YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels split a pair of games with the Altoona Curve. In the first game, the completion of Tuesday's rain-suspended game, Richmond held a 3-2 lead entering the ninth before an RBI single by Oneil Cruz tied the score and forced extras. Altoona walked off with a 4-3 win on a Jerrick Suiter RBI single in the bottom of the tenth. The Flying Squirrels opened a 2-0 lead in the third on RBI hits by **Jonah Arenado** and **Jalen Miller**. Altoona tied the game in the fifth with a two-run double by Arden Pabst. **Zach Houchins** put the Flying Squirrels back in the lead with an RBI double in the sixth. **Logan Webb** worked 6.0 innings and allowed two runs with six strikeouts. In the night's regularly-scheduled game, the Flying Squirrels blanked the Curve, 1-0. The game's lone run scored on a throwing error by Cruz in the fourth that brought in **Johneshwy Fargas** from second base. **Carlos Navas** worked 4.0 innings. **Sam Wolff** pitched 2.0 scoreless innings and **Tyler Cyr** earned the save stranding the tying run at third in the seventh.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a four-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. It is also the last of a seven-game road trip to Harrisburg (2-1) and Altoona (1-2). The Flying Squirrels had won three consecutive road series, taking two of three in Hartford from July 15-17, three of four in Altoona from July 25-27 and two of three in Harrisburg from August 2-4, and they are looking for a split in this series. This series is the sixth and final set between Richmond and Altoona. The Curve won the first four head-to-head series before the Flying Squirrels took the last series at PNG Field. Richmond is 10-6 in road getaway days this season.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won three of their last five games since Saturday but have lost seven of their last 10 since July 28. Over the last nine games. Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .219 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.76 team ERA, which is tied for ninth in the circuit. Richmond's -139 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Trenton at -26). The previous franchise-worst is -80 in 2017.

THE CURVE have gone 7-16 in their last 23 games since July 18. The Curve were swept in their last series in three games at Reading, and they were outscored 21-12 in that set. The Altoona pitching staff has combined for a 3.70 ERA this season, which is ranked eighth in the Eastern League. The Altoona offense is batting .239 this season, which is tied for sixth in the league. The Altoona roster includes four of MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects, including Oneil Cruz (3), Jared Oliva (11), Cody Bolton (13) and Blake Cederlind (29).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Chase Johnson** makes his first start of the season for the Flying Squirrels. He has pitched 27 relief outings this year for Richmond, four games for A-Adv. San Jose and one for Triple-A Sacramento. He has made four appearances against the Curve this year, combining for a 3.38 ERA (4 ER/10.2 IP). Johnson was a starter for Richmond in 2018, going 2-5 with a 3.86 ERA in 18 outings. Johnson was drafted in the third round in 2013 out of Cal Poly San Luis Obispo and has gone 4-14 with a 4.07 ERA in his 72 career outings for the Flying Squirrels, including 28 starts. *For more on Johnson, see page two.*

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander **Cody Bolton** makes his eighth start for the Curve and his third against the Flying Squirrels. He made his Double-A debut at The Diamond on June 26 and allowed four runs over 4.1 innings in a loss. He faced Richmond again on July 28 and worked 6.0 innings, allowing one run with a Double-A high eight strikeouts. In his most recent start, Bolton pitched 4.2 innings and allowed five runs at Reading on Saturday. Bolton was drafted by the Pirates in the sixth round in 2017 and is currently ranked by MLB.com as Pittsburgh's No. 13 prospect.

PITCHERS' DELIGHT: The 2019 season has been the "Year of the Pitcher" in the Eastern League. There have been eight no-hitters thrown in the league this year, one shy of the record nine no-hitters in 1967. On the season, the league has combined for a 3.59 ERA, the second-lowest in all of minor league baseball's full-season leagues, down from last year's mark of 4.01 and the lowest in the EL since 1990 (3.33). The league's offenses have combined to hit .239, the lowest of all MiLB full-season leagues, which is down from .253 last season and the lowest in the EL since 1971 (.234). Richmond's offense has been held to a .219 batting average, which would be tied for the seventh-lowest since the EL became a Double-A circuit in 1963 (most recently 1975 Trois-Rivieres Aigles).

A SERIES OF UNFORTUNATE EVENTS: On the season, the Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost 22 and split five. Six of their seven series wins have come on the road. The Flying Squirrels have lost four straight home sets but have won their last three road series, including taking three of four from July 25-28 in Altoona and two of three in Harrisburg over the weekend.

TROUBLE AT HOME: Since May 23, the Flying Squirrels have gone 6-26 in 32 home games. Richmond has lost nine of the last 10 home series since May 21, with the only exception being a four-game split against Hartford from June 27-30. After starting the year 5-2 at home through April 18, Richmond has posted a 10-39 record in 49 games at The Diamond since April 20. Richmond's only home series win the year was their first set of the season when they won three-of-four against Hartford from April 4-7. Away from The Diamond, the Flying Squirrels are 14-9 in their last 23 road games since June 20.

A LITTLE RELIEF: Over the last 53 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 2.59 ERA (56 ER/194.2 IP) with 169 strikeouts and 77 walks. On the season, Richmond's 3.57 bullpen ERA is the second-highest in the league. **Ryan Halstead** has gone 1-2 with a 1.11 ERA (4 ER/32.1 IP) in his last 21 games since May 5. **Melvin Adon** has posted a 1.00 ERA (3 ER/27.0) in 22 games since May 19 with 11 saves in 12 attempts, adding 34 strikeouts and 11 walks. **Tyler Cyr** has posted a 1.00 ERA (3 ER/27.0 IP) in his last 19 games since June 5. **Raffi Vizcaino** has a 1.23 ERA (3 ER/22.0 IP) in his last 15 appearances since June 11. **Caleb Simpson** has a 1.96 ERA (4 ER/18.1 IP) in his last 14 outings since June 18. **Carlos Navas** has combined for a 1.50 ERA (5 ER/30.0 IP) in his 14 total appearances with the Flying Squirrels this year. **Chase Johnson** has a 2.41 ERA (9 ER/33.2 IP) in his last 17 games since May 31.

CYR-IOUS: Reliever **Tyler Cyr** picked up the 23rd save of his Flying Squirrels career on Wednesday, which is tied for third-most in a career in franchise history with Rafael Cova. Cyr trails only Daryl Maday (28) and Derek Law (26) on the list. Cyr collected 18 saves for the Flying Squirrels in 2017, which ranked third in the Eastern League that year. He picked up three saves in 2018 before an elbow injury ended his season in May.

GRAND LARCENY: This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 112 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 44 steals this year. Fargas has the second-most steals in a season in franchise history, trailing only the 49 by **Kelby Tomlinson** in 2014, and has the third-most career steals in team history. He is also ranked tied for third in all of MLB and MiLB in steals on the year. **Jalen Miller** is third in the league with 24.

FINDING THE FIRST-HALF MAGIC: Over his last 12 games, **Jonah Arenado** is batting .271 (13-for-48) with four doubles. He posted a season-high seven-game hitting streak from July 26-August 2, but it was snapped with an 0-for-4 game on Saturday at Harrisburg. Arenado was batting .301 through June 8 (including a .348 average in April), but has hit .176 (34-for-193) in his 54 games since.

WALK THIS WAY: On the year, **Jacob Heyward** has worked 60 walks, which is second-most in the league. He has walked seven times over his last nine games. His 60 walks are tied for second-most in a season in Flying Squirrels franchise history. The four others in the top-five on the list all set their marks during the 2013 season (Mark Minicozzi - 62, Jarrett Parker - 60, Joe Panik - 58 and Javier Herrera - 57).

GOING UNDER: Friday's Flying Squirrels loss in Harrisburg pushed the team's overall record 30 games under .500, a new franchise-worst, at 39-69. This year's mark surpasses the previous low at 22 games under .500, which was reached three separate times during the 2016 season, most recently on August 10, 2016. The Flying Squirrels' -138 run differential is tied for second-worst in all of full-season MiLB (Columbia: -139, Nashville: -142). Richmond's .372 winning percentage is tied for second-worst in full-season MiLB (West Michigan: - .325, Mobile: - .372).

TOOL SHED: On Wednesday, *Baseball America* released its "Best Tools" list for the Eastern League, compiled through surveying managers around the league. **Johneshwy Fargas** was selected as the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Eastern League. **Melvin Adon**, who has been promoted to Triple-A, was named as having the league's "Best Fastball."

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America's* Mid-Season Top-30 prospects: **Logan Webb** (7), **Melvin Adon** (18), **Garrett Williams** (20) and **Raffi Vizcaino** (25). There are also three players included on *MLB.com's* top-30 Giants prospect list, including: **Webb** (5), **Adon** (14) and **Williams** (26).
