YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels were swept in a double-header by the Bowie Baysox, 5-0 and 2-0. In Game 1, **Garrett Williams** worked through four scoreless innings before the Baysox scored a pair of runs in the fifth to take a 2-0 lead. Bowie added three runs in the seventh to pull ahead, 5-0. **Bruce Zimmermann** pitched his second complete-game shutout this season. In Game 2, **Ryan Halstead** and **Chase Johnson** combined to hold Bowie off the board through the first six innings, but the Baysox scored two runs in the top of the seventh with two outs. The Flying Squirrels did not have a hit until two outs in the last inning, when **Jacob Heyward** flared a single to right field to break up the combined no-hit bid by Cody Sedlock and Cristian Alvarado.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the third of a four-game, three-day series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. It's also the seventh of an eight-game, seven-day homestand against Erie (1-3) and Bowie (0-2). This series is Bowie's second trip to Richmond this season. The two teams split a rain-shortened, two-game series from April 9-10. The Flying Squirrels are 21-41 this season in games following a loss.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost five of six on the current homestand after winning three of the last four on the last road trip. Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .219 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.84 team ERA, which is 11th in the circuit. Richmond's -119 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Portland at -22). The previous franchise-worst is -80 in 2017.

THE BAYSOX have won eight of their last ten games since July 14 and have posted a 16-4 record in the month of July. This month, the Baysox lead the league with a 2.51 team ERA and rank first in the league with a .275 team batting average. Bowie has won 13 consecutive series dating back to June 4. For the season, Bowie ranks third in the league with a .245 team batting average and third with a 3.31 team ERA. Bowie's roster includes 11 of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including Yusniel Diaz (4), Ryan McKenna (7), Zac Lowther (8), Dean Kremer (9), Dillon Tate (17), Zach Pop (19 - on IL), Rylan Bannon (21), Michael Baumann (24), Alex Wells (25), Cody Sedlock (26) and Mason McCoy (30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Keyvius Sampson** makes his second start of the season for the Flying Squirrels. In his Richmond debut on Friday, Sampson allowed one run over 3.0 innings before the game was delayed by rain, ending his outing. He also made three starts and one relief appearance in the Arizona League with the AZL Giants Black on a rehab assignment. After allowing four runs in his first 1.2 innings, Sampson did not allow a run in his final 9.1 innings on the mound. Sampson spent the 2018 season in the Korea Baseball Organization with the Hanwha Eagles, where he went 13-8 with a 4.68 ERA. He led the league with 195 strikeouts and led all pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) with 10.86 SO/9 IP. Sampson was originally drafted by the San Diego Padres in the fourth round in 2009 and made his MLB debut with the Cincinnati Reds in 2015. *For more on Sampson, see page two.*

FOR BOWIE: Left-hander **Dean Kremer** makes his 12th start of the season for the Baysox and his first against the Flying Squirrels. In his last start, Kremer pitched 7.0 scoreless innings against Altoona on Friday in a win. It was his third outing this season for the Baysox in which he has pitched 7.0 innings without allowing a run. Kremer has won five of his last six starts, going 5-0 with a 1.89 ERA (7 ER/33.1 IP) since June 22. He joined the Baysox on May 21 and went 0-3 with a 6.89 ERA in his first three Double-A starts. Since then, he has gone 6-1 with a 2.14 ERA (11 ER/46.1 IP) in eight starts dating back to June 11. Kremer was selected by the Dodgers in the 14th round in 2016 out of UNLV. He was traded to the Orioles on July 18, 2018 along with Breyvic Valera, Yusniel Diaz, Zach Pop and Rylan Bannon in exchange for Manny Machado.

HIGHS AND LOWS: The Flying Squirrels have been shut out in three of the six games on the current homestand and have come one out away from being no-hit twice. Over seven games from July 5 (G2)-July 14 (1-6 record), the Flying Squirrels hit .154 (31-for-202). On July 16 and 17, the team combined for 28 hits in two games, including a season-high 15 last Wednesday in Hartford. After being held to six total hits against Erie from July 18-19, the Richmond offense had 19 hits in the next two games from July 20-21. Over the next two games in Monday's double-header, the Flying Squirrels were held scoreless and collected six total hits. The Richmond offense has not scored in 18 consecutive innings.

PITCHERS' DELIGHT: The 2019 season has been the "Year of the Pitcher" in the Eastern League. There have been seven no-hitters thrown in the league this year, two shy of the record nine no-hitters in 1967. On the season, the league has combined for a 3.58 ERA, the second-lowest in all of minor league baseball, down from last year's mark of 4.01 and the lowest in the EL since 1990 (3.33). The league's offenses have combined to hit .238, lowest of all MiLB full-season leagues, which is down from .253 last season and the lowest in the EL since 1971 (.234). Richmond's offense has been held to a .219 batting average, which would be tied for the seventh-lowest (with 1967 Binghamton Triangles, 1967 Williamsport Mets and 1975 Trois-Rivières Aigles) since the EL became a Double-A circuit in 1963. The last time a team had a lower batting average in the Eastern League was the 1972 Elmira Pioneers (.218).

A SERIES OF UNFORTUNATE EVENTS: On the season, the Flying Squirrels have won five series, lost 20 and split five. Four of their five series wins have come on the road. Richmond had lost three straight series prior to winning two-of-three in Hartford this week, their first series win since a three-game sweep in Binghamton from June 21-23. They followed with a series loss to Erie over the weekend.

TROUBLE AT HOME: Since May 23, the Flying Squirrels have gone 6-22 in 28 home games. Richmond has lost seven of the last eight home series since May 21, with the only exception being a four-game split against Hartford from June 27-30. After starting the year 5-2 at home through April 18, Richmond has posted a 10-35 record in 45 games at The Diamond since April 20. Richmond's only home series win this year was their first set of the season when they won three-of-four against Hartford from April 4-7. Away from The Diamond, the Flying Squirrels are 8-6 in their last 14 road games since June 20.

A LITTLE RELIEF: Over the last 39 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 2.74 ERA (43 ER/141.1 IP) with 142 strikeouts and 61 walks. On the season, Richmond's 3.76 bullpen ERA is the second-highest in the league. **Ryan Halstead** has gone 1-2 with a 0.89 ERA (3 ER/30.1 IP) in his last 19 games since May 5. **Melvin Adon** has posted a 1.08 ERA (3 ER/25.0) in 20 games since May 19 with 10 saves in 11 attempts, adding 34 strikeouts and 11 walks. **Tyler Cyr** has posted a 0.89 ERA (2 ER/20.1 IP) in his last 14 games since June 5. **Raffi Vizcaino** has a 1.04 ERA (2 ER/17.1 IP) in his last 11 appearances since June 11. **Caleb Simpson** has a 1.54 ERA (2 ER/11.2 IP) in his last ten outings since June 18. **Carlos Navas** has combined for a 0.90 ERA (2 ER/20.0 IP) in his 10 total appearances with the Flying Squirrels this year. **Chase Johnson** has a 2.81 ERA (8 ER/25.2 IP) in his last 14 games since May 31.

NICE START, BRYCE: Outfielder **Bryce Johnson** was promoted to the Flying Squirrels on June 25 from A-Adv. San Jose. After going 0-for-4 in his Double-A debut on June 26, Johnson collected seven hits over his next three days. From June 27-July 17, Johnson posted an 18-game on-base streak, during which he hit .356 (21-for-59) with five doubles, a triple, three homers and 13 RBIs. He is batting .284 overall since joining the Eastern League, but is batting .111 (2-for-18) over his last five games.

RYAN REBOUNDING: Over his last seven games since July 17, **Ryan Howard** is batting .318 (7-for-22) with a triple and three RBIs. He hit .194 with the Flying Squirrels to open the season through May 8 before being promoted to Triple-A Sacramento. He returned to Richmond on June 25 and went hitless in his first five games back (0-for-14). He followed with a six-game hitting streak from June 30-July 5, during which he hit .348 (8-for-32). Over his next eight games from July 6-16, Howard hit .037 (1-for-27).

GRAND LARCENY: This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 91 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 37 steals this year. **Jalen Miler** is third with 21. In 18 games dating back to July 1, the Flying Squirrels have stolen 13 bases. The team stole 37 bases in the month of June. Fargas is tied for the third-most steals in a season in franchise history and has the fifth-most career steals in team history.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America's* Mid-Season Top-30 prospects: **Logan Webb** (7 - suspended), **Melvin Adon** (18), **Garrett Williams** (20) and **Raffi Vizcaino** (25). There are also six players included on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list, including: Webb (4), Adon (13), Williams (18), **Ryan Howard** (27), **Jalen Miler** (28) and **Jacob Heyward** (30).
