**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels led the lead late and fell to the Bowie Baysox, 5-3, snapping a season-high-tying four-game win streak. Bowie scored the game's first run in the first inning on an error. The Flying Squirrels tied the game in the second with an RBI single by **Ryan Howard** and took a 2-1 lead on an error. In the fifth, **Jacob Heyward** hit an RBI double to extend the lead to 3-1. Bowie broke up **Brandon Lawson's** no-hit bid in the seventh with a solo homer by Cedric Mullins to pull back within a run. In the eighth, Jesmuel Valentin doubled to tie the score and Preston Palmeiro gave the Baysox a 5-3 lead with a two-run single.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the second of a four-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Richmond has dropped four straight series against Bowie and 12 of the last 14 head-to-head games. This is the final series of the 2019 season.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** had won four straight games prior to last night's loss. Richmond sits fifth in the Western Division and is eliminated from postseason contention. Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .219 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.65 team ERA, which is ninth in the circuit. Richmond's -144 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Portland at -43). The Flying Squirrels have hit .300 (48-for-160) over the last six games with 17 extra-base hits.

**THE BAYSOX** have won seven of their last 10 games and currently lead the Western Division standings by 2.0 games over Erie. Bowie's pitching staff has combined for a 3.17 ERA this season, best in the league. The Baysox offense is batting .247 this season, second in the league, and lead the league with a .257 average in August. The Bowie roster includes eight of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including Yusniel Diaz (5), Michael Baumann (9), Zac Lowther (10), Ryan McKenna (13), Cody Sedlock (17), LHP Alex Wells (20), Mason McCoy (25) and Brett Cumberland (30).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Sean Hjelle** makes his fifth Double-A start and third against the Baysox. He faced Bowie in each of his first two Double-A starts and allowed nine earned runs over 9.2 IP (8.38 ERA). Last time out, he picked up his first Double-A win on Monday at Erie, allowing two runs over 5.0 innings. He began the season with Single-A Augusta, going 1-2 with a 2.66 ERA in nine starts. He was promoted to A-Adv. San Jose on May 20 and posted a 5-5 record with a 2.78 ERA in 14 starts. His ERA ranked second in the California League among pitchers during the time he was in the league and had the third-most innings pitched (77.2). Hjelle was drafted by the Giants in the second round in 2018 out of the University of Kentucky. *For more on Hjelle, see page two.*

**FOR BOWIE:** Right-hander Cody Sedlock makes his sixth Double-A start and ninth overall appearance for the Baysox. He last pitched on Monday at Reading and allowed three runs over 4.0 innings with six strikeouts in a loss. He has faced Richmond twice, both times at The Diamond. He pitched 5.0 no-hit innings with a Double-A-high seven strikeouts on July 22 in a no-decision. He pitched in Richmond again on August 10 and allowed two runs over 2.2 innings with a Double-A-high four walks in a no-decision. Sedlock was drafted by the Orioles in the first round (27th overall) in 2016 out of the University of Illinois.

**KEEPING IT CLOSE:** Since July 25, 27 of the Flying Squirrels' 36 games have been decided by two runs or less. In that span, the Flying Squirrels have played 14 one-run games (7-7) and 13 two-run games (6-7). The games have also mostly been low-scoring. 26 of the last 35 games have had eight-or-less total runs, and 11 have had four-or-less total runs.

**PITCHERS' DELIGHT:** The 2019 season has been the "Year of the Pitcher" in the Eastern League. There have been eight no-hitters thrown in the league this year, one shy of the record nine no-hitters in 1967. On the season, the league has combined for a 3.55 ERA, the second-lowest in all of minor league baseball's full-season leagues, down from last year's mark of 4.01 and the lowest in the EL since 1990 (3.33). The league's offenses have combined to hit .239, tied for the lowest of all MiLB full-season leagues, which is down from .253 last season and the lowest in the EL since 1971 (.234). Richmond's offense has been held to a .219 batting average, which would be tied for the seventh-lowest since the EL became a Double-A circuit in 1963 and lowest since 1975.

**STRONG ARMS:** The Flying Squirrels have posted a 2.92 ERA in 30 games in the month of August, which is the second-best in the Eastern League. Of those 30 games, the Flying Squirrels have held their opponent to four-or-less runs 19 times. Richmond starters have combined for a 3.29 ERA (56 ER/153.1 IP) this month. The Richmond bullpen has posted a 2.37 ERA (27 ER/102.2 IP).

**RULES OF THE ROAD:** On the season, **Bryce Johnson** is batting .300 (33-for-110) in 30 road games, best among current players on the team. Johnson is batting .167 (15-for-90) in his 27 home games this year. Johnson is also batting .298 (34-for-114) when batting lead-off, compared to .163 (14-for-86) in all other spots in the order.

**A SERIES OF UNFORTUNATE EVENTS:** On the season, the Flying Squirrels have won 10 series, lost 26 and split five. Seven of their 10 series wins have come on the road. The Flying Squirrels have won two straight home sets and have won four of their last seven road series.

**TOP OF THE CLASS:** The Flying Squirrels received top two prospects in the Giants' system on August 9 with the additions of **Joey Bart** and **Heliot Ramos**. Bart is ranked first and Ramos is ranked second both MLB.com and *Baseball America's* top-30 Giants prospects lists. Bart is the highest drafted player in Flying Squirrels history (2nd overall - 2018). Ramos is the third-highest drafted player in franchise history (19th overall - 2017), trailing Tyler Beede (14th overall - 2014). All time, the Flying Squirrels roster has featured 22 players selected in the first round of the MLB Draft. Bart is also the highest ranked player on *Baseball America's* Top 100 prospects list (No. 17) in Flying Squirrels franchise history.

**BART BASHING:** In his last 11 games, **Joey Bart** is batting .390 (16-for-41) with three homers, two doubles, five RBIs and five walks. He tied a career high with four hits on Monday at Erie and matched it again on Thursday. Bart is batting .412 in 10 games on the road, compared to .194 in his ten games at The Diamond.

**YOUTH MOVEMENT:** Outfielder **Heliot Ramos** became the youngest player in Flying Squirrels franchise history (19 years, 336 days) with his debut on August 9. He is the first teenager ever to suit up for the Flying Squirrels. Ramos is also the second-youngest player in the Eastern League this season behind Harrisburg's Luis Garcia.

**HOWARD HEATING UP:** In his last seven games, **Ryan Howard** is batting .360 (9-for-25) with a homer, two doubles, a walk and five RBIs. He has two multi-hit games in that stretch. Over his last 44 games since July 17, Howard has hit .279 (41-for-147), which leads the team in that span, which has increased his season batting average from .173 to .223.

**WALK THIS WAY:** **Jacob Heyward** has 80 walks this season, a franchise record and most in the league. He is batting just .087 (2-for-23) in his last nine games, but he has worked 10 walks in that stretch. Heyward's .360 on-base percentage is sixth in the league. Heyward has the second-most walks in the league over the last five seasons, trailing only the 100 walks by New Hampshire's Cavan Biggio from 2018.

**A LITTLE RELIEF:** Over the last 76 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 2.54 ERA (76 ER/269.0 IP) with 246 strikeouts and 99 walks. **Tyler Cyr** has posted a 1.08 ERA (4 ER/33.1 IP) in his last 24 games since June 5. **Caleb Simpson** has a 1.98 ERA (6 ER/27.1 IP) in his last 21 outings since June 18. **Carlos Navas** has combined for a 1.56 ERA (7 ER/40.1 IP) in his 18 total appearances with the Flying Squirrels this year. **Sam Moll** has a 0.58 ERA (1 ER/15.2 IP) over his last 12 outings since July 21. **Rodolfo Martinez** has not allowed an earned run in his four outings (5.1 IP) since returning to the Flying Squirrels.

**GRAND LARCENY:** This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 128 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 49 steals this year. Fargas tied the record for the most steals in a season in franchise history, matching the 49 by **Kelby Tomlinson** in 2014, and has the third-most career steals in team history. He is also ranked fourth in all of MiLB in steals on the year. **Jalen Miller** is tied for sixth in the league with 27 steals.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have five players included in *Baseball America's* Mid-Season Top-30 prospects: **Joey Bart** (1), **Heliot Ramos** (2), **Sean Hjelle** (7), **Garrett Williams** (21) and **Raffi Vizcaino** (27). There are also three players included on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list, including: Bart (1), Ramos (2), Hjelle (6) and Williams (28). Two players, Bart (16) and Ramos (66), are featured on *Baseball America's* Top 100 prospects list. Bart (21) and Ramos (55) are also listed on MLB.com's Top 100 prospects.
