SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels snapped a four-game losing streak with a 3-1 win over the Bowie Baysox. **Alfred Gutierrez** worked five innings and allowed one unearned run. **Caleb Simpson** worked 1.1 scoreless innings and **Sam Moll** followed with 1.2 scoreless innings. **Tyler Cyr** picked up the 24th save of his career, moving him into third place on the franchise career saves leaders list. **Heliot Ramos** opened the scoring with a two-run double in the third. Bowie scored on an error in the fourth. In the bottom of the fourth, **Peter Maris** hit an RBI single to open the lead to 3-1. The Flying Squirrels snapped a franchise-record ten-game losing streak and also snapped an eight-game losing streak against the Baysox.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the first two of a four-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Today's games are the fifth and sixth of eight consecutive games against the Baysox for the Flying Squirrels. The two teams split a rain-shortened, two-game series at The Diamond from April 9-10. The Flying Squirrels won two of three in Bowie from April 29-May 1. Bowie swept a rain-shortened, two-game set at Prince George's Stadium from May 10-11 and also swept a three-game set at The Diamond from July 22-24. The Baysox won three of four at The Diamond last weekend. Bowie had won eight consecutive games against Richmond dating back to May 10 prior to Sunday's game. The Flying Squirrels are playing their third double-header in the last week.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost 11 of their last 15 games since July 28. Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .218 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.69 team ERA, which is eighth in the circuit. Richmond's -145 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Altoona at -18). The previous franchise-worst is -80 in 2017.

THE BAYSOX have won three of the last four games, all in last weekend's series at The Diamond. The Baysox are in second place in the E.L. Western Division's second-half standings, 1.5 games behind first-place Erie. Bowie's pitching staff has combined for a 3.25 ERA, best in the league. The Baysox offense has combined to hit .243, which is third in the league. Bowie's roster includes 11 of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including Yusniel Diaz (5 - on IL), Dean Kremer (8), Michael Baumann (9), Zac Lowther (10), Ryan McKenna (13), Cody Sedlock (17), Alex Wells (20), Rylan Bannon (24), Mason McCoy (25), Zac Pop (26 - on IL) and Brett Cumberland (30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Chase Johnson** makes his second start of the season for the Flying Squirrels in Game 1. He made his first start of the year on Thursday in Altoona and allowed one unearned run over 3.1 innings. Over his last four overall appearances, Johnson has posted a 0.79 ERA (1 ER/11.1 IP), holding opponents to a .200 batting average. Johnson has pitched two games against the Baysox this year, going 0-2 with a 6.75 ERA (4 ER/5.1 IP). He has pitched 27 relief outings this year for Richmond, four games for A-Adv. San Jose and one for Triple-A Sacramento. Johnson was a starter for Richmond in 2018, going 2-5 with a 3.86 ERA in 18 outings. Johnson was drafted in the third round in 2013 out of Cal Poly San Luis Obispo and has gone 4-14 with a 3.99 ERA in his 73 career outings for the Flying Squirrels, including 29 starts. *For more on Johnson, see page two.*

Right-hander **Ryan Halstead** makes his third start of the season and 30th overall appearance for the Flying Squirrels in Game 2. He has made two other starts this year on June 24 against Altoona and July 22 against Bowie, combining to allow one run in 8.0 innings. Over his last 14 total outings, including one for Triple-A Sacramento, Halstead has gone 1-0 with a 0.74 ERA (2 ER/24.1 IP). Halstead is in his third season with the Flying Squirrels and has gone 8-8 with a 3.39 ERA in 87 total outings. He has pitched against Bowie twice this year, combining for 5.2 scoreless innings.

FOR BOWIE: Left-hander **Alex Wells** makes his 20th start of the season for the Baysox and his first against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, he worked 4.1 innings and allowed one run at Trenton on Wednesday. Through his first 16 games of the season, Wells went 8-1 with a 1.83 ERA. Over his last three outings since July 26, Wells is 0-1 with a 3.71 ERA (7 ER/17.0 IP). A native of Newcastle, New South Wales, Australia, Wells was selected this season as an Eastern League All-Star.

TOP OF THE CLASS: The Flying Squirrels received top two prospects in the Giants' system on Friday with the additions of **Joey Bart** and **Heliot Ramos**. Bart is ranked first and Ramos is ranked second both MLB.com and *Baseball America*'s top-30 Giants prospects lists. Bart is the highest drafted player in Flying Squirrels history (2nd overall - 2018). Ramos is the third-highest drafted player in franchise history (19th overall - 2017), trailing Tyler Beede (14th overall - 2014). All time, the Flying Squirrels roster has featured 22 players selected in the first round of the MLB Draft. Bart is also the highest ranked player on *Baseball America*'s Top 100 prospects list (No. 17) in Flying Squirrels franchise history.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: Outfielder **Heliot Ramos** became the youngest player in Flying Squirrels franchise history (19 years, 336 days) with his debut on August 9. He is the first teenager ever to suit up for the Flying Squirrels. Ramos is also the second-youngest player in the Eastern League this season behind Harrisburg's Luis Garcia. Ramos is batting .385 (5-for-13) through his first four Double-A games with a homer, a double, four RBIs and three walks.

CYR-IOUS: Reliever **Tyler Cyr** picked up the 24th save of his Flying Squirrels career on Sunday, moving into third place for saves in a career in franchise history. Cyr trails only Daryl Maday (28) and Derek Law (26) on the list. Cyr collected 18 saves for the Flying Squirrels in 2017, which ranked third in the Eastern League that year. He picked up three saves in 2018 before an elbow injury ended his season in May.

PITCHERS' DELIGHT: The 2019 season has been the "Year of the Pitcher" in the Eastern League. There have been eight no-hitters thrown in the league this year, one shy of the record nine no-hitters in 1967. On the season, the league has combined for a 3.58 ERA, the second-lowest in all of minor league baseball's full-season leagues, down from last year's mark of 4.01 and the lowest in the EL since 1990 (3.33). The league's offenses have combined to hit .239, tied for the lowest of all MiLB full-season leagues, which is down from .253 last season and the lowest in the EL since 1971 (.234). Richmond's offense has been held to a .218 batting average, which would be tied for the sixth-lowest since the EL became a Double-A circuit in 1963 (last - 1972 Elmira Pioneers). The last time a team had a lower batting average was 1968 (Binghamton Triplets - .210, Elmira Pioneers - .217).

A SERIES OF UNFORTUNATE EVENTS: On the season, the Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost 24 and split five. Six of their seven series wins have come on the road. The Flying Squirrels have lost five straight home sets but have won three of their last four road series.

A LITTLE RELIEF: Over the last 58 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 2.46 ERA (57 ER/208.1 IP) with 189 strikeouts and 79 walks. On the season, Richmond's 3.45 bullpen ERA is the third-highest in the league. **Ryan Halstead** has gone 1-2 with a 1.06 ERA (4 ER/34.0 IP) in his last 22 games since May 5. **Melvin Adon** has posted a 1.00 ERA (3 ER/27.0 IP) in 22 games since May 19 with 11 saves in 12 attempts, adding 34 strikeouts and 11 walks. **Tyler Cyr** has posted a 0.96 ERA (3 ER/28.0 IP) in his last 19 games since June 5. **Raffi Vizcaino** has a 1.16 ERA (3 ER/23.1 IP) in his last 16 appearances since June 11. **Caleb Simpson** has a 1.74 ERA (4 ER/20.2 IP) in his last 16 outings since June 18. **Carlos Navas** has combined for a 1.50 ERA (5 ER/30.0 IP) in his 14 total appearances with the Flying Squirrels this year. **Sam Wolff** has not allowed a run in his last six appearances since June 24, totaling 8.1 innings.

GRAND LARCENY: This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 113 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 44 steals this year. Fargas has the second-most steals in a season in franchise history, trailing only the 49 by **Kelby Tomlinson** in 2014, and has the third-most career steals in team history. He is also ranked tied for fourth in all of MLB and MiLB in steals on the year. **Jalen Miller** is third in the league with 24.

TAKE A WALK: On the year, **Jacob Heyward** has worked 67 walks, which is second-most in the league. He has walked nine times over his last six games. His 67 walks are the most in a season in Flying Squirrels franchise history. The four others in the top-five on the list all set their marks during the 2013 season (Mark Minicoczi - 62, Jarrett Parker - 60, Joe Panik - 58 and Javier Herrera - 57). His .357 on-base percentage leads the Flying Squirrels and ranks tenth in the league.

TOOL SHED: On Wednesday, *Baseball America* released its "Best Tools" list for the Eastern League, compiled through surveying managers around the league. **Johneshwy Fargas** was selected as the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Eastern League. **Melvin Adon**, who has been promoted to Triple-A, was named as having the league's "Best Fastball."

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have five players included in *Baseball America*'s Mid-Season Top-30 prospects: **Joey Bart** (1), **Heliot Ramos** (2), **Sean Hjelle** (7), **Garrett Williams** (21) and **Raffi Vizcaino** (27). There are also three players included on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list, including: Bart (1), Ramos (2), Hjelle (6) and Williams (28). Two players, Bart (16) and Ramos (66), are featured on *Baseball America*'s Top 100 prospects list. Bart (21) and Ramos (55) are also listed on MLB.com's Top 100 prospects.
