YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels opened a six-run lead in the first inning but lost, 14-7, in the series finale to the Erie SeaWolves. Facing baseball's top pitching prospect, Casey Mize, **Gio Brusa** opened the scoring with a two-run double in the first. **Zach Houchins** hit a two-run double, and **Jonah Arenado** and **Hamlet Marte** added RBI singles before the second out of the inning was recorded. Erie scored single runs in the second, third and fourth innings to close within three runs. In the fifth, Arenado hit an RBI single to extend Richmond's lead to 7-3. Erie scored two in the seventh, seven in the eighth and two in the ninth to pull ahead and pull away.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the first two of a four-game, three-day series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. It's also the fifth and sixth of an eight-game, seven-day homestand against Erie (1-3) and Bowie. This series is Bowie's second trip to Richmond this season. The two teams split a rain-shortened, two-game series from April 9-10. The Flying Squirrels are 21-39 this season in games following a loss, 4-6 on Mondays, 3-5 in double-headers and 10-20 in first games of a series (4-11 at home).

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost three of four on the current homestand after winning three of the last four on the last road trip. Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .220 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.85 team ERA, which is 11th in the circuit. Richmond's -112 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Portland at -22). The previous franchise-worst is -80 in 2017.

THE BAYSOX have won six of their last eight games since July 14 and have posted a 14-4 record in the month of July. This month, the Baysox lead the league with a 2.73 team ERA and rank first in the league with a .275 team batting average. Bowie has won 13 consecutive series dating back to June 4. For the season, Bowie ranks third in the league with a .245 team batting average and third with a 3.36 team ERA. Bowie's roster includes 11 of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including Yusniel Diaz (4), Ryan McKenna (7), Zac Lowther (8), Dean Kremer (9), Dillon Tate (17), Zach Pop (19 - on IL), Rylan Bannon (21), Michael Baumann (24), Alex Wells (25), Cody Sedlock (26) and Mason McCoy (30).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Garrett Williams** takes the mound for his 19th start of the season for the Flying Squirrels and his second against Bowie. In his most recent start on Wednesday at Hartford, Williams worked 5.0 innings and allowed four runs, the most in a start since June 18, in a win at Hartford on July 17. He has picked up a win in three of his last four starts. Over his last seven starts since June 6, Williams has gone 3-1 with a 2.79 ERA (13 ER/42.0 IP). He last faced the Baysox on May 1 and pitched 6.0 innings and allowed two runs in a win. He made 14 starts for Richmond last season and went 2-6 with a 6.00 ERA before moving to the bullpen when the calendar turned to July. As a reliever, he posted a 5.96 ERA in 18 appearances. Williams is ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 21 Giants prospect and No. 19 by MLB.com. **For more on Williams, see page two.**

Right-hander **Ryan Halstead** takes the mound for the Flying Squirrels in Game 2. It is the second start of his professional career. He made a spot start against Altoona on June 24 and worked a career-high 4.0 innings and allowed one run on two hits. Since June 2, Halstead has gone 1-0 with a 1.15 ERA (2 ER/15.2 IP).

FOR BOWIE: Left-hander Bruce Zimmermann makes his 17th start of the season for the Baysox. Last time out, he allowed four runs over 4.0 innings in a loss against Harrisburg on Wednesday. Over his last two starts, Zimmermann is 0-1 with a 5.19 ERA (5 ER/8.2 IP). Over his previous six starts from June 5-July 4, Zimmermann went 3-1 with a 1.96 ERA (8 ER/36.2 IP). Zimmermann was traded to the Orioles on July 31, 2018 along with Brett Cumberland, Jean Carlos Encarnacion and Evan Phillips for RHP Kevin Gausman and RHP Darren O'Day. A Baltimore native, he was originally drafted by the Braves in the fifth round in 2017.

Right-hander Cody Sedlock starts in Game 2 for the Baysox in his second Double-A appearance. He began the year with A-Adv. Frederick and went 4-1 with a 2.36 ERA in 13 games (10 starts). He made his Double-A debut on Thursday against Harrisburg and pitched 3.0 scoreless innings. Sedlock was drafted by the Orioles in the first round (27th overall) in 2016 out of the University of Illinois, where he was the Big Ten Pitcher of the Year.

HIGHS AND LOWS: Over the previous seven games from July 5 (G2)-July 14 (1-6 record) dating back to July 5 (G2), the Flying Squirrels hit .154 (31-for-202). Over the seven games since, Richmond has collected at least nine hits in a game five times. In that stretch dating back to July 15, the Flying Squirrels are batting .251 (62-for-247). The Flying Squirrels matched a season high with 13 hits in Tuesday afternoon's win at Hartford and then set a new season high with 15 hits in Wednesday's win at Dunkin Donuts Park.

A SERIES OF UNFORTUNATE EVENTS: On the season, the Flying Squirrels have won five series, lost 20 and split five. Four of their five series wins have come on the road. Richmond had lost three straight series prior to winning two-of-three in Hartford this week, their first series win since a three-game sweep in Binghamton from June 21-23. They followed with a series loss to Erie over the weekend.

TROUBLE AT HOME: Since May 23, the Flying Squirrels have gone 6-20 in 26 home games. Richmond has lost seven of the last eight home series since May 21, with the only exception being a four-game split against Hartford from June 27-30. After starting the year 5-2 at home through April 18, Richmond has posted a 10-33 record in 43 games at The Diamond since April 20. Richmond's only home series win the year was their first set of the season when they won three-of-four against Hartford from April 4-7. Away from The Diamond, the Flying Squirrels are 8-6 in their last 14 road games since June 20.

A LITTLE RELIEF: Over the last 37 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 2.68 ERA (41 ER/137.2 IP) with 140 strikeouts and 59 walks. On the season, Richmond's 3.75 bullpen ERA is the second-highest in the league. **Ryan Halstead** has gone 1-2 with a 1.03 ERA (3 ER/26.1 IP) in his last 18 games since May 5. **Melvin Adon** has posted a 1.08 ERA (3 ER/25.0) in 20 games since May 19 with 10 saves in 11 attempts, adding 34 strikeouts and 11 walks. **Tyler Cyr** has posted a 0.89 ERA (2 ER/20.1 IP) in his last 14 games since June 5. **Raffi Vizcaino** has a 1.04 ERA (2 ER/17.1 IP) in his last 11 appearances since June 11. **Caleb Simpson** has a 1.64 ERA (2 ER/11.0 IP) in his last nine outings since June 18. **Carlos Navas** has combined for a 0.90 ERA (2 ER/20.0 IP) in his 10 total appearances with the Flying Squirrels this year. **Chase Johnson** has a 2.38 ERA (6 ER/22.2 IP) in his last 13 games since May 31.

NICE START, BRYCE: Outfielder **Bryce Johnson** was promoted to the Flying Squirrels on June 25 from A-Adv. San Jose. After going 0-for-4 in his Double-A debut on June 26, Johnson collected seven hits over his next three days. From June 27-July 17, Johnson posted an 18-game on-base streak, during which he hit .356 (21-for-59) with five doubles, a triple, three homers and 13 RBIs. He is batting .303 overall since joining the Eastern League.

ARENADO ELEVATING: Over his last six games since July 16, **Jonah Arenado** is batting .318 (7-for-22) with a homer and four RBIs, bringing his season batting average back up to .250. He opened the season with a .283 batting average through June 23, but hit .074 (4-for-54) over 19 games from June 24-July 15, dropping his average to a season-low .245.

RYAN REBOUNDING: Over his last five games since July 17, **Ryan Howard** is batting .316 (6-for-19) with a triple and three RBIs. He hit .194 with the Flying Squirrels to open the season through May 8 before being promoted to Triple-A Sacramento. He returned to Richmond on June 25 and went hitless in his first five games back (0-for-14). He followed with a six-game hitting streak from June 30-July 5, during which he hit .348 (8-for-32). Over his next eight games from July 6-16, Howard hit .037 (1-for-27).

GRAND LARCENY: This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 91 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 37 steals this year. **Jalen Miller** is third with 21. In 18 games dating back to July 1, the Flying Squirrels have stolen 13 bases. The team stole 37 bases in the month of June. Fargas is tied for the third-most steals in a season in franchise history and has the fifth-most career steals in team history.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America's* Mid-Season Top-30 prospects: **Logan Webb** (7 - suspended), **Melvin Adon** (18), **Garrett Williams** (20) and **Raffi Vizcaino** (25). There are also six players included on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list, including: Webb (4), Adon (13), Williams (18), **Ryan Howard** (27), **Jalen Miller** (28) and **Jacob Heyward** (30).
