YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost the series finale against the Bowie Baysox, 4-3, at Prince George's Stadium. In the third inning, **Johneshwy Fargas** hit a solo homer, his fifth of the season. Later in the inning, **Zach Houchins** and **Peter Maris** each hit two-out, RBI doubles to open a 3-0 Flying Squirrels lead. **Sean Hjelle** did not allow a run over his first three innings but allowed three runs in the fourth to tie the score. In the fifth, Carlos Perez hit a go-ahead single to put Bowie in the lead, 4-3. Maris finished the day with two hits. **Sam Moll** and **Sam Wolff** each pitched 1.2 scoreless innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a three-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. It is also the first of a six-game homestand against Harrisburg and Erie. Including tonight, the Flying Squirrels have ten home games remaining in 2019. On the year, the Flying Squirrels lost their first three series against the Senators before taking two of three in Harrisburg from August 2-4. This series is the final set this year for the Flying Squirrels against a National League affiliate. Richmond has lost all three series openers against Harrisburg.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost 14 of their last 19 games since July 28. Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .217 batting average, including a .206 average in August. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.69 team ERA, which is eighth in the circuit. Richmond's -150 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Altoona at -29). The previous franchise-worst is -80 in 2017.

THE SENATORS have lost four of their last six games, but won two of three against Altoona in their most recent series. On the year, Harrisburg is ranked tied for sixth in the league in batting average (.241) and fourth in ERA (3.43). The Senators clinched the Western Division First-Half title on June 12 in Richmond to lock up a spot in the Eastern League playoffs. The Senators opened the season with a 21-4 record through the end of April, their best start in franchise history. Harrisburg's roster includes five of MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects, including Luis Garcia (2), Sterling Sharp (13 - on IL), Tres Barrera (18), Steven Fuentes (21 - suspended) and Jhonathan German (28).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Caleb Baragar** makes his 18th start for the Flying Squirrels this season and his first against the Senators. In his most recent start on Saturday in the first game of a double-header against the Baysox, Baragar picked up a 7.0-inning complete game and allowed one unearned run on three hits in a loss. Over his previous eight starts from June 25-August 5, Baragar went 1-4 with a 5.61 ERA (27 ER/43.1 IP). In his previous seven starts from May 19-June 20, Baragar went 2-0 with a 2.27 ERA (10 ER/39.2 IP). Prior to joining Richmond, Baragar made one start with Triple-A Sacramento on May 2 and allowed five runs over 4.1 innings in a no-decision. He began the season with A-Adv. San Jose and went 0-1 with a 2.70 ERA in four starts and one relief outing. Baragar was drafted by the Giants in the ninth round in 2016 out of Indiana University and is in his fourth professional season. *For more on Baragar, see page two.*

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander **Mario Sanchez** makes his 16th start of the season for the Senators and his fourth against the Flying Squirrels. In his previous three starts against Richmond, all at FNB Field, Sanchez went 2-1 with a 1.56 ERA (3 ER/17.1 IP). He last pitched on Saturday at Trenton and did not allow an earned run over 6.0 innings while picking up a career-high 10 strikeouts with no walks. Sanchez was originally signed by the Nationals in 2012 and was traded to the Phillies in December 2016. After reaching free agency in the fall of 2018, Sanchez signed back with the Nationals.

KEEPING IT CLOSE: Since July 25, 18 of the Flying Squirrels' 22 games have been decided by two runs or less. In that span, the Flying Squirrels have played eight one-run games (3-5) and 10 two-run games (5-5). Flying Squirrels have not won a game by 3+ runs in that span, but have lost by three, four, six and nine runs once each. The games have also mostly been low-scoring. 18 of the last 22 games have had eight-or-less total runs, and nine have had four-or-less total runs.

PITCHERS' DELIGHT: The 2019 season has been the "Year of the Pitcher" in the Eastern League. There have been eight no-hitters thrown in the league this year, one shy of the record nine no-hitters in 1967. On the season, the league has combined for a 3.57 ERA, the second-lowest in all of minor league baseball's full-season leagues, down from last year's mark of 4.01 and the lowest in the EL since 1990 (3.33). The league's offenses have combined to hit .239, the lowest of all MiLB full-season leagues, which is down from .253 last season and the lowest in the EL since 1971 (.234). Richmond's offense has been held to a .217 batting average, which would be tied for the fifth-lowest since the EL became a Double-A circuit in 1963 (last - 1967 York White Roses). The last time a team had a lower batting average was 1968 (Binghamton Triplets - .210, Elmira Pioneers - .214).

A SERIES OF UNFORTUNATE EVENTS: On the season, the Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost 25 and split five. Six of their seven series wins have come on the road. The Flying Squirrels have lost five straight home sets but have won three of their last five road series.

TOP OF THE CLASS: The Flying Squirrels received top two prospects in the Giants' system on August 9 with the additions of **Joey Bart** and **Heliot Ramos**. Bart is ranked first and Ramos is ranked second both MiLB.com and *Baseball America's* top-30 Giants prospects lists. Bart is the highest drafted player in Flying Squirrels history (2nd overall - 2018). Ramos is the third-highest drafted player in franchise history (19th overall - 2017), trailing Tyler Beede (14th overall - 2014). All time, the Flying Squirrels roster has featured 22 players selected in the first round of the MLB Draft. Bart is also the highest ranked player on *Baseball America's* Top 100 prospects list (No. 17) in Flying Squirrels franchise history.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: Outfielder **Heliot Ramos** became the youngest player in Flying Squirrels franchise history (19 years, 336 days) with his debut on August 9. He is the first teenager ever to suit up for the Flying Squirrels. Ramos is also the second-youngest player in the Eastern League this season behind Harrisburg's Luis Garcia. Ramos hit .385 (5-for-13) with a homer, a double, four RBIs and three walks through his first four Double-A games. He is batting .071 (1-for-14) in his last four games since.

FARGAS ON FIRE: In his last 11 games, **Johneshwy Fargas** is batting .353 (12-for-34) with a homer, two doubles, an RBI and four steals. That stretch has raised his batting average to .252, which is the highest of all qualified hitters for the Flying Squirrels this season. In the second half of the season, Fargas is batting .282 (45-for-159) in 53 games.

CYR-IOUS: Reliever **Tyler Cyr** picked up the 25th save of his Flying Squirrels career on Tuesday, the third-most saves in a career in franchise history. Cyr trails only Daryl Maday (28) and Derek Law (26) on the list. Cyr collected 18 saves for the Flying Squirrels in 2017, which ranked third in the Eastern League that year. He picked up three saves in 2018 before an elbow injury ended his season in May. He has picked up four saves this year, and has a save in each of his last three appearances.

A LITTLE RELIEF: Over the last 62 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 2.56 ERA (62 ER/217.2 IP) with 198 strikeouts and 83 walks. On the season, Richmond's 3.48 bullpen ERA is the second-highest in the league. **Ryan Halstead** has gone 1-2 with a 1.06 ERA (4 ER/34.0 IP) in his last 22 games since May 5. **Tyler Cyr** has posted a 1.24 ERA (4 ER/29.0 IP) in his last 20 games since June 5. **Raffi Vizcaino** has a 1.85 ERA (5 ER/24.1 IP) in his last 17 appearances since June 11. **Caleb Simpson** has a 1.74 ERA (4 ER/20.2 IP) in his last 16 outings since June 18. **Carlos Navas** has combined for a 1.69 ERA (6 ER/32.0 IP) in his 15 total appearances with the Flying Squirrels this year. **Sam Wolff** has not allowed a run in his last seven appearances since June 24, totaling 10.0 innings.

GRAND LARCENY: This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 113 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 44 steals this year. Fargas has the second-most steals in a season in franchise history, trailing only the 49 by **Kelby Tomlinson** in 2014, and has the third-most career steals in team history. He is also ranked fifth in all of MLB and MiLB in steals on the year. **Jalen Miller** is tied for third in the league with 24.

GOING UNDER: Thursday's loss to the Baysox pushed the team's overall record to 34 games under .500, the worst in team history at 44-78. This year's mark surpasses the previous low at 22 games under .500, which was reached three separate times during the 2016 season, most recently on August 10, 2016. The Flying Squirrels' -150 run differential is the worst in all of full-season MiLB. Richmond's .361 winning percentage is second-worst in full-season MiLB (Mobile - .361; West Michigan: - .322).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have five players included in *Baseball America's* Mid-Season Top-30 prospects: **Joey Bart** (1), **Heliot Ramos** (2), **Sean Hjelle** (7), **Garrett Williams** (21) and **Raffi Vizcaino** (27). There are also three players included on MiLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list, including: Bart (1), Ramos (2), Hjelle (6) and Williams (28). Two players, Bart (16) and Ramos (66), are featured on *Baseball America's* Top 100 prospects list. Bart (21) and Ramos (55) are also listed on MiLB.com's Top 100 prospects.
