HOPS TRAVEL TO EUGENE FOR FIRST TIME IN 2018

THIS SERIES: The Hops and Eugene Emeralds meet for their second series of the year; Eugene took 2 of 3 at Ron Tonkin Field from June 20-22; the Ems had also won their first series of the year in Vancouver June 15-19; but since winning those first two series, Eugene has dropped four series in a row.

MAYBE NOT ON THE HOME STRETCH

YET... but with 16 games remaining in the half, the first-half pennant race is entering the final turn. By winning the last two games at Salem-Keizer, the Hops have built their largest lead of the season (two games), and they hold the tie-breaker over Salem-Keizer. Boise is three games out, and Eugene sits seven back.

PLAYING (AND WINNING) IT CLOSE:

The Hops have played the most one-run games in the NWL in 2018 (9, tied with Salem-Keizer), and Hillsboro has the best record in the NWL in one-run games (8-1). That also fits with the historical trend: incredibly, since entering the league in 2013, the Hops are THIRTY-FOUR games above .500 in one-run games (79-45).

VS. EUGENE: The Hops are 36-27 all-time vs. Eugene (37-31 including the playoffs), and they are 17-13 at P.K. Park (17-16 including postseason). **However, the Hops have dropped 9 of their last 10 here** (regular season & postseason combined).

TRENDS ENTERING SATURDAY:

Hillsboro has won 11 of 13... INF **Jose Caballero** has a reached base via hit or walk in 14 straight... 1B **Francis Martinez** has hit in 8 straight (9x32) a season-high for any Hop... C **Andy Yerzy**'s four-hit game on Friday was the first four-hit game by a Hop in 2018, and the 31st in franchise history.
