Home Cooking Continues: The Chukars, who are 8-0 at home in 2019, look to move to 9-0 today and sweep the Great Falls Voyagers. Bryar Johnson takes the ball for Idaho Falls, making his first start. Johnson pitched 2.1 innings out of the bullpen in Great Falls on Tuesday, allowing one run. 2019 21st round selection Chase Solesky goes for the Voyagers. The former Tulane righty has pitched just three innings in his professional career.

Offense Early & Often: The Chukars at home have made it a habit of scoring in bunches early, and last night against Great Falls was no different. Idaho Falls scored three runs in the first inning before an out was recorded, thanks to a solo homer from Clay Dungan, along with RBI doubles from Brady McConnell & Rhett Aplin. One more run came in the second and two in the fourth, with Chukars starting pitcher Stephen Ridings holding Great Falls at bay. Ridings allowed just one unearned run over six innings, making him the first Chukars pitcher to complete six innings in a start this season.

Familiar Faces: Omar Ramirez returns to manage the Chukars for the second straight season and fifth overall. Ramirez was the skipper from 2012-2014, presiding over the 2013 Pioneer League champion Chukars. Damon Hollins returns to the club but in a new capacity, shifting from hitting coach to bench coach. Hollins is also serving as a roving outfield & base running coordinator this season. Six players who have previously donned Idaho Falls uniforms are back in 2019. Infielders Tyler James and pitcher Nathan Webb all played for Idaho Falls at some point in 2018. Brady Cox also returns, but he has been converted from a catcher to a pitcher. Jose Ramirez has also returned to the Chukars after being on loan to Oaxaca of the Mexican League.

So What's New?: With the relocation of the Helena Brewers to Colorado Springs, the Chukars have been moved into the Northern Division. This means that they will play the majority of their games against Great Falls, Missoula, and Billings. They will also only play two of the teams from the Southern Division this year, with those home and home matchups coming against Ogden & Orem. The Chukars have a new pitching coach in Clayton Mortensen, who takes over for Jeff Suppan after four seasons. Mortensen is a former major leaguer who is in his first professional season as a coach. The former St Louis Cardinals first round selection is a native of Rexburg, ID, located just north of Idaho Falls. Former major league infielder Chris Nelson takes over as hitting coach after spending last season as a coach with AA Northwest Arkansas.

Need For Speed: In just 47 games last season, Tyler James stole 38 bases, which led the Pioneer League. 2018 Chukar Nate Eaton was second in the league in steals, but finished 19 behind James.

A Dun-good Performance: On Sunday Chukars shortstop Clay Dungan recorded six hits in six at bats, making him the second Chukar in as many seasons to do so, as Kyle Kasser accomplished the feat against Orem. Dungan has hit safely in five of six games he's played in and has multiple hits in three of them. The 9th round selection by the Royals out of Indiana State has smacked five doubles, a triple, and a homer, accounting for almost half of his total hits.

Some League Leaders: The Chukars are currently first in the league in team ERA (3.22) and are the only team in the Pioneer League with a team ERA under four. Rhett Aplin currently leads the league in homers while Clay Dungan paces the league in batting average.

Meet Bryar Johnson: Bryar Johnson is in his third season of professional baseball. Johnson was selected in the 20th round of the 2017 MLB draft by the Royals out of Carolina Forest High School in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina.

Last Outing: Johnson pitched the final 2.1 innings out of the bullpen on Tuesday night in Great Falls, allowing one run on one hit, walking one and striking out four. It is his only appearance against the Voyagers this season.

Professional Past: Johnson made 23 combined professional appearances over his first two seasons in professional baseball. Today will mark just his fifth professional start.

Background: At Carolina Forest High School (S.C.), Johnson was named Rawlings Perfect Game Honorable Mention All-American and South Carolina 5A All-State Team...committed to Coastal Carolina before signing with Kansas City.

2019 Coaching Staff



Manager - Omar Ramirez (2nd Season, 5th Overall)

Omar Ramirez enters his 11th season in the Royals' organization, his second as manager in Idaho Falls. He previously managed at Burlington (2017), Lexington (2015-16) and Idaho Falls (2012-14) and was the Chukars' hitting coach in 2011, the same role he had at Burlington (R) in 2009 and Burlington (A) in 2010. Ramirez, the Indians' 31st-round pick in 1990 out of Hill Junior College in Texas, played outfield for eight seasons in the minors with the Indians and Astros before retiring following the 2001 season. Ramirez resides in his hometown of Santiago, Dominican Republic. Ramirez resides in his hometown of Santiago, Dominican Republic, with his wife, Betty.



Pitching Coach - Clayton Mortensen (1st Season)

Clayton Mortensen enters his first season as the Idaho Falls pitching coach and first overall as a coach. A first-round pick by St. Louis in 2007 out of Gonzaga University, Mortensen had a five-year Major League career with the Cardinals (2009), Athletics (2009-10), Rockies (2011) and Red Sox (2012-13). He pitched in the Royals' organization from 2013-17, mostly at Omaha (AAA). Mortensen is a native of Rexburg, ID, which is just north of Idaho Falls. Clayton and his wife, Janna, have a daughter, Harper.



Hitting Coach - Chris Nelson (1st Season)

Chris Nelson begins his first season as a coach with Idaho Falls after spending the 2018 season as a coach for AA Northwest Arkansas. Nelson is a former major league infielder who saw time in the big leagues with the Rockies (2010-2013), Yankees (2013), Angels (2013), and Padres (2014). He was the ninth overall selection by the Rockies in the 2004 draft out of Redan HS in Stone Mountain, GA.



Bench Coach - Damon Hollins (3rd Season)

Damon Hollins is in his 10th season with the Royals as a coach, his third in Idaho Falls. He will also serve as an assistant outfield, base running and bunting coordinator. He began his coaching career in the same capacity at Burlington (R) in 2010, then coached at Kane County (A) in 2011, Wilmington (A) in 2012, the Chukars from 2013-14 and Lexington (A) from 2015-16. Hollins, a fourth-round selection by Atlanta in 1992, played in the Majors for the Braves (1998, 2004), Dodgers (1998) and Devil Rays (2005-06). He spent the 2007 season in Japan with the Yomiuri Giants before playing for the Omaha Royals in 2008. Hollins resides in Litchfield Park, Ariz., with his wife, Patrice. They have three children: Tahari, Ameerah and Averi.



Athletic Trainer - Masa Koyanagi (1st Straight Season, 4th Overall)

Masanobu Koyanagi enters his second stint as the trainer at Idaho Falls, after previously serving there from 2008-10. Now in his 12th season with the Royals, Koyanagi also served as trainer for Northwest Arkansas (2012-18) and Wilmington (2011). Prior to his time with the Royals, Koyanagi served as an athletic trainer within the Milwaukee Brewers' organization (2003-2006). Koyanagi worked for two years as an athletic training intern with Giants (2001) and Tigers (2002) organizations prior to joining the Brewers in 2003. Koyanagi was also honored to work as the athletic trainer for WBC Champion Japanese National Team in 2006 and for the Chinese National Team in 2013. Koyanagi is a graduate of Fresno State University where he earned a bachelor's of science in kinesiology. He was born and raised in Fukuoka, Japan, but moved to the US in 1993 and is currently residing in Surprise, Ariz., with his wife, Misato, and two daughters, Maria and Monami.



Strength & Conditioning Specialist - Jamie Collins (1st Season)

Jamie Collins enters his first season in the Royals' organization as Idaho Falls' strength & conditioning coach. He is currently working towards his Master's of Education at Springfield College, after receiving his Bachelor's from Saint Joseph's College of Maine in 2017, where he played baseball for four seasons and was the strength coach during the 2018-19 season.

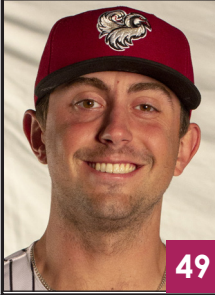
