UPCOMING GAMES & PROBABLE PITCHERS

Mon., Sept. 2 Bowie 1:05 p.m. LHP Alex Wells (8-5, 2.75) vs. LHP Caleb Baragar (4-5, 3.60)

YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Bowie Baysox, 3-2, on a two-run, walk-off double by **Joey Bart** in the bottom of the tenth inning. It was the 22nd extra-inning game for the Flying Squirrels, extending a franchise record and the most in all of minor league baseball this season. Richmond scored the game's first run in the second inning with a bases-loaded walk by **Bryce Johnson**. Bowie evened the score in the fourth with an RBI single by Preston Palmeiro. Cedric Mullins put the Baysox ahead in the top of the 10th with an RBI single. Bart's game-winning double scored Johnson from second and **Johneshwy Fargas** from first base. Fargas also picked up a stolen base in the game, tying him with Kelby Tomlinson for the most in a season in team history with 49.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the third of a four-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Richmond has dropped four straight series against Bowie and 12 of the last 14 head-to-head games. This is the final series of the 2019 season.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won five of their last six games. Richmond sits fifth in the Western Division and is eliminated from postseason contention. Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .219 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.62 team ERA, which is seventh in the circuit. Richmond's -143 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Portland at -41). The Flying Squirrels have hit .278 (54-for-194) over the last six games with 19 extra-base hits.

THE BAYSOX have won seven of their last 11 games and currently lead the Western Division standings by 1.0 game over Erie. Bowie's pitching staff has combined for a 3.16 ERA this season, best in the league. The Baysox offense is batting .247 this season, second in the league, and is tied for the league lead with a .257 average in August. The Bowie roster includes eight of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including Yushnel Diaz (5), Michael Baumann (9), Zac Lowther (10), Ryan McKenna (13), Cody Sedlock (17), LHP Alex Wells (20), Mason McCoy (25) and Brett Cumberland (30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Carlos Sano** makes his Double-A debut for the Flying Squirrels. He has pitched 16 total games this year between the rookie-level AZL Giants Orange (1-0, 7.36), A-Adv. San Jose (1-1, 6.00) and Triple-A Sacramento (0-0, 54.00). Sano signed with the Giants at the age of 24 in November 2017 after pitching in La Liga Nicaraguense de Beisbol Profesional (LNBP) with Gigantes de Rivas. He spent most of 2018 with A-Adv. San Jose, going 5-5 with a 3.81 ERA in 20 games (12 starts). **For More on Sano, see page two.**

FOR BOWIE: Left-hander Zac Lowther makes his 26th start of the season for the Baysox and his second against Richmond. He faced the Flying Squirrels on August 11 at The Diamond and allowed three runs (two earned) over 7.0 innings with eight strikeouts in a loss. Last time out, Lowther worked 6.0 innings and allowed one run in a no-decision at Reading on Tuesday. Lowther was an Eastern League All-Star this year, and he leads the league in wins (13). He also ranks third in ERA (2.66), second in strikeouts (145), tied for fourth in games started (25), ranks fourth in innings pitched (142.0), fourth in BAA (.198) and sixth in WHIP (1.13). Lowther was drafted in the second round (CBB) by the Orioles in 2017 out of Xavier.

KEEPING IT CLOSE: Since July 25, 28 of the Flying Squirrels' 37 games have been decided by two runs or less. In that span, the Flying Squirrels have played 15 one-run games (8-7) and 13 two-run games (6-7). The games have also mostly been low-scoring. 27 of the last 36 games have had eight-or-less total runs, and 11 have had four-or-less total runs.

PITCHERS' DELIGHT: The 2019 season has been the "Year of the Pitcher" in the Eastern League. There have been eight no-hitters thrown in the league this year, one shy of the record nine no-hitters in 1967. On the season, the league has combined for a 3.54 ERA, the second-lowest in all of minor league baseball's full-season leagues, down from last year's mark of 4.01 and the lowest in the EL since 1990 (3.33). The league's offenses have combined to hit .238, the lowest of all MiLB full-season leagues, which is down from .253 last season and the lowest in the EL since 1971 (.234). Richmond's offense has been held to a .219 batting average, which would be tied for the seventh-lowest since the EL became a Double-A circuit in 1963 and lowest since 1975.

STRONG ARMS: The Flying Squirrels have posted a 2.84 ERA in 31 games since August 1, which is the second-best in the Eastern League. Of those 31 games, the Flying Squirrels have held their opponent to four-or-less runs 20 times. Richmond starters have combined for a 3.24 ERA (57 ER/158.1 IP). The Richmond bullpen has posted a 2.26 ERA (27 ER/107.2 IP).

RULES OF THE ROAD: On the season, **Bryce Johnson** is batting .300 (33-for-110) in 30 road games, best among current players on the team. Johnson is batting .161 (15-for-93) in his 28 home games this year. Johnson is also batting .298 (34-for-114) when batting lead-off, compared to .157 (14-for-89) in all other spots in the order.

A SERIES OF UNFORTUNATE EVENTS: On the season, the Flying Squirrels have won 10 series, lost 26 and split five. Seven of their 10 series wins have come on the road. The Flying Squirrels have won two straight home sets and have won four of their last seven road series.

TOP OF THE CLASS: The Flying Squirrels received top two prospects in the Giants' system on August 9 with the additions of **Joey Bart** and **Heliot Ramos**. Bart is ranked first and Ramos is ranked second both MLB.com and *Baseball America's* top-30 Giants prospects lists. Bart is the highest drafted player in Flying Squirrels history (2nd overall - 2018). Ramos is the third-highest drafted player in franchise history (19th overall - 2017), trailing Tyler Beede (14th overall - 2014). All time, the Flying Squirrels roster has featured 22 players selected in the first round of the MLB Draft. Bart is also the highest ranked player on *Baseball America's* Top 100 prospects list (No. 17) in Flying Squirrels franchise history.

BART BASHING: In his last 12 games, **Joey Bart** is batting .391 (18-for-46) with three homers, three doubles, seven RBIs and five walks. He tied a career high with four hits last Monday at Erie and matched it again on Thursday. Bart is batting .412 in 10 games on the road, compared to .220 in his 11 games at The Diamond.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: Outfielder **Heliot Ramos** became the youngest player in Flying Squirrels franchise history (19 years, 336 days) with his debut on August 9. He is the first teenager ever to suit up for the Flying Squirrels. Ramos is also the second-youngest player in the Eastern League this season behind Harrisburg's Luis Garcia. With his debut tonight, **Anyesber Sivira** will become the new youngest player to debut for the Flying Squirrels (19 years, 235 days) and the first player born in the new millennium.

A LITTLE RELIEF: Over the last 77 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 2.50 ERA (76 ER/274.0 IP) with 249 strikeouts and 100 walks. **Tyler Cyr** has posted a 1.08 ERA (4 ER/33.1 IP) in his last 24 games since June 5. **Caleb Simpson** has a 1.98 ERA (6 ER/27.1 IP) in his last 21 outings since June 18. **Carlos Navas** has combined for a 1.56 ERA (7 ER/40.1 IP) in his 18 total appearances with the Flying Squirrels this year. **Sam Moll** has a 0.58 ERA (1 ER/15.2 IP) over his last 12 outings since July 21. **Rodolfo Martinez** has not allowed an earned run in his four outings (5.1 IP) since returning to the Flying Squirrels.

GRAND LARCENY: This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 128 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 49 steals this year. Fargas tied the record for the most steals in a season in franchise history, matching the 49 by **Kelby Tomlinson** in 2014, and has the third-most career steals in team history. He is also ranked fourth in all of MiLB in steals on the year. **Jalen Miller** is tied for sixth in the league with 27 steals.

RECORD YEAR: The Flying Squirrels have set a handful of new team records this season. The pitching staff has struck out 1,150 batters (previous - 1,096/2011) and currently has posted the lowest BAA at .239 (previous - .242/2015). **Garrett Williams** set the record for the most hit batters (15), **Melvin Adon** tied the mark for the most intentional walks (5) and **Chase Johnson** issued the most wild pitches (19). **Caleb Baragar** currently holds the mark for lowest BAA at .195 (previous - .231/Eric Surkamp/2011). On the offensive side, the team is on pace to set the record for lowest batting average at .219 (previous - .240/2018), fewest runs scored at 449 (previous - 503/2015), fewest hits with 960 (previous - 1,056/2018), fewest RBIs with 421 (previous - 462/2015) and fewest total bases at 1,441 (previous - 1,586/2015). The offense has already set the team records for strikeouts with 1,205, caught stealing with 76 and shutouts with 18. **Jacob Heyward** set the record for most walks with 80 and currently holds the record for lowest batting average at .209. **Johneshwy Fargas** is tied for the most steals with 49 and has the most caught stealing with 23. **Gio Brusa** has the most homers by a switch-hitter with 12. The team has set the record for the most errors with 136 and is on pace to set the lowest fielding percentage at .973 (previous - .974/2018). **Hamlet Marte** set the record for the most passed balls with 10 and Fargas is tied for the most outfield assists with 13. As a team overall, 84 losses, a .387 winning percentage and 46 home losses are all records. The team's 22 extra-inning games and 14 extra-inning losses are also new records.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have five players included in *Baseball America's* Mid-Season Top-30 prospects: **Joey Bart** (1), **Heliot Ramos** (2), **Sean Hjelle** (7), **Garrett Williams** (21) and **Raffi Vizcaino** (27). There are also three players included on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list, including: Bart (1), Ramos (2), Hjelle (6) and Williams (28). Two players, Bart (16) and Ramos (66), are featured on *Baseball America's* Top 100 prospects list. Bart (21) and Ramos (55) are also listed on MLB.com's Top 100 prospects.

THIS DATE IN HISTORY

In 2010, Darren Ford made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants, becoming the first Flying Squirrels alum to reach the majors. That year for Richmond, Ford hit .251 with five homers and 40 RBIs over his 113 Eastern League games and led the team with 37 stolen bases, which ranked second in the Eastern League and held as a franchise record until 2014. He also tied the league lead with nine triples. Ford played 206 total games in his career for the Flying Squirrels and 33 with the Giants in 2010 & 2011.
