YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Bowie Baysox, 2-1, with two runs in the eighth inning in front of a crowd of 9,354 fans. Scoreless entering the bottom of the eighth, **Jalen Miller** hit an RBI single and **Joey Bart** added a second run with an RBI groundout, beating out a potential inning-ending double play at first base. In the top of the ninth, Cedric Mullins scored after a fielding error by Miller to close the score to 2-1. Bowie loaded the bases, but **Garrett Williams** struck out Jesmuel Valentin looking to end the game. In their Double-A debuts, **Carlos Sano** and **Cooper Casad** combined for 6.0 scoreless innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the final game of 2019, the last of a four-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The Flying Squirrels are aiming to win their fourth series in the last five sets to close out the year.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won six of their last seven games. Richmond sits fifth in the Western Division and is eliminated from postseason contention. Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .218 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.60 team ERA, which is tied for sixth in the circuit. Richmond's -142 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Portland at -47). The Flying Squirrels have hit .268 (60-for-224) over the last seven games with 22 extra-base hits.

THE BAYSOX have won seven of their last 12 games and clinched the Western Division Second Half title on Sunday night. The Baysox are in the playoffs for the third time in the last five years and will face Harrisburg in the Division Series. Bowie's pitching staff has combined for a 3.15 ERA this season, best in the league. The Baysox offense is batting .246 this season, second in the league, and is tied for the league lead with a .257 average in August. The Bowie roster includes eight of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including Yusniel Diaz (5), Michael Baumann (9), Zac Lowther (10), Ryan McKenna (13), Cody Sedlock (17), LHP Alex Wells (20), Mason McCoy (25) and Brett Cumberland (30).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Caleb Baragar** makes his 21st start of the season for the Flying Squirrels and his second against the Baysox. He last faced Bowie on August 10 at The Diamond in the first game of a double-header, and he pitched all 7.0 innings and allowed one unearned run in a loss. He made his Double-A debut in his lone Double-A relief appearance at Bowie on May 10 and allowed four unearned runs. Last time out, he allowed two runs over 5.0 innings in a win at Erie on Wednesday. Over his last four starts since August 10, Baragar has gone 1-1 with a 2.13 ERA (6 ER/25.1 IP). On the season, Baragar ranks tenth in the league in ERA (3.60) and fifth in WHIP (1.07). He has held opposing batters to a .195 batting average, which is third in the league and would be a franchise record. Prior to joining Richmond, Baragar made one start with Triple-A Sacramento on May 2 and allowed five runs over 4.1 innings in a no-decision. He began the season with A-Adv. San Jose and went 0-1 with a 2.70 ERA in four starts and one relief outing. Baragar was drafted by the Giants in the ninth round in 2016 out of Indiana University and is in his fourth professional season. *For more on Baragar, see page two.*

FOR BOWIE: Left-hander Alex Wells makes his 24th start of the season for the Baysox and his second against Richmond. He faced the Flying Squirrels on August 13 in Bowie and allowed four runs over 6.0 innings, including two homers. He last pitched on Wednesday at Reading and was hit with a loss, his fourth straight losing decision since July 26. An Eastern League All-Star, Wells is ranked fifth in the league in ERA (2.75), seventh in innings pitched (134.0), sixth in BAA (.231) and third in WHIP (1.04). Wells has earned an All-Star selection in all four of his professional seasons.

KEEPING IT CLOSE: Since July 25, 29 of the Flying Squirrels' 38 games have been decided by two runs or less. In that span, the Flying Squirrels have played 16 one-run games (9-7) and 13 two-run games (6-7). The games have also mostly been low-scoring. 28 of the last 37 games have had eight-or-less total runs, and 12 have had four-or-less total runs.

PITCHERS' DELIGHT: The 2019 season has been the "Year of the Pitcher" in the Eastern League. There have been eight no-hitters thrown in the league this year, one shy of the record nine no-hitters in 1967. On the season, the league has combined for a 3.54 ERA, the second-lowest in all of minor league baseball's full-season leagues, down from last year's mark of 4.01 and the lowest in the EL since 1990 (3.33). The league's offenses have combined to hit .238, the lowest of all MiLB full-season leagues, which is down from .253 last season and the lowest in the EL since 1971 (.234). Richmond's offense has been held to a .218 batting average, which would be tied for the sixth-lowest since the EL became a Double-A circuit in 1963 and lowest since 1972.

STRONG ARMS: The Flying Squirrels have posted a 2.75 ERA (84 ER/275.0 IP) in 32 games since August 1, which is the second-best in the Eastern League. Of those 32 games, the Flying Squirrels have held their opponent to four-or-less runs 21 times. Richmond starters have combined for a 3.20 ERA (57 ER/160.1 IP). The Richmond bullpen has posted a 2.12 ERA (27 ER/114.2 IP).

RULES OF THE ROAD: On the season, **Bryce Johnson** is batting .300 (33-for-110) in 30 road games, best among current players on the team. Johnson is batting .167 (16-for-96) in his 29 home games this year. Johnson is also batting .298 (34-for-114) when batting lead-off, compared to .163 (15-for-92) in all other spots in the order.

A SERIES OF UNFORTUNATE EVENTS: On the season, the Flying Squirrels have won 10 series, lost 26 and split five. Seven of their 10 series wins have come on the road. The Flying Squirrels have won two straight home sets and have won four of their last seven road series. They have also won three of their last four series.

TOP OF THE CLASS: The Flying Squirrels received top two prospects in the Giants' system on August 9 with the additions of **Joey Bart** and **Heliot Ramos**. Bart is ranked first and Ramos is ranked second both MLB.com and *Baseball America's* top-30 Giants prospects lists. Bart is the highest drafted player in Flying Squirrels history (2nd overall - 2018). Ramos is the third-highest drafted player in franchise history (19th overall - 2017), trailing Tyler Beede (14th overall - 2014). All time, the Flying Squirrels roster has featured 22 players selected in the first round of the MLB Draft. Bart is also the highest ranked player on *Baseball America's* Top 100 prospects list (No. 17) in Flying Squirrels franchise history.

BART BASHING: In his last 13 games, **Joey Bart** is batting .400 (20-for-50) with three homers, four doubles, a triple, eight RBIs and five walks. He tied a career high with four hits last Monday at Erie and matched it again on Thursday. Bart is batting .412 in 10 games on the road, compared to .244 in his 12 games at The Diamond.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: Outfielder **Heliot Ramos** became the youngest player in Flying Squirrels franchise history (19 years, 336 days) with his debut on August 9. He is the first teenager ever to suit up for the Flying Squirrels. Ramos is also the second-youngest player in the Eastern League this season behind Harrisburg's Luis Garcia. With his debut Sunday, **Anyesber Sivira** will become the new youngest player to debut for the Flying Squirrels (19 years, 235 days) and the first player born in the new millennium (January 9, 2000).

A LITTLE RELIEF: Over the last 78 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 2.43 ERA (76 ER/281.0 IP) with 256 strikeouts and 103 walks. **Tyler Cyr** has posted a 1.08 ERA (4 ER/33.1 IP) in his last 24 games since June 5. **Caleb Simpson** has a 1.91 ERA (6 ER/28.1 IP) in his last 22 outings since June 18. **Rodolfo Martinez** has not allowed an earned run in his four outings (5.1 IP) since returning to the Flying Squirrels.

GRAND LARCENY: This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 129 stolen bases. **Jhoneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 50 steals this year. Fargas broke the record for the most steals in a season in franchise history on Sunday, passing the 49 by **Kelby Tomlinson** in 2014, and has the third-most career steals in team history. He is also ranked fourth in all of MiLB in steals on the year. **Jalen Miller** is tied for sixth in the league with 27 steals.

RECORD YEAR: The Flying Squirrels have set a handful of new team records this season. The pitching staff has struck out 1,157 batters (previous - 1,096/2011) and currently has posted the lowest BAA at .239 (previous - .242/2015). **Garrett Williams** set the record for the most hit batters (15), **Melvin Adon** tied the mark for the most intentional walks (5) and **Chase Johnson** issued the most wild pitches (19). **Caleb Baragar** currently holds the mark for lowest BAA at .195 (previous - .231/Eric Surkamp/2011). On the offensive side, the team is on pace to set the record for lowest batting average at .218 (previous - .240/2018), fewest runs scored at 451 (previous - 503/2015), fewest hits with 966 (previous - 1,056/2018), fewest RBIs with 423 (previous - 462/2015) and fewest total bases at 1,451 (previous - 1,586/2015). The offense has already set the team records for strikeouts with 1,219, caught stealing with 76 and shutouts with 18. **Jacob Heyward** set the record for most walks with 80 and currently holds the record for lowest batting average at .209. **Jhoneshwy Fargas** has broken the record for the most steals with 50 and has the most caught stealing with 23. **Gio Brusa** has the most homers by a switch-hitter with 12. The team has set the record for the most errors with 137 and is on pace to set the lowest fielding percentage at .973 (previous - .974/2018). **Hamlet Marte** set the record for the most passed balls with 10 and Fargas is tied for the most outfield assists with 13. As a team overall, 84 losses, a .391 winning percentage and 46 home losses are all records. The team's 22 extra-inning games and 14 extra-inning losses are also new records.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have five players included in *Baseball America's* Mid-Season Top-30 prospects: **Joey Bart** (1), **Heliot Ramos** (2), **Sean Hjelle** (7), **Garrett Williams** (21) and **Raffi Vizcaino** (27). There are also three players included on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list, including: Bart (1), Ramos (2), Hjelle (6) and Williams (28). Two players, Bart (16) and Ramos (66), are featured on *Baseball America's* Top 100 prospects list. Bart (21) and Ramos (55) are also listed on MLB.com's Top 100 prospects.
