**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels snapped a four-game losing streak with a 3-1 win over the Altoona Curve at PNG Field. In the first inning, Altoona's Logan Hill brought in the first run with an RBI double, the only run allowed by **Brandon Lawson** over his 6.0 innings. The Flying Squirrels tied the game in the third with an RBI single by **Jacob Heyward**. In the fourth, **Bryce Johnson** put the Flying Squirrels ahead with an RBI single. **Gio Brusa** singled in an insurance run in the seventh. **Tyler Cyr** worked two perfect relief innings and **Melvin Adon** closed out his 14th save, which ties him for fifth in a season in franchise history.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the second of a four-game road series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. Tonight's game is the 15th of 21 total match-ups between the two teams this season. Altoona won two of three at The Diamond from April 18-20, two of three in Altoona from April 26-28, three of four in Richmond from May 2-5 and two of three in Richmond from May 24-26. The Flying Squirrels are 14-22 in games following a win this season.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have lost six of their last eight games since July 21. Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .219 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.84 team ERA, which is 11th in the circuit. Richmond's -124 run differential is last in the league (next closest is New Hampshire at -21). The previous franchise-worst is -80 in 2017.

**THE CURVE** have lost four consecutive games since Monday and 10 of the last 13 since July 14. Altoona's offense is ranked tied for fourth in the league with a .242 batting average. The team's pitching staff is ranked eighth in the league with a 3.69 ERA on the year. Altoona's roster includes four of MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects, including Jared Oliva (9), Stephen Alemais (22 - on IL), Cody Bolton (23) and Blake Cederlind (30).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander **Caleb Baragar** makes his 14th start for the Flying Squirrels this season and his second against Altoona. In his last start, Baragar allowed a Double-A-high five runs over 6.0 innings in a no-decision against Erie on Saturday. He last faced the Curve on June 25 at The Diamond and picked up a loss after allowing four runs over 4.1 innings, his shortest start with Richmond. Over his last five starts since June 25, Baragar has gone 0-3 with a 5.53 ERA (17 ER/27.2 IP). In his previous seven starts from May 19-June 20, Baragar went 2-0 with a 2.27 ERA (10 ER/39.2 IP). Prior to joining Richmond, Baragar made one start with Triple-A Sacramento on May 2 and allowed five runs over 4.1 innings in a no-decision. He began the season with A-Adv. San Jose and went 0-1 with a 2.70 ERA in four starts and one relief outing. Baragar was drafted by the Giants in the ninth round in 2016 out of Indiana University and is in his fourth professional season. **For more on Baragar, see page two.**

**FOR ALTOONA:** Left-hander Sean Brady makes his 15th start of the season with Altoona and his first against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, Brady allowed six runs on 10 hits, both tied for the most since he joined Altoona, in a no-decision at Bowie on Sunday. Over his previous seven starts from June 12-July 16, Brady went 1-3 with a 2.40 ERA (12 ER/45.0 IP). Brady started the season with the Indians organization, splitting time between Triple-A Columbus and Double-A Akron. He was released on May 1 and signed with the Pirates on May 6. He spent most of 2018 with Akron, going 7-7 with a 4.53 ERA in 27 starts.

**HIGHS AND LOWS:** The Flying Squirrels were shut out in three of the seven games on the last homestand and came one out away from being no-hit twice. Over seven games from July 5 (G2)-July 14 (1-6 record), the Flying Squirrels hit .154 (31-for-202). On July 16 and 17, the team combined for 28 hits in two games, including a season-high 15 last Wednesday in Hartford. After being held to six total hits against Erie from July 18-19, the Richmond offense had 19 hits in the next two games from July 20-21. In the three-game series against the Baysox from July 22-24, the Flying Squirrels were shut out twice and outscored 15-1, batting .143 (11-for-77) for the series. The team snapped a 261-inning scoreless streak with a homer by **Gio Brusa** in the ninth on Wednesday afternoon. In Thursday's series-opening win at Altoona, the Flying Squirrels offense again reached 10 hits.

**PITCHERS' DELIGHT:** The 2019 season has been the "Year of the Pitcher" in the Eastern League. There have been seven no-hitters thrown in the league this year, two shy of the record nine no-hitters in 1967. On the season, the league has combined for a 3.59 ERA, the second-lowest in all of minor league baseball, down from last year's mark of 4.01 and the lowest in the EL since 1990 (3.33). The league's offenses have combined to hit .239, lowest of all MiLB full-season leagues, which is down from .253 last season and the lowest in the EL since 1971 (.234). Richmond's offense has been held to a .219 batting average, which would be tied for the seventh-lowest (1967 Williamsport Mets, 1967 Binghamton Triples & 1975 Trois-Rivieres Aigles) since the EL became a Double-A circuit in 1963. The last time a team had a lower batting average in the Eastern League in 1971 (Elmira Pioneers - .218).

**A SERIES OF UNFORTUNATE EVENTS:** On the season, the Flying Squirrels have won five series, lost 21 and split five. Four of their five series wins have come on the road. Richmond had lost three straight series prior to winning two-of-three in Hartford last week, their first series win since a three-game sweep in Binghamton from June 21-23. They followed with a series loss to Erie over the weekend and a three-game sweep by Bowie from Monday through Wednesday.

**TROUBLE AT HOME:** Since May 23, the Flying Squirrels have gone 6-23 in 29 home games. Richmond has lost eight of the last nine home series since May 21, with the only exception being a four-game split against Hartford from June 27-30. After starting the year 5-2 at home through April 18, Richmond has posted a 10-36 record in 46 games at The Diamond since April 20. Richmond's only home series win the year was their first set of the season when they won three-of-four against Hartford from April 4-7. Away from The Diamond, the Flying Squirrels are 9-6 in their last 15 road games since June 20.

**A LITTLE RELIEF:** Over the last 41 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 2.71 ERA (45 ER/149.2 IP) with 149 strikeouts and 64 walks. On the season, Richmond's 3.73 bullpen ERA is the second-highest in the league. **Ryan Halstead** has gone 1-2 with a 0.89 ERA (3 ER/30.1 IP) in his last 19 games since May 5. **Melvin Adon** has posted a 1.00 ERA (3 ER/27.0) in 22 games since May 19 with 11 saves in 12 attempts, adding 34 strikeouts and 11 walks. **Tyler Cyr** has posted a 0.81 ERA (2 ER/22.1 IP) in his last 15 games since June 5. **Raffi Vizcaino** has a 0.95 ERA (2 ER/19.0 IP) in his last 12 appearances since June 11. **Caleb Simpson** has a 1.54 ERA (2 ER/11.2 IP) in his last ten outings since June 18. **Carlos Navas** has combined for a 1.66 ERA (4 ER/21.2 IP) in his 11 total appearances with the Flying Squirrels this year. **Chase Johnson** has a 2.81 ERA (8 ER/25.2 IP) in his last 14 games since May 31.

**NICE START, BRYCE:** Outfielder **Bryce Johnson** was promoted to the Flying Squirrels on June 25 from A-Adv. San Jose. After going 0-for-4 in his Double-A debut on June 26, Johnson collected seven hits over his next three days. From June 27-July 17, Johnson posted an 18-game on-base streak, during which he hit .356 (21-for-59) with five doubles, a triple, three homers and 13 RBIs. However, from July 18-22, Johnson hit .111 (2-for-18). He is batting .375 (3-for-8) over his last two games.

**RYAN REBOUNDING:** Over his last nine games since July 17, **Ryan Howard** is batting .345 (10-for-29) with a triple and three RBIs. He hit .194 with the Flying Squirrels to open the season through May 8 before being promoted to Triple-A Sacramento. He returned to Richmond on June 25 and went hitless in his first five games back (0-for-14). He followed with a six-game hitting streak from June 30-July 5, during which he hit .348 (8-for-32). Over his next eight games from July 6-16, Howard hit .037 (1-for-27).

**HEYWARD HEATING UP:** Over his last 11 games since July 14, **Jacob Heyward** is batting .278 (10-for-36) with four doubles and five RBIs. He now leads the team with 33 RBIs and 18 doubles on the season.

**GRAND LARCENY:** This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 92 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 39 steals this year. **Jalen Miller** is tied for third with 21. In 22 games dating back to July 1, the Flying Squirrels have stolen 15 bases. The team stole 37 bases in the month of June. Fargas has the second-most steals in a season in franchise history, trailing only the 49 by **Kelby Tomlinson** in 2014, and is tied for the fourth-most career steals in team history.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America's* Mid-Season Top-30 prospects: **Logan Webb** (7 - suspended), **Melvin Adon** (18), **Garrett Williams** (20) and **Raffi Vizcaino** (25). There are also six players included on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list, including: Webb (4), Adon (13), Williams (18), **Ryan Howard** (27), **Jalen Miller** (28) and **Jacob Heyward** (30).
