SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels saw their three-game winning streak snapped with a 3-1 loss in the road-trip finale against the Altoona Curve. Richmond scored in the first inning for the third time in the four-game series. **Peter Maris** hit an RBI single to bring in **Bryce Johnson** in the top of the first against starter Cody Bolton. Altoona answered in the bottom of the first with an RBI single by Chris Sharpe. In the fourth, Brett Pope put the Curve ahead with an RBI single. Bralin Jackson added an insurance run with a pinch-hit, RBI single in the sixth. In his first Double-A start since April, **Logan Webb** worked 4.2 innings and allowed two runs with six strikeouts.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a three-game home series against the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. This series is Portland's first and only trip to Richmond this season. The two teams previously met for a three-game set in Portland from June 4-6 and Richmond won two of the three games. This series marks Richmond's final set of the year against a team from the Eastern Division.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS won three of four games on the last road trip after losing six of seven on the last homestand. Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .219 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.82 team ERA, which is 11th in the circuit. Richmond's -123 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Portland at -23). The previous franchise-worst is -80 in 2017.

THE SEA DOGS have lost four of their last six games since last Wednesday, including dropping three-of-four at Harrisburg over the weekend. The Portland pitching staff has a 3.15 ERA in the month of July, which is third-best in the league. Overall for the season, Sea Dogs pitchers have combined for a 3.76 ERA, which is tenth in the Eastern League. The Portland offense is ranked ninth in the circuit with a .237 batting average. The Sea Dogs' roster includes eight of MLB.com's Top-30 Red Sox prospects, including Bobby Dalbec (2), Bryan Mata (3), Jarren Duran (4), C.J. Chatham (10), Durbin Feltman (17), Marcus Wilson (18), Eduard Bazarzo (26) and Denyi Reyes (27).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Brandon Lawson** makes his 18th start with the Flying Squirrels and his first against the Sea Dogs. Last time out, Lawson worked 6.0 innings and allowed one run in a win at Altoona on Thursday. Over his last three starts since July 14, Lawson has gone 2-0 with a 1.35 ERA (3 ER/20.0 IP). In his last eight starts since June 13, Lawson has gone 2-3 with a 3.00 ERA (16 ER/48.0 IP) and has helped opposing teams to four-or-less earned runs in all but one outing. Lawson was signed as a minor-league free agent by the Giants on April 23 after being released by the Tampa Bay Rays near the end of spring training. He was originally drafted by the Rays in the 12th round in 2016 out of the University of South Florida and reached Double-A for 14 outings (five starts) last season with the Montgomery Biscuits. **For more on Lawson, see page two.**

FOR PORTLAND: Right-hander Bryan Mata makes his sixth start of the season for the Sea Dogs. In his most recent start, Mata matched a season high with 6.0 innings pitched and allowed two runs (one earned) in a loss against Hartford on Wednesday. Mata began the season with A-Adv. Salem and went 3-1 with a 1.75 ERA in 10 starts. He was promoted to Double-A on July 1 and won his debut the next day with 6.0 innings and one run allowed against Trenton. He has lost three of his four starts since. Mata is currently ranked by MLB.com as the No. 3 Red Sox prospect and he pitched in the 2018 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Nationals Park last July.

PITCHERS' DELIGHT: The 2019 season has been the "Year of the Pitcher" in the Eastern League. There have been seven no-hitters thrown in the league this year, two shy of the record nine no-hitters in 1967. On the season, the league has combined for a 3.59 ERA, the second-lowest in all of minor league baseball's full-season leagues, down from last year's mark of 4.01 and the lowest in the EL since 1990 (3.33). The league's offenses have combined to hit .239, tied with the South Atlantic League for the lowest of all MiLB full-season leagues, which is down from .253 last season and the lowest in the EL since 1971 (.234). Richmond's offense has been held to a .219 batting average, which would be tied for the seventh-lowest (1967 Williamsport Mets, 1967 Binghamton Triples & 1975 Trois-Rivieres Aigles) since the EL became a Double-A circuit in 1963. The last time a team had a lower batting average in the Eastern League in 1971 (Elmira Pioneers - .218).

A SERIES OF UNFORTUNATE EVENTS: On the season, the Flying Squirrels have won six series, lost 21 and split five. Five of their six series wins have come on the road. Richmond had lost three straight series prior to winning two-of-three in Hartford from July 15-17, their first series win since a three-game sweep in Binghamton from June 21-23. They followed with a series loss to Erie from July 18-21 and a three-game sweep by Bowie from July 22-24, but won three of four in Altoona over the weekend.

TROUBLE AT HOME: Since May 23, the Flying Squirrels have gone 6-23 in 29 home games. Richmond has lost eight of the last nine home series since May 21, with the only exception being a four-game split against Hartford from June 27-30. After starting the year 5-2 at home through April 18, Richmond has posted a 10-36 record in 46 games at The Diamond since April 20. Richmond's only home series win the year was their first set of the season when they won three-of-four against Hartford from April 4-7. Away from The Diamond, the Flying Squirrels are 11-7 in their last 18 road games since June 20.

A LITTLE RELIEF: Over the last 44 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 2.60 ERA (47 ER/163.0 IP) with 152 strikeouts and 69 walks. On the season, Richmond's 3.65 bullpen ERA is the second-highest in the league. **Ryan Halstead** has gone 1-2 with a 0.86 ERA (3 ER/31.1 IP) in his last 20 games since May 5. **Melvin Adon** has posted a 1.00 ERA (3 ER/27.0 IP) in 22 games since May 19 with 11 saves in 12 attempts, adding 34 strikeouts and 11 walks. **Tyler Cyr** has posted a 0.81 ERA (2 ER/22.1 IP) in his last 15 games since June 5. **Raffi Vizcaino** has a 1.35 ERA (3 ER/20.0 IP) in his last 13 appearances since June 11. **Caleb Simpson** has a 1.39 ERA (2 ER/13.0 IP) in his last 11 outings since June 18. **Carlos Navas** has combined for a 1.52 ERA (4 ER/23.2 IP) in his 12 total appearances with the Flying Squirrels this year. **Chase Johnson** has a 2.51 ERA (8 ER/28.2 IP) in his last 15 games since May 31.

NICE START, BRYCE: Outfielder **Bryce Johnson** was promoted to the Flying Squirrels on June 25 from A-Adv. San Jose. After going 0-for-4 in his Double-A debut on June 26, Johnson collected seven hits over his next three days. From June 27-July 17, Johnson posted an 18-game on-base streak, during which he hit .356 (21-for-59) with five doubles, a triple, three homers and 13 RBIs. However, from July 18-22, Johnson hit .111 (2-for-18). He is batting .368 (7-for-19) over his last five games.

RYAN REBOUNDING: Over his last 12 games since July 17, **Ryan Howard** is batting .385 (15-for-39) with a triple, a double and four RBIs. He hit 194 with the Flying Squirrels to open the season through May 8 before being promoted to Triple-A Sacramento. He returned to Richmond on June 25 and went hitless in his first five games back (0-for-14). He followed with a six-game hitting streak from June 30-July 5, during which he hit .348 (8-for-32). Over his next eight games from July 6-16, Howard hit .037 (1-for-27).

GRAND LARCENY: This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 100 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 40 steals this year. **Jalen Miller** is fifth with 21. In 25 games dating back to July 1, the Flying Squirrels have stolen 20 bases. The team stole 37 bases in the month of June. Fargas has the second-most steals in a season in franchise history, trailing only the 49 by **Kelby Tomlinson** in 2014, and has the third-most career steals in team history.

HOME IS WHERE THE HOMERS AREN'T: The Flying Squirrels have hit 17 home runs at home this season through 53 games (0.32 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games). The Flying Squirrels have ranked last in the league in home runs hit at home each of the last two seasons and three of the last four years. Entering 2019, the Flying Squirrels averaged 0.49 home runs per home game for the franchise's first nine seasons. The lowest single-season home homer rate was in 2015 (20 HR/71 Home Games/0.28 per game). Richmond has hit one home run in its last 14 home games since June 28. Opposing teams have hit just five at The Diamond in the same time frame.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America's* Mid-Season Top-30 prospects: **Logan Webb** (7), **Melvin Adon** (18), **Garrett Williams** (20) and **Raffi Vizcaino** (25). There are also three players included on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list, including: Webb (5), Adon (14) and Williams (26).
