YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Erie SeaWolves, 7-3, on a pinch-hit, walk-off grand slam by **Jacob Heyward** in the bottom of the tenth inning. Erie scored the game's first run in the first inning on an RBI single by Kody Eaves. Richmond evened the score in the bottom of the inning with a solo homer by **Joey Bart**. In the third, **Heliot Ramos** put the Flying Squirrels ahead, 2-1, with an RBI double. Cam Gibson tied the score at 2-2 in the fourth with a sac fly. **Johnshwy Fargas** brought home **Zach Houchins** with a squeeze bunt to give Richmond a 3-2 lead in the fifth. Erie's Josh Lester hit a game-tying, solo homer in the top of the ninth to force extra innings. **Ryan Halstead** pitched a career-high 5.0 innings and allowed two runs with five strikeouts.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a three-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. It is also the fourth of a five-game homestand against Harrisburg (2-0) and Erie (1-0). Including today, the Flying Squirrels have six home games remaining in 2019. The Flying Squirrels dropped two of three in Erie from May 13-15 and lost three of four at home from July 18-21. The two teams meet again for a four-game series in Erie next Monday through Thursday. Richmond's current four-game home winning streak is the longest of the season.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won three straight games after dropping 10 of the previous 13 from August 5-15. Richmond sits fifth in the Western Division and is eliminated from postseason contention. Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .217 batting average, including a .207 average in August. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.62 team ERA, which is sixth in the circuit. Richmond's -139 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Portland at -32). The previous franchise-worst is -80 in 2017.

THE SEAWOLVES have won seven of their last 10 games since August 9. They have the best overall record in the Eastern League this season and has clinched a winning record for the first time since 2013, the franchise's last year in the E.L. post-season. Erie has the second-best ERA (3.27) in the Eastern League this season and the is ranked first in batting average (.251). Erie's roster includes 10 of MLB.com's Top-30 Tigers prospects, including Casey Mize (1), Matt Manning (2), Tarik Skubal (4), Isaac Paredes (5), Alex Faedo (9 - on IL), Joey Wentz (10), Sergio Alcantara (15 - on IL), Anthony Castro (20), Derek Hill (28) and Alex Lange (29).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Brandon Lawson** makes his 22nd start of the season for the Flying Squirrels and his third against Erie. In his two previous starts against the SeaWolves, Lawson is 0-0 with a 1.39 ERA (2 ER/13.0 IP), including a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings with one hit allowed on July 19 at The Diamond. In his most recent start, Lawson was hit with a loss despite allowing two runs (one earned) over 7.0 innings at Bowie on Wednesday. Over his last seven starts since July 14, Lawson has gone 3-3 with a 2.60 ERA (13 ER/45.0 IP). Lawson was signed as a minor-league free agent by the Giants on April 23 after being released by the Tampa Bay Rays near the end of spring training. He was originally drafted by the Rays in the 12th round in 2016 out of the University of South Florida and reached Double-A for 14 outings (five starts) last season with the Montgomery Biscuits. **For more on Lawson, see page two.**

FOR ERIC: Right-hander Matt Manning makes his 23rd start of the season for the SeaWolves and his first against Richmond. He last took the mound on Thursday against Reading, when he worked 5.0 scoreless innings and allowed one hit, his fourth straight start with a winning decision. Over his last nine starts since June 21, Manning has gone 6-0 with a 2.66 ERA (14 ER/47.1 IP). Over his current four-start winning streak, Manning is 4-0 with a 1.08 ERA (3 ER/25.0 IP). Manning was drafted by the Tigers in the first round (ninth overall) and is currently ranked by MLB.com as the No. 27 prospect in baseball and the No. 7 RHP prospect.

KEEPING IT CLOSE: Since July 25, 19 of the Flying Squirrels' 25 games have been decided by two runs or less. In that span, the Flying Squirrels have played nine one-run games (4-5) and 10 two-run games (5-5). The games have also mostly been low-scoring. 20 of the last 25 games have had eight-or-less total runs, and 10 have had four-or-less total runs.

PITCHERS' DELIGHT: The 2019 season has been the "Year of the Pitcher" in the Eastern League. There have been eight no-hitters thrown in the league this year, one shy of the record nine no-hitters in 1967. On the season, the league has combined for a 3.57 ERA, the second-lowest in all of minor league baseball's full-season leagues, down from last year's mark of 4.01 and the lowest in the EL since 1990 (3.33). The league's offenses have combined to hit .239, the lowest of all MiLB full-season leagues, which is down from .253 last season and the lowest in the EL since 1971 (.234). Richmond's offense has been held to a .217 batting average, which would be tied for the fifth-lowest since the EL became a Double-A circuit in 1963 (last - 1967 York White Roses). The last time a team had a lower batting average was 1968 (Binghamton Triplets - .210, Elmira Pioneers - .214).

STRONG ARMS: The Flying Squirrels have posted a 2.29 ERA in 19 games in the month of August, which is the best in the Eastern League (second-best in all of Double-A). Of those 19 games, the Flying Squirrels have held their opponent to four-or-less runs 16 times, including 13 of the last 14 games since August 6. Richmond starters have combined for a 2.46 ERA (26 ER/95.0 IP) this month. The Richmond bullpen has posted a 2.02 ERA (14 ER/62.1 IP).

A SERIES OF UNFORTUNATE EVENTS: On the season, the Flying Squirrels have won eight series, lost 25 and split five. Six of their eight series wins have come on the road. The Flying Squirrels have lost five of the last six home sets but have won three of their last five road series.

TOP OF THE CLASS: The Flying Squirrels received top two prospects in the Giants' system on August 9 with the additions of **Joey Bart** and **Heliot Ramos**. Bart is ranked first and Ramos is ranked second both MLB.com and *Baseball America's* top-30 Giants prospects lists. Bart is the highest drafted player in Flying Squirrels history (2nd overall - 2018). Ramos is the third-highest drafted player in franchise history (19th overall - 2017), trailing Tyler Beede (14th overall - 2014). All time, the Flying Squirrels roster has featured 22 players selected in the first round of the MLB Draft. Bart is also the highest ranked player on *Baseball America's* Top 100 prospects list (No. 17) in Flying Squirrels franchise history.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: Outfielder **Heliot Ramos** became the youngest player in Flying Squirrels franchise history (19 years, 336 days) with his debut on August 9. He is the first teenager ever to suit up for the Flying Squirrels. Ramos is also the second-youngest player in the Eastern League this season behind Harrisburg's Luis Garcia. Ramos hit .385 (5-for-13) with a homer, a double, four RBIs and three walks through his first four Double-A games. He is batting .115 (3-for-26) in his last seven games.

FARGAS ON FIRE: In his last 13 games, **Johnshwy Fargas** is batting .325 (13-for-40) with a homer, two doubles, two RBIs and four steals. That stretch has raised his batting average to .251, which is the highest of all qualified hitters for the Flying Squirrels this season. In the second half of the season, Fargas is batting .279 (46-for-165) in 55 games.

CYR-IOUS: Reliever **Tyler Cyr** picked up the 25th save of his Flying Squirrels career on Tuesday, the third-most saves in a career in franchise history. Cyr trails only Daryl Maday (28) and Derek Law (26) on the list. Cyr collected 18 saves for the Flying Squirrels in 2017, which ranked third in the Eastern League that year. He picked up three saves in 2018 before an elbow injury ended his season in May. He has picked up four saves this year, and he has a save in each of his last three appearances.

A LITTLE RELIEF: Over the last 65 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 2.48 ERA (63 ER/228.2 IP) with 214 strikeouts and 87 walks. On the season, Richmond's 3.42 bullpen ERA is the third-highest in the league. **Ryan Halstead** has gone 1-2 with a 1.39 ERA (6 ER/39.0 IP) in his last 23 games since May 5. **Tyler Cyr** has posted a 1.23 ERA (4 ER/29.1 IP) in his last 21 games since June 5. **Raffi Vizcaino** has a 1.71 ERA (5 ER/26.1 IP) in his last 18 appearances since June 11. **Caleb Simpson** has a 1.61 ERA (4 ER/22.1 IP) in his last 17 outings since June 18. **Carlos Navas** has combined for a 1.78 ERA (7 ER/35.1 IP) in his 16 total appearances with the Flying Squirrels this year. **Sam Wolff** has not allowed a run in his last eight appearances since June 24, totaling 11.0 innings. **Sam Moll** has a 0.84 ERA (1 ER/10.2 IP) over his last eight outings since July 21.

GRAND LARCENY: This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 118 stolen bases. **Johnshwy Fargas** leads the league with 44 steals this year. Fargas has the second-most steals in a season in franchise history, trailing only the 49 by **Kelby Tomlinson** in 2014, and has the third-most career steals in team history. He is also ranked tied for fifth in all of MiLB in steals on the year. **Jalen Miller** is fourth in the league with 26 steals.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have five players included in *Baseball America's* Mid-Season Top-30 prospects: **Joey Bart** (1), **Heliot Ramos** (2), **Sean Hjelle** (7), **Garrett Williams** (21) and **Raffi Vizcaino** (27). There are also three players included on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list, including: Bart (1), Ramos (2), Hjelle (6) and Williams (28). Two players, Bart (16) and Ramos (66), are featured on *Baseball America's* Top 100 prospects list. Bart (21) and Ramos (55) are also listed on MLB.com's Top 100 prospects.
