It All Ends Tonight: The 2019 Pioneer League Championship Series concludes this evening as the Idaho Falls Chukars and the Ogden Raptors battle in a winner take all game three of the 2019 Pioneer League Championship Series. Alec Marsh goes for the Chukars, making his second start of the playoffs. Marsh in his first playoff start went a career high five innings, allowing two runs to Billings on Monday. Marsh's only start against Ogden he lasted just one inning, allowing four runs and throwing 40 pitches. Ogden will counter with right hander Elio Serrano, who started the playoff opener for the Raptors on September 8th. In that game he allowed one run on five hits over 5.1 innings, walking two and striking out four. He got the win in his only start against the Chukars on August 9th, allowing three runs on four hits over five innings.

Big Time Response: Needing a win to keep their season alive, the Chukars came up clutch last night in Ogden, breaking a two all tie in the sixth inning and never surrendering the lead from there. Rhett Aplin broke the tie with an RBI single, and Jimmy Govern extended the lead with an RBI single of his own. Anthony Veneziano came on in the fifth inning and pitched four hitless innings, facing just one over the minimum. Juan Carlos Negret blasted a two run shot in the eighth inning to extend the lead, and Jonah Dipoto finished off the win with a scoreless ninth inning. Dating back to the regular season, the Chukars have won three straight at Lindquist Field.

Hot Henry: Chukars outfielder Isaiah Henry has two hits in five of his past eight games, including two homers. His home run Sunday night in game one of the Northern Division Championship Series was the second home run he had hit against Billings this season. He also has at least one RBI in six straight games. In the Billings series Henry was 5-10 with a home run, three doubles and three RBI.

A Dun-good Performance: On June 23rd, Chukars shortstop Clay Dungan recorded six hits in six at bats, making him the second Chukar in as many seasons to do so, as Kyle Kasser accomplished the feat against Orem. Dungan has multiple hits in 27 games, which leads the team. He finished second in the league in batting average and first in hits. Dungan also had career best 15 game hitting streak, which is the longest for any Chukar in 2019. He finished the season on a 13 game hitting streak. Dungan over the All Star break was named the Royals Player of the Month for July at Idaho Falls.

Magnificent Marquez: Chukars infielder Jose Marquez finished second in the league in hits with 78 and fifth in batting average. Marquez hit a grand slam against Orem on August 12, his first homer of the season.

Post Season All Stars: Michael Emodi, Clay Dungan, and Rhett Aplin were the three Chukars named to the 2019 Pioneer League Post Season All Star Team. Aplin is the only one of the three that was not on the Midseason All Star Team. Emodi & Dungan both started in the All Star game.

#AlwaysRoyal: The Chukars were one of five Royals affiliates to make the playoffs in 2019, with all of them making their respective championship series. The Burlington Royals lost in the Championship series to the Johnson City Cardinals, while the Dominican Summer League Royals won the DSL title over the DSL Diamondbacks. The High A Wilmington Blue Rocks won the Carolina League title last night with a 2-0 win over Fayetteville in a decisive game five. The Low A Lexington Legends won the 2019 South Atlantic League title Friday night thanks to a walkoff three run homer by 2018 Chukar Reed Rohlman in the bottom of the 13th.

Meet Alec Marsh: Alec Marsh is entering his first professional season and is making his 15th professional appearance. Marsh was drafted by the Royals in the Compensation B round of the 2019 draft out of Arizona State University. Marsh in his only appearance against Ogden last just one inning on August 9th, allowing four runs, throwing 40 pitches and issuing multiple walks for the only time in his pro career.

Last Outing: Marsh went a career high five innings against Billings in Game Two of the Northern Division Championship Series, allowing just two runs, walking one, and striking out five. He got a no decision but left in line for the win.

The College Days: Marsh spent three seasons at Arizona State, where he won 12 games and made 29 starts. Marsh won nine games in 2019, which paced all Sun Devils. He was a Midseason 1st Team All American by Perfect Game, where at the time of the announcement he had a 0.94 ERA.

Pac 12 Pals: Including Marsh, there are four Pac 12 pitchers on the Chukars roster (Grant Gambrell - Oregon State, Austin Manning - USC, and Augie Sylk - USC).

2019 Coaching Staff



Manager - Omar Ramirez (2nd Season, 5th Overall)

Omar Ramirez enters his 11th season in the Royals' organization, his second as manager in Idaho Falls. He previously managed at Burlington (2017), Lexington (2015-16) and Idaho Falls (2012-14) and was the Chukars' hitting coach in 2011, the same role he had at Burlington (R) in 2009 and Burlington (A) in 2010. Ramirez, the Indians' 31st-round pick in 1990 out of Hill Junior College in Texas, played outfield for eight seasons in the minors with the Indians and Astros before retiring following the 2001 season. Ramirez resides in his hometown of Santiago, Dominican Republic. Ramirez resides in his hometown of Santiago, Dominican Republic, with his wife, Betty.



Pitching Coach - Clayton Mortensen (1st Season)

Clayton Mortensen enters his first season as the Idaho Falls pitching coach and first overall as a coach. A first-round pick by St. Louis in 2007 out of Gonzaga University, Mortensen had a five-year Major League career with the Cardinals (2009), Athletics (2009-10), Rockies (2011) and Red Sox (2012-13). He pitched in the Royals' organization from 2013-17, mostly at Omaha (AAA). Mortensen is a native of Rexburg, ID, which is just north of Idaho Falls.



Hitting Coach - Chris Nelson (1st Season)

Chris Nelson begins his first season as a coach with Idaho Falls after spending the 2018 season as a coach for AA Northwest Arkansas. Nelson is a former major league infielder who saw time in the big leagues with the Rockies (2010-2013), Yankees (2013), Angels (2013), and Padres (2014). He was the ninth overall selection by the Rockies in the 2004 draft out of Redan HS in Stone Mountain, GA.



Bench Coach - Damon Hollins (3rd Season)

Damon Hollins is in his 10th season with the Royals as a coach, his third in Idaho Falls. He will also serve as an assistant outfield, base running and bunting coordinator. He began his coaching career in the same capacity at Burlington (R) in 2010, then coached at Kane County (A) in 2011, Wilmington (A) in 2012, the Chukars from 2013-14 and Lexington (A) from 2015-16. Hollins, a fourth-round selection by Atlanta in 1992, played in the Majors for the Braves (1998, 2004), Dodgers (1998) and Devil Rays (2005-06). He spent the 2007 season in Japan with the Yomiuri Giants before playing for the Omaha Royals in 2008. Hollins resides in Litchfield Park, Ariz., with his wife, Patrice. They have three children: Tahari, Ameerah and Averi.



Athletic Trainer - Masa Koyanagi (1st Straight Season, 4th Overall)

Masanobu Koyanagi enters his second stint as the trainer at Idaho Falls, after previously serving there from 2008-10. Now in his 12th season with the Royals, Koyanagi also served as trainer for Northwest Arkansas (2012-18) and Wilmington (2011). Prior to his time with the Royals, Koyanagi served as an athletic trainer within the Milwaukee Brewers' organization (2003-2006). Koyanagi worked for two years as an athletic training intern with Giants (2001) and Tigers (2002) organizations prior to joining the Brewers in 2003. Koyanagi was also honored to work as the athletic trainer for WBC Champion Japanese National Team in 2006 and for the Chinese National Team in 2013. Koyanagi is a graduate of Fresno State University where he earned a bachelor's of science in kinesiology. He was born and raised in Fukuoka, Japan, but moved to the US in 1993 and is currently residing in Surprise, Ariz., with his wife, Misato, and two daughters, Maria and Monami.



Strength & Conditioning Specialist - Taylor Portman (1st Season)

Taylor Portman joins the Chukars & the Royals organization from the Olympic Training Center in Lake Placid, NY. Originally from North Carolina, Portman has also worked as a strength & conditioning assistant at UNC Chapel Hill & North Carolina State. Portman graduated from Appalachian State University with a degree in Kinesiology & Exercise Science along with a master's degree in Sport Science from East Tennessee State University.


