YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels broke up a no-hitter with two outs and two strikes in the ninth inning and lost to the Erie SeaWolves, 3-0, in the series opener. Erie starter Spenser Watkins did not allow a hit through his first 8.2 innings, but **Ryder Jones** broke up the no-hitter with a two-out, two-strike double down the third-base line. The Flying Squirrels loaded the bases in the ninth inning, but Drew Carlton worked out of the jam to complete the shutout. It was the fifth time the Flying Squirrels have been held to one hit this season. Frank Schwindel hit a sac fly in the first inning to get Erie's first run home. Josh Lester hit a solo homer in the sixth. Kody Eaves added a sac fly in the seventh to open a 3-0 lead.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a four-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. It's also the second of a seven-day, eight-game homestand against Erie (0-1) and Bowie. This series is the first of two trips to The Diamond for the SeaWolves. They return for a three-game set from August 19-21. The two teams previously met for a three-game series at Erie's UPMC Park from April 13-15, when Richmond won the first game but Erie walked off in each of the final two games of the series.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS had won three of the last five four games since Sunday before losing last night's series opener. Over the previous 11 games from June 30-July 13, the Flying Squirrels went 2-9 and lost six straight games from July 5 (G2)-July 13, tied for the longest losing streak of the year. Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .220 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.74 team ERA, which is tenth in the circuit. Richmond's -103 run differential is last in the league (next closest is New Hampshire at -32).

THE SEAWOLVES have won five straight games since Sunday, including a three-game home sweep over Akron from Monday through Wednesday. During their current five-game winning streak, Erie pitchers have combined for a 2.60 ERA (13 ER/45.0 IP). Over their last six games since Saturday, the SeaWolves have hit .269 (53-for-197) and have scored 32 runs (5.3 per game). For the season, the SeaWolves have the best run differential in the league (+55). Erie's pitching staff has a 3.26 ERA this year, second-best in the league. The SeaWolves offense leads the league with a .249 team batting average and is tied for second with 74 home runs. Erie's roster includes 12 of MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects, including Casey Mize (No. 1, No. 2 overall, No. 1 RHP), Matt Manning (No. 2, No. 32 overall, No. 10 RHP), Isaac Paredes (No. 4, No. 83 overall), Alex Faedo (No. 9), Kyle Funkhouser (No. 10), Sergio Alcantara (No. 14), Logan Shore (No. 15), Tarik Skubal (No. 17), Anthony Castro (No. 21), Derek Hill (No. 23), Zac Houston (No. 24) and Jose Azocar (No. 29).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Brandon Lawson** makes his 15th start with the Flying Squirrels and his second against Erie. Last time out, he picked up a win at Harrisburg after allowing two runs in 6.0 innings. He also faced the SeaWolves on May 13 at UPMC Park and picked up his first Richmond win after allowing four runs (two earned) in 5.0 innings. Lawson was signed as a minor-league free agent by the Giants on April 23 after being released by the Tampa Bay Rays near the end of spring training. He was originally drafted by the Rays in the 12th round in 2016 out of the University of South Florida and reached Double-A for 14 outings (five starts) last season with the Montgomery Biscuits. *For more on Lawson, see page two.*

FOR ERIE: Left-hander Tarik Skubal makes his third start for the SeaWolves. Each of his two Double-A starts have come against Altoona. On July 7, He pitched 5.0 innings and allowed one unearned run with 11 strikeouts in a no-decision. He followed with 5.0 innings of work on Friday at home and allowed one run in 5.0 innings with 10 strikeouts. He began the season with A-Adv. Lakeland and went 4-5 with a 2.58 ERA in 15 starts, earning Florida State League Mid-Season All-Star honors. Skubal ranks ninth in all of minor league baseball with 118 strikeouts. His 11.76 K/9 IP is third in all of MiLB among pitchers who have worked at least 90.0 innings. Skubal was drafted in the ninth round in 2018 out of Seattle University.

HIGHS AND LOWS: The Flying Squirrels matched a season high with 13 hits in Tuesday afternoon's win at Hartford and then set a new season high with 15 hits in Wednesday's win at Dunkin' Donuts Park. Over last three games from Monday through Wednesday, the Flying Squirrels hit .327 (37-for-113) and homered four times while averaging 5.7 runs per game (17 total runs). Over the previous seven games (1-6 record) dating back to July 5 (G2), the Flying Squirrels hit .154 (31-for-202).

IT STARTS WITH ONE: The Flying Squirrels have not been no-hit in the franchise's history. However, Richmond's offense has been held to one hit five times in the 2019 season. On April 20, the Flying Squirrels had one hit in each game of a double-header against Altoona. On June 9, Nate Pearson and Willy Ortiz of New Hampshire held Richmond to one hit, an infield single by **Johneshwy Fargas**, in Manchester. Three days later on June 12, Harrisburg's Ben Braymer and Bryan Bonnell did not allow a hit until one out into the tenth inning, when **Jalen Miller** hit a walk-off single. On Thursday, Erie's Spenser Watkins held Richmond hitless two outs into the ninth inning, but **Ryder Jones** hit a two-strike double down the third-base line to break up the no-hitter.

A SERIES OF UNFORTUNATE EVENTS: On the season, the Flying Squirrels have won five series, lost 19 and split five. Four of their five series wins have come on the road. Richmond had lost three straight series prior to winning two-of-three in Hartford this week, their first series win since a three-game sweep in Binghamton from June 21-23.

TROUBLE AT HOME: Since May 22, the Flying Squirrels have gone 5-18 in 24 home games. Richmond has lost six of the last seven home series since May 21, with the only exception being a four-game split against Hartford from June 27-30. After starting the year 5-2 at home through April 18, Richmond has posted a 9-31 record in 40 games at The Diamond since April 20. Richmond's only home series win the year was their first set of the season when they won three-of-four against Hartford from April 4-7. Away from The Diamond, the Flying Squirrels are 8-6 in their last 14 road games since June 20.

KEEP IT IN THE YARD: On Thursday, Erie's Josh Lester homered off of **Chase Johnson**, the first home run allowed by the Richmond bullpen since June 7. The most recent homer before was a solo homer by Brock Lundquist against **Ryan Halstead** on June 7 in Manchester. The Richmond bullpen had worked 35 straight games without allowing a homer.

A LITTLE RELIEF: Over the last 35 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 1.89 ERA (27 ER/128.2 IP) with 131 strikeouts and 53 walks while not allowing a single home run. On the season, Richmond's 3.50 bullpen ERA is the second-highest in the league. **Ryan Halstead** has gone 1-2 with a 1.03 ERA (3 ER/26.1 IP) in his last 18 games since May 5. **Melvin Adon** has posted a 1.08 ERA (3 ER/25.0) in 20 games since May 19 with 10 saves in 11 attempts, adding 34 strikeouts and 11 walks. **Tyler Cyr** has posted a 0.96 ERA (2 ER/18.2 IP) in his last 13 games since June 5. **Raffi Vizcaino** has a 1.10 ERA (2 ER/16.1 IP) in his last 10 appearances since June 11. **Caleb Simpson** has a 1.69 ERA (2 ER/10.2 IP) in his last eight outings since June 18. **Sam Moll** has a 2.00 ERA (2 ER/9.0 IP) in his last 10 outings since June 20. **Frank Rubio** has a 1.00 ERA (1 ER/9.0 IP) in his last seven outings since June 22. **Carlos Navas** has combined for a 0.95 ERA (2 ER/19.0 IP) in his 10 total appearances with the Flying Squirrels this year. **Chase Johnson** has a 2.38 ERA (6 ER/22.2 IP) in his last 13 games since May 31.

NICE START, BRYCE: Outfielder **Bryce Johnson** was promoted to the Flying Squirrels on June 25 from A-Adv. San Jose. After going 0-for-4 in his Double-A debut on June 26, Johnson collected seven hits over his next three days. From June 27-July 17, Johnson posted an 18-game on-base streak, during which he hit .356 (21-for-59) with five doubles, a triple, three homers and 13 RBIs. He is batting .313 overall since joining the Eastern League.

MEET PETE MARIS: Over his last nine games since July 7, **Peter Maris** is batting .291 (9-for-31) with two doubles, two triples and three RBIs. He collected a season-high three hits on Tuesday at Hartford. In his 18 games since he joined the Flying Squirrels, Maris is batting .275.

GRAND LARCENY: This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 89 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 36 steals this year. **Jalen Miller** is third with 20. In 14 games dating back to July 1, the Flying Squirrels have stolen eight bases. After stealing 37 bases in June, the Flying Squirrels did not pick up a steal in their first six games in July. Fargas has the fourth-most steals in a season in franchise history and has the fifth-most career steals in team history.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features five of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), infielder **Ryan Howard** (24) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Five players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Adon (15), Williams (20), Howard (27), Miller (28) and **Jacob Heyward** (30).
