**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels and Altoona Curve were suspended due to rain in the bottom of the second inning with no score.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the completion of yesterday's rain suspended game, followed by tonight's regularly-scheduled game, which will now be seven innings. The Flying Squirrels play the second and third of a four-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. It is also the fifth and sixth of a seven-game road trip to Harrisburg (2-1) and Altoona (0-1). The Flying Squirrels have won three consecutive road series, taking two of three in Harrisburg (July 15-17), three of four in Altoona from July 25-27 and two of three in Harrisburg from August 2-4. This series is the sixth and final set between Richmond and Altoona. The Curve won the first four head-to-head series before the Flying Squirrels took the last series at PNG Field.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have lost six of their last eight games overall since a loss in Altoona last Sunday, but have won two of their last three on the current road trip. They have been outscored 20-13 on the current road trip, but have allowed 11 unearned runs. Over the last seven games, the Flying Squirrels have hit .239 (56-for-234) and are averaging 3.0 runs per game (21 total runs). Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .220 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.80 team ERA, which is 11th in the circuit. Richmond's -139 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Trenton at -25). The previous franchise-worst is -80 in 2017.

**THE CURVE** have gone 6-15 in their last 21 games since July 18. The Curve were swept in their last series in three games at Reading, and they were outscored 21-12 in that set. The Altoona pitching staff has combined for a 3.74 ERA this season, which is ranked eighth in the Eastern League. The Altoona offense is batting .240 this season, which is tied for fifth in the league. The Altoona roster includes four of MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects, including Oneil Cruz (3), Jared Oliva (11), Cody Bolton (13) and Blake Cederlind (29).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Logan Webb** will take the mound to begin the completion of last night's suspended game. It will be his first "relief" outing in Double-A. In his last start, Webb allowed a career-high 10 runs, all unearned, over 3.2 innings at Harrisburg. The 10 unearned runs allowed was a franchise record. On the year, Webb has made seven starts for the Flying Squirrels and has faced Altoona once, working 4.2 innings and allowing two runs in a loss on July 28. It was his first Double-A start since April after he received an 80-game suspension for a positive test for Dehydrochlormethyltestosterone (DHCHMT), handed down as part of the Major League Baseball Joint Drug Prevention and Treatment Program. He made three rehab appearances between the rookie-level Arizona League Giants Orange and Single-A Augusta, going 1-0 with a 1.20 ERA (2 ER/15.0 IP). Webb was drafted by the Giants in the fourth round in 2014 out of Rocklin (Calif.) High School. **For more on Webb, see page two.**

Right-hander **Carlos Navas** will start the regularly-scheduled game following the completion game. It will be his first start as a member of the Flying Squirrels. He has started five times this year, all with Triple-A Sacramento, going 0-2 with a 6.52 ERA. His longest outing came on June 4 at Oklahoma City, when he allowed six runs over 5.0 innings on a season-high 78 pitches.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Left-hander Sean Brady makes his 17th start for the Curve and his second against Richmond. Last time out, he worked 6.0 innings and allowed three runs (two earned) at Reading on Friday. He faced the Flying Squirrels on July 26 and worked a season-high-tying 7.0 innings and allowed five runs in a loss. Brady began the season with the Indians organization, splitting time between Double-A Akron and Triple-A Columbus before being released on May 1. He signed with the Pirates on May 6 and was assigned to Altoona.

**PITCHERS' DELIGHT:** The 2019 season has been the "Year of the Pitcher" in the Eastern League. There have been eight no-hitters thrown in the league this year, one shy of the record nine no-hitters in 1967. On the season, the league has combined for a 3.59 ERA, the second-lowest in all of minor league baseball's full-season leagues, down from last year's mark of 4.01 and the lowest in the EL since 1990 (3.33). The league's offenses have combined to hit .239, the lowest of all MiLB full-season leagues, which is down from .253 last season and the lowest in the EL since 1971 (.234). Richmond's offense has been held to a .220 batting average, which would be tied for the tenth-lowest (1968 York Pirates) since the EL became a Double-A circuit in 1963.

**A SERIES OF UNFORTUNATE EVENTS:** On the season, the Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost 22 and split five. Six of their seven series wins have come on the road. The Flying Squirrels have lost four straight home sets but have won their last three road series, including taking three of four from July 25-28 in Altoona and two of three in Harrisburg over the weekend.

**TROUBLE AT HOME:** Since May 23, the Flying Squirrels have gone 6-26 in 32 home games. Richmond has lost nine of the last 10 home series since May 21, with the only exception being a four-game split against Hartford from June 27-30. After starting the year 5-2 at home through April 18, Richmond has posted a 10-39 record in 49 games at The Diamond since April 20. Richmond's only home series win this year was their first set of the season when they won three-of-four against Hartford from April 4-7. Away from The Diamond, the Flying Squirrels are 13-8 in their last 21 road games since June 20.

**A LITTLE RELIEF:** Over the last 51 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 2.60 ERA (53 ER/183.1 IP) with 161 strikeouts and 76 walks. On the season, Richmond's 3.57 bullpen ERA is the second-highest in the league. **Ryan Halstead** has gone 1-2 with a 1.11 ERA (4 ER/32.1 IP) in his last 21 games since May 5. **Melvin Adon** has posted a 1.00 ERA (3 ER/27.0) in 22 games since May 19 with 11 saves in 12 attempts, adding 34 strikeouts and 11 walks. **Tyler Cyr** has posted a 1.04 ERA (3 ER/26.0 IP) in his last 18 games since June 5. **Raffi Vizcaino** has a 1.25 ERA (3 ER/21.2 IP) in his last 14 appearances since June 11. **Caleb Simpson** has a 1.96 ERA (4 ER/181 IP) in his last 14 outings since June 18. **Carlos Navas** has combined for a 1.73 ERA (5 ER/26.0 IP) in his 13 total appearances with the Flying Squirrels this year. **Chase Johnson** has a 2.41 ERA (9 ER/33.2 IP) in his last 17 games since May 31. **Sam Moll** has not allowed a run over his last four outings since June 21, totaling 4.1 IP.

**RYAN REBOUNDING:** Over his last 19 games since July 17, **Ryan Howard** is batting .297 (19-for-64) with a triple, two doubles and five RBIs. However, he is batting .154 (4-for-26) over his last eight games. He hit .194 with the Flying Squirrels to open the season through May 8 before being promoted to Triple-A Sacramento. He returned to Richmond on June 25 and went hitless in his first five games back (0-for-14). He followed with a six-game hitting streak from June 30-July 5, during which he hit .348 (8-for-32). Over his next eight games from July 6-16, Howard hit .037 (1-for-27).

**GRAND LARCENY:** This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 111 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 43 steals this year. Fargas has the second-most steals in a season in franchise history, trailing only the 49 by **Kelby Tomlinson** in 2014, and has the third-most career steals in team history. He is also ranked tied for third in all of MiLB and MiLB in steals on the year. **Jalen Miller** is third in the league with 24.

**FINDING THE FIRST-HALF MAGIC:** Over his last 10 games, **Jonah Arenado** is batting .275 (11-for-40) with three doubles. He posted a season-high seven-game hitting streak from July 26-August 2, but it was snapped with an 0-for-4 game on Saturday at Harrisburg. Arenado was batting .301 through June 8 (including a .348 average in April), but has hit .173 (32-for-185) in his 52 games since.

**WALK THIS WAY:** On the year, **Jacob Heyward** has worked 58 walks, which is third-most in the league. He has walked five times over his last seven games. His 58 walks are tied for third-most in a season in Flying Squirrels franchise history. The four others in the top-five on the list all set their marks during the 2013 season (Mark Minicozzi - 62, Jarrett Parker - 60, Joe Panik - 58 and Javier Herrera - 57).

**GOING UNDER:** Friday's Flying Squirrels loss in Harrisburg pushed the team's overall record 30 games under .500, a new franchise-worst, at 39-69. This year's mark surpasses the previous low at 22 games under .500, which was reached three separate times during the 2016 season, most recently on August 10, 2016. The Flying Squirrels' -138 run differential is tied for second-worst in all of full-season MiLB (Columbia: -139, Nashville: -151). Richmond's .369 winning percentage is third-worst in full-season MiLB (West Michigan: -.319, Mobile: -.366).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America's* Mid-Season Top-30 prospects: **Logan Webb** (7), **Melvin Adon** (18), **Garrett Williams** (20) and **Raffi Vizcaino** (25). There are also three players included on *MLB.com's* top-30 Giants prospect list, including: **Webb** (5), **Adon** (14) and **Williams** (26).
