with 49.

**GRAND LARCENY:** This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 89 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 36 steals this year. **Jalen Miller** is third with 20. In 14 games dating back to July 1, the Flying Squirrels have stolen eight bases. After stealing 37 bases in June, the Flying Squirrels did not pick up a steal in their first six games in July. Fargas has the fourth-most steals in a season in franchise history and has the fifth-most career steals in team history.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels' roster features five of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), infielder **Ryan Howard** (24) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Five players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Adon (15), Williams (20), Howard (27), Miller (28) and **Jacob Heyward** (30).


