YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels snapped a four-game losing streak with a 7-6 win over the Erie SeaWolves. Erie scored a run in the second inning, but **Zach Houchins** tied the game with a solo homer in the third. Erie pulled back ahead 3-1 in the fifth, but the Flying Squirrels scored four runs in the top of the sixth with an RBI double by **Joey Bart**, an RBI double by **Heliot Ramos**, a n RBI single by Houchins and an RBI single by **Gio Brusa** to take a 5-2 lead. The SeaWolves closed back within a run in the sixth inning at 5-4. Ramos drove in two runs with a double in the seventh to open a 7-4 lead. Kade Scivicque hit a solo homer and Kody Eaves brought in a run with a groundout in the seventh to close Erie back within a run. **Jamie Callahan** worked the final four outs of the game to pick up the save. **Sean Hjelle** allowed two runs over 5.0 innings for his first Double-A win.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a four-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. It is also the sixth of an eight-game road trip to Akron (0-4) and Erie (1-0), the last road trip of the season for Richmond. The Flying Squirrels dropped two of three at UPMC Park in their only other visit from May 13-15 and three of four at The Diamond from July 18-21. The Flying Squirrels won two of three against the SeaWolves from August 19-21, all in extras.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost four straight games to open the road trip before Monday night's win. Richmond sits last in the Western Division and is eliminated from postseason contention. Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .217 batting average, including a .210 average in August. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.65 team ERA, which is tied for sixth in the circuit. Richmond's -149 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Portland at -46).

THE SEAWOLVES have lost six of their last eight games since opening the series in Richmond on August 19. They had won seven of the previous nine from August 9-18. The SeaWolves are tied for first place in the West standing with Bowie. Erie leads the Eastern League with a .250 team batting average and ranks second with a 3.29 team ERA. Erie's roster includes 11 of MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects, including Casey Mize (1), Matt Manning (2), Tarik Skubal (4), Isaac Paredes (5), Alex Faedo (9 - on IL), Joey Wentz (10), Sergio Alcantara (15 - on IL), Kody Clemens (17), Anthony Castro (20), Derek Hill (28) and Alex Lange (29).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Caleb Baragar** makes his 20th start of the season for the Flying Squirrels and his third against Erie. In his two previous starts against Erie, Baragar has a 5.68 ERA (8 ER/12.2 IP). After back-to-back starts going 7.0 innings without allowing an earned run, Baragar allowed four runs over 5.2 innings in a no-decision at Akron on Thursday. Baragar is ranked ninth in the league in ERA (3.60), third in BAA (.194) and fourth in WHIP (1.07). Prior to joining Richmond, Baragar made one start with Triple-A Sacramento on May 2 and allowed five runs over 4.1 innings in a no-decision. He began the season with A-Adv. San Jose and went 0-1 with a 2.70 ERA in four starts and one relief outing. Baragar was drafted by the Giants in the ninth round in 2016 out of Indiana University and is in his fourth professional season. **For more on Baragar, see page two.**

FOR ERIE: Left-hander Jose Fernandez makes his second start of the season for the SeaWolves. He pitched eight relief outings for Erie, posting a 4.91 ERA. He made his first start in his most recent outing on Thursday at Harrisburg and allowed three runs over 4.0 innings. He has made one appearance against Richmond this season, when he worked 3.0 scoreless innings on July 19 at The Diamond in relief. Previously a member of the Blue Jays organization, Fernandez made 13 relief appearances in the majors with Toronto last year. He was claimed off waivers from the Blue Jays in November and is in his first season with the Tigers. Fernandez has made four relief appearances in the majors for the Tigers this year.

KEEPING IT CLOSE: Since July 25, 24 of the Flying Squirrels' 32 games have been decided by two runs or less. In that span, the Flying Squirrels have played 13 one-run games (6-7) and 11 two-run games (5-6). The games have also mostly been low-scoring. 24 of the last 32 games have had eight-or-less total runs, and 11 have had four-or-less total runs.

PITCHERS' DELIGHT: The 2019 season has been the "Year of the Pitcher" in the Eastern League. There have been eight no-hitters thrown in the league this year, one shy of the record nine no-hitters in 1967. On the season, the league has combined for a 3.56 ERA, the second-lowest in all of minor league baseball's full-season leagues, down from last year's mark of 4.01 and the lowest in the EL since 1990 (3.33). The league's offenses have combined to hit .239, tied for the lowest of all MiLB full-season leagues, which is down from .253 last season and the lowest in the EL since 1971 (.234). Richmond's offense has been held to a .217 batting average, which would be tied for the fifth-lowest since the EL became a Double-A circuit in 1963, matching the 1967 York White Roses.

STRONG ARMS: The Flying Squirrels have posted a 2.85 ERA in 26 games in the month of August, which is the second-best in the Eastern League. Of those 26 games, the Flying Squirrels have held their opponent to four-or-less runs 18 times. Richmond starters have combined for a 3.32 ERA (48 ER/130.1 IP) this month. The Richmond bullpen has posted a 2.23 ERA (23 ER/92.2 IP).

RULES OF THE ROAD: On the season, **Bryce Johnson** is batting .311 (32-for-103) in 28 road games, best among current players on the team. Johnson is batting .174 (15-for-86) in his 26 home games this year. Johnson is also batting .298 (34-for-114) when batting lead-off, compared to .173 (13-for-75) in all other spots in the order.

A SERIES OF UNFORTUNATE EVENTS: On the season, the Flying Squirrels have won nine series, lost 26 and split five. Six of their nine series wins have come on the road. The Flying Squirrels have won two straight home sets and have won three of their last six road series.

TOP OF THE CLASS: The Flying Squirrels received top two prospects in the Giants' system on August 9 with the additions of **Joey Bart** and **Heliot Ramos**. Bart is ranked first and Ramos is ranked second both MLB.com and *Baseball America's* top-30 Giants prospects lists. Bart is the highest drafted player in Flying Squirrels history (2nd overall - 2018). Ramos is the third-highest drafted player in franchise history (19th overall - 2017), trailing Tyler Beede (14th overall - 2014). All time, the Flying Squirrels roster has featured 22 players selected in the first round of the MLB Draft. Bart is also the highest ranked player on *Baseball America's* Top 100 prospects list (No. 17) in Flying Squirrels franchise history.

BART BASHING: In his last seven games, **Joey Bart** is batting .345 (10-for-29) with two homers, a double, three RBIs and three walks. He tied a career high with four hits on Monday at Erie. Bart is batting .391 in seven games on the road, compared to .171 in his nine games at The Diamond.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: Outfielder **Heliot Ramos** became the youngest player in Flying Squirrels franchise history (19 years, 336 days) with his debut on August 9. He is the first teenager ever to suit up for the Flying Squirrels. Ramos is also the second-youngest player in the Eastern League this season behind Harrisburg's Luis Garcia.

CYR-IOUS: Reliever **Tyler Cyr** picked up the 25th save of his Flying Squirrels career on Tuesday, the third-most saves in a career in franchise history. Cyr trails only Daryl Maday (28) and Derek Law (26) on the list. Cyr collected 18 saves for the Flying Squirrels in 2017, which ranked third in the Eastern League that year. He picked up three saves in 2018 before an elbow injury ended his season in May. He has picked up four saves this year, and he has a save in each of his last three appearances.

A LITTLE RELIEF: Over the last 72 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 2.50 ERA (72 ER/259.0 IP) with 233 strikeouts and 94 walks. **Tyler Cyr** has posted a 1.10 ERA (4 ER/32.2 IP) in his last 23 games since June 5. **Caleb Simpson** has a 2.10 ERA (6 ER/25.2 IP) in his last 20 outings since June 18. **Carlos Navas** has combined for a 1.60 ERA (7 ER/39.1 IP) in his 18 total appearances with the Flying Squirrels this year. **Sam Moll** has a 0.61 ERA (1 ER/14.2 IP) over his last 11 outings since July 21.

GRAND LARCENY: This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 123 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 45 steals this year. Fargas has the second-most steals in a season in franchise history, trailing only the 49 by **Kelby Tomlinson** in 2014, and has the third-most career steals in team history. He is also ranked tied for fifth in all of MiLB in steals on the year. **Jalen Miller** is fourth in the league with 27 steals.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have five players included in *Baseball America's* Mid-Season Top-30 prospects: **Joey Bart** (1), **Heliot Ramos** (2), **Sean Hjelle** (7), **Garrett Williams** (21) and **Raffi Vizcaino** (27). There are also three players included on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list, including: **Bart** (1), **Ramos** (2), **Hjelle** (6) and **Williams** (28). Two players, **Bart** (16) and **Ramos** (66), are featured on *Baseball America's* Top 100 prospects list. **Bart** (21) and **Ramos** (55) are also listed on MLB.com's Top 100 prospects.
