**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels were swept in a double-header by the Bowie Baysox. In Game 1, Richmond lost, 1-0. **Caleb Baragar** pitched a complete game and allowed one unearned run and an RBI double by Jesmuel Valentin in the sixth. **Heliot Ramos** and **Jalen Miller** each had two hits. **Dean Kremer** struck out 10 in his 5.0 innings for Bowie. The Baysox won Game 2, 5-3, behind five runs in the fifth inning. **Ramos** hit a two-run homer, his first at Double-A, off the bottom of the scoreboard in left-center field in the third inning. Starter **Sean Hjelle**, making his Double-A debut, worked four scoreless innings before Bowie brought home five runs in the fifth. **Joey Bart** had three hits, including an RBI single in the seventh.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a four-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Today's game is the fourth of eight consecutive games against the Baysox for the Flying Squirrels. The two teams split a rain-shortened, two-game series at The Diamond from April 9-10. The Flying Squirrels won two of three in Bowie from April 29-May 1. Bowie swept a rain-shortened, two-game set at Prince George's Stadium from May 10-11 and also swept a three-game set at The Diamond from July 22-24. Bowie has won eight consecutive games against Richmond dating back to May 10. The Flying Squirrels have lost ten consecutive home games dating back to July 21.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have lost 11 of their last 14 games since July 28. Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .219 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.73 team ERA, which is ninth in the circuit. Richmond's -147 run differential is last in the league (next closest is New Hampshire at -19). The previous franchise-worst is -80 in 2017.

**THE BAYSOX** have won three straight games after dropping six of their last eight entering the series. The Baysox are in second place in the E.L. Western Division's second-half standings, 1.5 games behind first-place Erie. Bowie's pitching staff has combined for a 3.26 ERA, best in the league. The Baysox offense has combined to hit .244, which is third in the league. Bowie's roster includes 11 of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including Yusniel Diaz (5 - on IL), **Dean Kremer** (8), Michael Baumann (9), **Zac Lowther** (10), Ryan McKenna (13), Cody Sedlock (17), Alex Wells (20), Rylan Bannon (24), Mason McCoy (25), **Zac Pop** (26 - on IL) and Brett Cumberland (30).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Alfred Gutierrez** makes his team-leading 23rd start of the season for the Flying Squirrels and his third against the Baysox. Last time out, Gutierrez worked a scoreless first inning before rain suspended play in Altoona on Tuesday, ending his outing. Over his last six starts since July 11, Gutierrez has gone 0-2 with a 6.26 ERA (16 ER/23.0 IP). Over his previous eight starts from May 26-July 3 heading into the All-Star Break, Gutierrez went 6-1 with a 2.98 ERA (14 ER/42.1 IP). In his previous starts against Bowie this season, Gutierrez is 0-1 with a 5.00 ERA (5 ER/9.0 IP). Last year, he spent time at three levels and made seven starts for the Erie SeaWolves in the Eastern League. He spent most of the season split between the starting rotation and bullpen with A-Adv. Lakeland and was named a Florida State League Mid-Season All-Star. **For more on Gutierrez, see page two.**

**FOR BOWIE:** Left-hander **Zac Lowther** makes his 22nd start of the season for the Baysox and his first against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on Tuesday at Trenton, allowing three runs over 6.0 innings in a win with a season-high 10 strikeouts. Lowther ranks first in the Eastern League in wins (12), ranks fourth in ERA (2.72), third in strikeouts (116), tied for fifth in starts (21), sixth in innings pitched (116.0), tied for first in BAA (.193), ninth in WHIP (1.16) and tied for second in winning percentage (.710). A second-round draft pick for the Orioles in 2017 out of Xavier, Lowther is in his first Double-A season and was named an Eastern League Mid-Season All-Star.

**TOP OF THE CLASS:** The Flying Squirrels received top two prospects in the Giants' system on Friday with the additions of **Joey Bart** and **Heliot Ramos**. Bart is ranked first and Ramos is ranked second both MLB.com and *Baseball America*'s top-30 Giants prospects lists. Bart is the highest drafted player in Flying Squirrels history (2nd overall - 2018). Ramos is the third-highest drafted player in franchise history (19th overall - 2017), trailing Tyler Beede (14th overall - 2014). All time, the Flying Squirrels roster has featured 22 players selected in the first round of the MLB Draft. Bart is also the highest ranked player on *Baseball America*'s Top 100 prospects list (No. 17) in Flying Squirrels franchise history.

**YOUTH MOVEMENT:** Outfielder **Heliot Ramos** became the youngest player in Flying Squirrels franchise history (19 years, 336 days) with his debut on August 9. He is the first teenager ever to suit up for the Flying Squirrels. Ramos is also the second-youngest player in the Eastern League this season behind Harrisburg's Luis Garcia. Ramos is batting .400 (4-for-10) through his first three Double-A games and hit his first homer in the second game of Saturday's double-header.

**PITCHERS' DELIGHT:** The 2019 season has been the "Year of the Pitcher" in the Eastern League. There have been eight no-hitters thrown in the league this year, one shy of the record nine no-hitters in 1967. On the season, the league has combined for a 3.57 ERA, the second-lowest in all of minor league baseball's full-season leagues, down from last year's mark of 4.01 and the lowest in the EL since 1990 (3.33). The league's offenses have combined to hit .239, the lowest of all MiLB full-season leagues, which is down from .253 last season and the lowest in the EL since 1971 (.234). Richmond's offense has been held to a .219 batting average, which would be tied for the seventh-lowest since the EL became a Double-A circuit in 1963 (last - 1975 Trios-Rivieres Aigles).

**A SERIES OF UNFORTUNATE EVENTS:** On the season, the Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost 24 and split five. Six of their seven series wins have come on the road. The Flying Squirrels have lost five straight home sets but have won three of their last four road series.

**TROUBLE AT HOME:** Since May 22, the Flying Squirrels have gone 6-29 in 35 home games. The team has lost 15 of the last 16 home games since July 5. The current 10-game home losing streak is the longest in franchise history (prev: 8, 5/9-5/20/16). Richmond has lost 10 of the last 11 home series since May 21, with the only exception being a four-game split against Hartford from June 27-30. After starting the year 5-2 at home through April 18, Richmond has posted a 10-42 record in 52 games at The Diamond since April 20. Richmond's only home series win the year was their first set of the season when they won three-of-four against Hartford from April 4-7. Away from The Diamond, the Flying Squirrels are 14-11 in their last 25 road games since June 20.

**A LITTLE RELIEF:** Over the last 57 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 2.51 ERA (57 ER/201 IP) with 182 strikeouts and 79 walks. On the season, Richmond's 3.50 bullpen ERA is the third-highest in the league. **Ryan Halstead** has gone 1-2 with a 1.06 ERA (4 ER/34.0 IP) in his last 22 games since May 5. **Melvin Adon** has posted a 1.00 ERA (3 ER/27.0 IP) in 22 games since May 19 with 11 saves in 12 attempts, adding 34 strikeouts and 11 walks. **Tyler Cyr** has posted a 1.00 ERA (3 ER/27.0 IP) in his last 19 games since June 5. **Raffi Vizcaino** has a 1.16 ERA (3 ER/23.1 IP) in his last 16 appearances since June 11. **Caleb Simpson** has a 1.86 ERA (4 ER/19.1 IP) in his last 15 outings since June 18. **Carlos Navas** has combined for a 1.50 ERA (5 ER/30.0 IP) in his 14 total appearances with the Flying Squirrels this year. **Sam Wolff** has not allowed a run in his last six appearances since June 24, totaling 8.1 innings.

**GRAND LARCENY:** This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 113 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 44 steals this year. Fargas has the second-most steals in a season in franchise history, trailing only the 49 by **Kelby Tomlinson** in 2014, and has the third-most career steals in team history. He is also ranked fourth in all of MLB and MiLB in steals on the year. **Jalen Miller** is third in the league with 24.

**TAKE A WALK:** On the year, **Jacob Heyward** has worked 66 walks, which is second-most in the league. He has walked eight times over his last five games. His 66 walks are the most in a season in Flying Squirrels franchise history. The four others in the top-five on the list all set their marks during the 2013 season (Mark Minicoczi - 62, Jarrett Parker - 60, Joe Panik - 58 and Javier Herrera - 57). His .355 on-base percentage leads the Flying Squirrels.

**GOING UNDER:** Saturday's losses to the Baysox pushed the team's overall record to 33 games under .500, the worst in team history at 42-75. This year's mark surpasses the previous low at 22 games under .500, which was reached three separate times during the 2016 season, most recently on August 10, 2016. The Flying Squirrels' -147 run differential is the worst in all of full-season MiLB. Richmond's .359 winning percentage is second-worst in full-season MiLB (West Michigan: - .316).

**TOOL SHED:** On Wednesday, *Baseball America* released its "Best Tools" list for the Eastern League, compiled through surveying managers around the league. **Johneshwy Fargas** was selected as the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Eastern League. **Melvin Adon**, who has been promoted to Triple-A, was named as having the league's "Best Fastball."

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have five players included in *Baseball America*'s Mid-Season Top-30 prospects: **Joey Bart** (1), **Heliot Ramos** (2), **Sean Hjelle** (7), **Garrett Williams** (21) and **Raffi Vizcaino** (27). There are also three players included on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list, including: Bart (1), Ramos (2), Hjelle (6) and Williams (28). Two players, Bart (16) and Ramos (66), are featured on *Baseball America*'s Top 100 prospects list. Bart (21) and Ramos (55) are also listed on MLB.com's Top 100 prospects.



The homer was one of only five hits in the game for the Flying Squirrels. Dylan Davis hit a three-run homer in the fifth. Nate Reed allowed four runs over 7.1 innings. He faced 33 batters in the game, the most by a Flying Squirrels starter in a game in franchise history.
