YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels fell for the fifth straight game with an 11-2 loss to the Harrisburg Senators, matching the largest loss against the Senators in franchise history. Starting pitcher **Logan Webb** allowed 10 runs, all unearned, setting a franchise record for unearned runs allowed in a game. It was also the fifth time in team history a pitcher has allowed 10 or more runs in an outing. On the first two pitches of the game from Harrisburg starter Tyler Mapes, **Bryce Johnson** and **Ryan Howard** combined for a pair of doubles to plate the game's first run. **Jonah Arenado** added an RBI single later in the first to open a 2-0 lead. Harrisburg scored seven runs in the third inning, aided by two Richmond errors and capped by a grand slam from Rhett Wiseman. The Senators added three runs in the fourth and another run in the sixth to open an 11-3 lead. Johnson and Howard each had two hits. **Caleb Simpson** worked 2.0 scoreless innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a three-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. It is also the second of a seven-game road trip to Harrisburg (0-1) and Altoona. The Flying Squirrels have lost all three previous series against the Senators this season, including dropping three of four in Harrisburg from July 11-14 in the last meetings between the two teams. The Senators have outscored the Flying Squirrels, 61-25, on the year. A loss in today's game would match the longest losing streak of the season for the Flying Squirrels at six games.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost five straight games after winning the first three on last weekend's road trip to Altoona. In the current losing streak, Richmond has been outscored 31-2 by Altoona, Portland and Harrisburg. The Flying Squirrels have allowed runs in the first three innings in each of the last five games (16 total runs over the first three innings). Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .220 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.83 team ERA, which is 11th in the circuit. Richmond's -141 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Hartford at -18). The previous franchise-worst is -80 in 2017.

THE SENATORS have won nine of 12 games since July 30. The Senators are ranked tied for seventh in the league with a .240 team batting average this season and fourth with a 3.39 ERA. The Senators clinched the Western Division First-Half title on June 12 in Richmond to lock up a spot in the Eastern League playoffs. The Senators opened the season with a 21-4 record through the end of April, their best start in franchise history. Harrisburg's roster includes five of MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects, including Luis Garcia (2), Tres Barrera (18), Steven Fuentes (21 - suspended), Jackson Tetreault (24) and Jhonathan German (28).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Garrett Williams** takes the mound for his 20th start of the season for the Flying Squirrels and his third against Harrisburg. He last pitched in relief on Sunday at Altoona, his first appearance out of the bullpen this year, and allowed one run over 2.1 innings. In his last start on July 22 against Bowie, Williams worked 6.1 innings and allowed four runs for the second straight start, but two of the runs scored in the seventh. He has faced the Senators twice (June 12 and July 12), posting a 2.89 ERA (3 ER/9.1 IP). He made 14 starts for Richmond last season and went 2-6 with a 6.00 ERA before moving to the bullpen when the calendar turned to July. As a reliever, he posted a 5.96 ERA in 18 appearances. Williams is ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 20 Giants prospect and No. 26 by MLB.com. **For more on Williams, see page two.**

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Mario Sanchez makes his 14th start of the season for the Senators and his third against the Flying Squirrels. Today is his first start since July 23 at New Hampshire, when he allowed two runs over 5.0 innings in a win. He was placed on the injured list on July 25. Over his last five starts, Sanchez has gone 3-2 with a 3.16 ERA. In his two starts against the Flying Squirrels this season, Sanchez is 2-0 with a 1.59 ERA. He began the season with the Senators and went 3-0 with a 1.04 ERA, alternating between starting and relieving. He spent four games with Triple-A Fresno from May 5-23 and returned to the Eastern League on May 29. Sanchez signed with the Nationals as a free agent over the offseason after spending seven years of his career with the Phillies, including the 2017 season with Reading.

PITCHERS' DELIGHT: The 2019 season has been the "Year of the Pitcher" in the Eastern League. There have been eight no-hitters thrown in the league this year, one shy of the record nine no-hitters in 1967. On the season, the league has combined for a 3.58 ERA, the second-lowest in all of minor league baseball's full-season leagues, down from last year's mark of 4.01 and the lowest in the EL since 1990 (3.33). The league's offenses have combined to hit .239, tied for the lowest of all MiLB full-season leagues, which is down from .253 last season and the lowest in the EL since 1971 (.234). Richmond's offense has been held to a .220 batting average, which would be tied for the tenth-lowest (1968 York Pirates) since the EL became a Double-A circuit in 1963.

A SERIES OF UNFORTUNATE EVENTS: On the season, the Flying Squirrels have won six series, lost 22 and split five. Five of their six series wins have come on the road. The Flying Squirrels have lost four straight home sets but have won their last two road series, including taking three of four from July 25-28 in Altoona.

TROUBLE AT HOME: Since May 23, the Flying Squirrels have gone 6-26 in 32 home games. Richmond has lost nine of the last 10 home series since May 21, with the only exception being a four-game split against Hartford from June 27-30. After starting the year 5-2 at home through April 18, Richmond has posted a 10-39 record in 49 games at The Diamond since April 20. Richmond's only home series win the year was their first set of the season when they won three-of-four against Hartford from April 4-7. Away from The Diamond, the Flying Squirrels are 11-8 in their last 19 road games since June 20.

A LITTLE RELIEF: Over the last 48 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 2.58 ERA (50 ER/174.1 IP) with 157 strikeouts and 72 walks. On the season, Richmond's 3.63 bullpen ERA is the second-highest in the league. **Ryan Halstead** has gone 1-2 with a 1.11 ERA (4 ER/32.1 IP) in his last 21 games since May 5. **Melvin Adon** has posted a 1.00 ERA (3 ER/27.0) in 22 games since May 19 with 11 saves in 12 attempts, adding 34 strikeouts and 11 walks. **Tyler Cyr** has posted a 1.56 ERA (3 ER/23.1 IP) in his last 16 games since June 5. **Raffi Vizcaino** has a 1.25 ERA (3 ER/21.2 IP) in his last 14 appearances since June 11. **Caleb Simpson** has a 1.06 ERA (2 ER/17.0 IP) in his last 13 outings since June 18. **Carlos Navas** has combined for a 1.73 ERA (5 ER/26.0 IP) in his 13 total appearances with the Flying Squirrels this year. **Chase Johnson** has a 2.35 ERA (8 ER/30.2 IP) in his last 16 games since May 31.

RYAN REBOUNDING: Over his last 16 games since July 17, **Ryan Howard** is batting .321 (18-for-56) with a triple, two doubles and five RBIs. However, he is batting .167 (3-for-18) over his last five games. He hit .194 with the Flying Squirrels to open the season through May 8 before being promoted to Triple-A Sacramento. He returned to Richmond on June 25 and went hitless in his first five games back (0-for-14). He followed with a six-game hitting streak from June 30-July 5, during which he hit .348 (8-for-32). Over his next eight games from July 6-16, Howard hit .037 (1-for-27).

GRAND LARCENY: This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 102 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 40 steals this year. Fargas has the fifth-most in a season in franchise history, trailing only the 49 by **Kelby Tomlinson** in 2014, and has the third-most career steals in team history. He is also ranked fifth in all of MLB and MiLB in steals on the year. **Jalen Miller** is tied for third in the league with 22.

WALK THIS WAY: On the year, **Jacob Heyward** has worked 56 walks, which is third-most in the league. He has walked three times over his last two games. His 56 walks are the fifth-most in a season in Flying Squirrels franchise history. The four ahead of him on the list all set their marks during the 2013 season (Mark Minicozzi - 62, Jarrett Parker - 60, Joe Panik - 58 and Javier Herrera - 57).

GOING UNDER: Friday's Flying Squirrels loss in Harrisburg pushed the team's overall record 30 games under .500, a new franchise-worst, at 39-69. This year's mark surpasses the previous low at 22 games under .500, which was reached three separate times during the 2016 season, most recently on August 10, 2016. The Flying Squirrels' -141 run differential is the third-worst in all of full-season MiLB (Nashville: -147, Columbia: -146). Richmond's .361 winning percentage is second-worst in full-season MiLB (West Michigan: -.321).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America's* Mid-Season Top-30 prospects: **Logan Webb** (7), **Melvin Adon** (18), **Garrett Williams** (20) and **Raffi Vizcaino** (25). There are also three players included on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list, including: Webb (5), Adon (14) and Williams (26).
