YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels dropped their fourth straight game, falling 4-3 to the Portland Sea Dogs to cap a three-game sweep at The Diamond. Bobby Dalbec drove in the game's first run with a single in the first inning for Portland. Richmond tied the score at 1-1 in the second with an RBI single by Hamlet Marte. In the sixth, Portland pulled ahead, 2-1, when Jarred Duran scored on a wild pitch and Luke Tendler pushed the lead to 4-1 with a two-run single. Jonah Arenado singled home a run in the sixth and Johneshwy Fargas hit an RBI single in the seventh to close the gap to 4-3. Portland relievers Durbin Feltman and Jordan Weems held Richmond off the scoreboard in the final two innings.

VIRRELS

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a three-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. It is also the first of a seven-game road trip to Harrisburg and Altoona. The Flying Squirrels have lost all three previous series against the Senators this season, including dropping three of four in Harrisburg from July 11-14 in the last meetings between the two teams.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost four straight games after winning the first three on last weekend's road trip to Altoona. In the current losing streak, Richmond has been outscored 20-9 by Altoona and Portland. The Flying Squirrels have allowed runs in the first two innings in each of the last four games (9 total runs over the first two innings). Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .219 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.85 team ERA, which is 11th in the circuit. Richmond's -132 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Trenton at -19). The previous franchise-worst is .80 in 2017

THE SENATORS have lost two games in a row after winning eight of nine from July 23-30. The Senators are ranked eighth in the league with a .240 team batting average this season and fourth with a 3.40 ERA. The Senators clinched the Western Division First-Half title on June 12 in Richmond to lock up a spot in the Eastern League playoffs. The Senators opened the season with a 21-4 record through the end of April, their best start in franchise history. Harrisburg's roster includes five of MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects, including Luis Garcia (2), Tres Barrera (18), Steven Fuentes (21 - suspended), Jackson Tetreault (24) and Jhonathan German (28).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Logan Webb makes his seventh start of the season for the Flying Squirrels and his first against the Senators. Last time out, Webb made his first Double-A start since April and allowed two runs over 4.2 innings in a loss at Altoona on Sunday night. Webb received an 80-game suspension for a positive test for Dehydrochlormethyltestosterone (DHCMT), handed down as part of the Major League Baseball Joint Drug Prevention and Treatment Program. He made three rehab appearances between the rookie-level Arizona League Giants Orange and Single-A Augusta, going 1-0 with a 1.20 ERA (2 ER/15.0 IP). Webb was drafted by the Giants in the fourth round in 2014 out of Rocklin (Calif.) High School. For more on Webb,

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Tyler Mapes makes his 20th start of the season for the Senators and his second against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on Sunday at Portland and allowed four runs (three earned) on nine his over 5.2 innings in a no-decision. He faced the Richmond on July 12 at FNB Field and allowed two runs over 5.0 innings in a no-decision, his most recent home start. Mapes is in his third season with the Senators dating back to 2016. In 52 career starts for the Senators, Mapes has gone 17-17 with a 3.91 ERA. He was drafted by the Nationals in the 30th round in 2014 out of Tulane.

PITCHERS' DELIGHT: The 2019 season has been the "Year of the Pitcher" in the Eastern League. There have been eight no-hitters thrown in the league this year, one shy of the record nine no-hitters in 1967. On the season, the league has combined for a 3.58 ERA, the second-lowest in all of minor league baseball's full-season leagues, down from last year's mark of 4.01 and the lowest in the EL since 1990 (3.33). The league's offenses have combined to hit .239, tied for the lowest of all Mil.B full-season leagues, which is down from .253 last season and the lowest in the EL since 1971 (.234). Richmond's offense has been held to a .219 batting average, which would be tied for the seventh-lowest (1967 Williamsport Mets, 1967 Binghamton Triples & 1975 Trois-Rivieres Aigles) since the EL became a Double-A circuit in 1963. The last time a team had a lower batting average in the Eastern League in 1971 (Elmira Pioneers - .218).

A SERIES OF UNFORTUNATE EVENTS: On the season, the Flying Squirrels have won six series, lost 22 and split five. Five of their six series wins have come on the road. The Flying Squirrels have lost four straight home sets but have won their last two road series, including taking three of four from July 25-28 in Altoona.

**TROUBLE AT HOME:** Since May 23, the Flying Squirrels have gone 6-26 in 32 home games. Richmond has lost nine of the last 10 home series since May 21, with the only exception being a four-game split against Hartford from June 27-30. After starting the year 5-2 at home through April 18, Richmond has posted a 10-39 record in 49 games at The Diamond since April 20. Richmond's only home series win the year was their first set of the season when they won three-of-four against Hartford from April 4-7. Away from The Diamond, the Flying Squirrels are 11-7 in their last 18 road games since June 20.

A LITTLE RELIEF: Over the last 47 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 2.59 ERA (49 ER/170.0 IP) with 155 strikeouts and 72 walks. On the season, Richmond's 3.63 bullpen ERA is the second-highest in the league. Ryan Halstead has gone 1-2 with a 1.11 ERA (4 ER/32.1 IP) in his last 21 games since May 5. Melvin Adon has posted a 1.00 ERA (3 ER/27.0) in 22 games since May 19 with 11 saves in 12 attempts, adding 34 strikeouts and 11 walks. Tyler Cyr has posted a 1.56 ERA (3 ER/23.1 IP) in his last 16 games since June 5. Raffi Vizcaino has a 1.25 ERA (3 ER/21.2 IP) in his last 14 appearances since June 11. Caleb Simpson has a 1.20 ERA (2 ER/15.0 IP) in his last 12 outings since June 18. Carlos Navas has combined for a 1.52 ERA (4 ER/23.2 IP) in his 12 total appearances with the Flying Squirrels this year. Chase Johnson has a 2.35 ERA (8 ER/30.2 IP) in his last 16 games since May 31.

RYAN REBOUNDING: Over his last 15 games since July 17, Ryan Howard is batting .314 (16-for-51) with a triple, a double and four RBIs. However, he is batting .077 (1-for-13) over his lat four games. He hit .194 with the Flying Squirrels to open the season through May 8 before being promoted to Triple-A Sacramento. He returned to Richmond on June 25 and went hitless in his first five games back (0-for-14). He followed with a six-game hitting streak from June 30-July 5, during which he hit .348 (8-for-32). Over his next eight games from July 6-16, Howard hit .037 (1-for-27).

**GRAND LARCENY:** This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 100 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 40 steals this year. **Jalen Miller** is fifth with 21. In 26 games dating back to July 1, the Flying Squirrels have stolen 20 bases. The team stole 37 bases in the month of June. Fargas has the second-most steals in a season in franchise history, trailing only the 49 by **Kelby Tomlinson** in 2014, and has the third-most career steals in team history.

WALK THIS WAY: On the year, Jacob Heyward has worked 56 walks, which is third-most in the league. He has walked three times over his last two games. His 56 walks are the fifth-most in a season in Flying Squirrels franchise history. The four ahead of him on the list all set their marks during the 2013 season (Mark Minicozzi - 62, Jarrett Parker - 60, Joe Panik - 58 and Javier Herrera - 57).

HOME IS WHERE THE HOMERS AREN'T: The Flying Squirrels have hit 19 home runs at home this season through 56 games (0.34 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games). The Flying Squirrels have ranked last in the league in home runs hit at home each of the last two seasons and three of the last four years. Entering 2019, the Flying Squirrels averaged 0.49 home runs per home game for the franchise's first nine seasons. The lowest single-season home homer rate was in 2015 (20 HR/71 Home Games/0.28 per game). Richmond hit one homer in its 14 home games fron June 28-July 24, but have homered in back-to-back home games.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America*'s Mid-Season Top-30 prospects: **Logan Webb** (7), **Melvin Adon** (18), **Garrett Williams** (20) and **Raffi Vizcaino** (25). There are also three players included on MLB. com's top-30 Giants prospect list, including: Webb (5), Adon (14) and Williams (26).
