**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels dropped the series opener to the Baysox, 4-1. Bowie took the lead in the second on an RBI double by Jesmuel Valentin and added a second run with an RBI double by Anderson Feliz in the third. **Zach Houchins** hit a solo homer, his eighth of the year, in the third inning to get the Flying Squirrels on the board. In the fifth, Feliz hit an RBI single and Carlos Perez added a RBI groundout to put the Baysox ahead, 4-1. **Brandon Lawson** worked 6.0 innings and allowed four runs (three earned). **Ryan Halstead** and **Raffi Vizcaino** combined for 3.0 scoreless relief innings. Former Richmond pitcher Tyler Herb allowed one run over 7.0 innings for the Baysox.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the second and third of a four-game series against the Bowie Baysox. Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Today's games are the second and third of eight consecutive games against the Baysox for the Flying Squirrels. The two teams split a rain-shortened, two-game series at The Diamond from April 9-10. The Flying Squirrels won two of three in Bowie from April 29-May 1. Bowie swept a rain-shortened, two-game set at Prince George's Stadium from May 10-11 and also swept a three-game set at The Diamond from July 22-24. Bowie has won six consecutive games against Richmond dating back to May 10. The Flying Squirrels have lost eight consecutive home games dating back to July 21.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have lost nine of their last 12 games since July 28. Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .218 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.73 team ERA, which is ninth in the circuit. Richmond's -144 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Trenton at -19). The previous franchise-worst is -80 in 2017.

**THE BAYSOX** had lost three consecutive games and six of their last eight prior to taking the series opener on Friday. The Baysox are in second place in the E.L. Western Division's second-half standings, 2.0 games behind first-place Erie. Bowie's pitching staff has combined for a 3.28 ERA, best in the league. The Baysox offense has combined to hit .245, which is third in the league. Bowie's roster includes 11 of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including Yusniel Diaz (5 - on IL), Dean Kremer (8), Michael Baumann (9), Zac Lowther (10), Ryan McKenna (13), Cody Sedlock (17), Alex Wells (20), Rylan Bannon (24), Mason McCoy (25), Zac Pop (26 - on IL) and Brett Cumberland (30).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander **Caleb Baragar** makes his 17th start for the Flying Squirrels this season and his first against the Baysox. He faced the Baysox in his Double-A debut as a reliever and allowed four unearned runs in 0.2 innings. In his most recent start, Baragar allowed four runs over 5.0 innings on Monday in Altoona in a no-decision. Over his last eight starts since June 25, Baragar has gone 1-4 with a 5.61 ERA (27 ER/43.1 IP). In his previous seven starts from May 19-June 20, Baragar went 2-0 with a 2.27 ERA (10 ER/39.2 IP). Prior to joining Richmond, Baragar made one start with Triple-A Sacramento on May 2 and allowed five runs over 4.1 innings in a no-decision. He began the season with A-Adv. San Jose and went 0-1 with a 2.70 ERA in four starts and one relief outing. Baragar was drafted by the Giants in the ninth round in 2016 out of Indiana University and is in his fourth professional season. **For more on Baragar, see page two.**

Right-hander **Sean Hjelle** makes his Double-A debut in the second game of today's double-header. He began the season with Single-A Augusta, going 1-2 with a 2.66 ERA in nine starts. He was promoted to A-Adv. San Jose on May 20 and posted a 5-5 record with a 2.78 ERA in 14 starts. His ERA ranked second in the California League among pitchers during the time he was in the league and had the third-most innings pitched (77.2). Hjelle was drafted by the Giants in the second round in 2018 out of the University of Kentucky. **For more on Hjelle, see page two.**

**FOR BOWIE:** Right-hander Dean Kremer makes his 15th start of the season for the Baysox and his second against the Flying Squirrels. On July 24, Kremer worked 6.0 scoreless innings at The Diamond in a win. Last time out, he tossed 6.2 innings against Portland and allowed three runs with eight strikeouts in a win. Kremer was traded to the Orioles on July 18, 2018 as part of the deal that sent Manny Machado to the Dodgers. He is ranked by MLB.com as the Orioles' No. 8 prospect.

Right-hander Cody Sedlock makes his second start and fifth overall for the Baysox this season. His only other start came against the Flying Squirrels on July 22, and he worked 5.0 hitless, scoreless innings with seven strikeouts. Sedlock pitched 13 games (10 starts) for the A-Adv. Frederick Keys to begin the year and went 4-1 with a 2.36 ERA. He was drafted by the Orioles in the first round (27th overall) in 2016 and is ranked by MLB.com as the Orioles' No. 17 prospect.

**TOP OF THE CLASS:** The Flying Squirrels received top two prospects in the Giants' system on Friday with the additions of **Joey Bart** and **Heliot Ramos**. Bart is ranked first and Ramos is ranked second both MLB.com and *Baseball America*'s top-30 Giants prospects lists. Bart is the highest drafted player in Flying Squirrels history (2nd overall - 2018). Ramos is the third-highest drafted player in franchise history (19th overall - 2017), trailing Tyler Beede (14th overall - 2014). All time, the Flying Squirrels roster has featured 22 players selected in the first round of the MLB Draft. Bart is also the highest ranked player on *Baseball America*'s Top 100 prospects list (No. 17) in Flying Squirrels franchise history.

**YOUTH MOVEMENT:** Outfielder **Heliot Ramos** became the youngest player in Flying Squirrels franchise history (19 years, 336 days) with his debut on August 9. He is the first teenager ever to suit up for the Flying Squirrels. Ramos is also the second-youngest player in the Eastern League this season behind Harrisburg's Luis Garcia.

**PITCHERS' DELIGHT:** The 2019 season has been the "Year of the Pitcher" in the Eastern League. There have been eight no-hitters thrown in the league this year, one shy of the record nine no-hitters in 1967. On the season, the league has combined for a 3.57 ERA, the second-lowest in all of minor league baseball's full-season leagues, down from last year's mark of 4.01 and the lowest in the EL since 1990 (3.33). The league's offenses have combined to hit .239, the lowest of all MiLB full-season leagues, which is down from .253 last season and the lowest in the EL since 1971 (.234). Richmond's offense has been held to a .218 batting average, which would be tied for the sixth-lowest since the EL became a Double-A circuit in 1963 (tied with 1972 Elmira Pioneers). The last team with a lower average was the 1967 York White Roses (.217).

**A SERIES OF UNFORTUNATE EVENTS:** On the season, the Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost 23 and split five. Six of their seven series wins have come on the road. The Flying Squirrels have lost four straight home sets but have won their last three of their last four road series.

**TROUBLE AT HOME:** Since May 22, the Flying Squirrels have gone 6-27 in 33 home games. The team has lost 13 of the last 14 home games since July 5. Richmond has lost nine of the last 10 home series since May 21, with the only exception being a four-game split against Hartford from June 27-30. After starting the year 5-2 at home through April 18, Richmond has posted a 10-40 record in 50 games at The Diamond since April 20. Richmond's only home series win the year was their first set of the season when they won three-of-four against Hartford from April 4-7. Away from The Diamond, the Flying Squirrels are 14-11 in their last 25 road games since June 20.

**A LITTLE RELIEF:** Over the last 55 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 2.54 ERA (57 ER/202.1 IP) with 178 strikeouts and 79 walks. On the season, Richmond's 3.50 bullpen ERA is the third-highest in the league. **Ryan Halstead** has gone 1-2 with a 1.06 ERA (4 ER/34.0 IP) in his last 22 games since May 5. **Melvin Adon** has posted a 1.00 ERA (3 ER/27.0) in 22 games since May 19 with 11 saves in 12 attempts, adding 34 strikeouts and 11 walks. **Tyler Cyr** has posted a 1.00 ERA (3 ER/27.0 IP) in his last 19 games since June 5. **Raffi Vizcaino** has a 1.16 ERA (3 ER/23.1 IP) in his last 16 appearances since June 11. **Caleb Simpson** has a 1.86 ERA (4 ER/19.1 IP) in his last 15 outings since June 18. **Carlos Navas** has combined for a 1.50 ERA (5 ER/30.0 IP) in his 14 total appearances with the Flying Squirrels this year.

**GRAND LARCENY:** This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 113 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 44 steals this year. Fargas has the second-most steals in a season in franchise history, trailing only the 49 by **Kelby Tomlinson** in 2014, and has the third-most career steals in team history. He is also ranked tied for third in all of MLB and MiLB in steals on the year. **Jalen Miller** is third in the league with 24.

**WALK THIS WAY:** On the year, **Jacob Heyward** has worked 61 walks, which is tied for second-most in the league. He has walked seven times over his last nine games. His 61 walks are second-most in a season in Flying Squirrels franchise history. The four others in the top-five on the list all set their marks during the 2013 season (Mark Minicozzi - 62, Jarrett Parker - 60, Joe Panik - 58 and Javier Herrera - 57).

**GOING UNDER:** Friday's loss to the Baysox pushed the team's overall record to 31 games under .500, the worst in team history at 42-73. This year's mark surpasses the previous low at 22 games under .500, which was reached three separate times during the 2016 season, most recently on August 10, 2016. The Flying Squirrels' -144 run differential is the worst in all of full-season MiLB (behind Nashville: -136, Tacoma: -136). Richmond's .365 winning percentage is second-worst in full-season MiLB (West Michigan: -.319).
