**Yesterday's Game**

- On Sunday, the Blue Jays fell in their series finale against the St. Lucie Mets 5-3 at home at Dunedin Stadium. Dunedin's high-powered offense was out-hit 12-6 and RHP Yennsy Diaz ran up a high pitch count early (91 pitches, 4.1 IP, 7 H, 2 ER, 3 BB, 1 K).
- Dunedin fell behind 2-0 in the first, but answered with two runs of their own in the second. A hit by pitch coupled with singles by Rodrigo Orozco and Nash Knight and a pair of passed balls allowed Dunedin to tie the game at 2-2. Dunedin held St. Lucie from scoring again until the sixth, but a single, a fielding error, and a double by Gene Cone allowed two unearned runs to score and the Mets to take the lead back. The two teams traded runs in the seventh, leading to the 5-3 final.
- Orozco was the only Blue Jay with multiple hits. Josh Palacios knocked a double, his team-leading 25th of the season, for Dunedin's only XBH in the game. RHP William Ouellette allowed two unearned runs in 1.2 IP of relief. RHP Claudio Custodio allowed one run in 2.0 IP. RHP Bryan Baker struck out the side in the ninth in his second Dunedin appearance.

**Around the Farm**

- Buffalo defeated Gwinnett 4-2. Jonathan Davis hit his third AAA HR. Reese McGuire was 3-4 with a 2B, an RBI, and a R. RHP Mike Hauschild tossed 5.2 IP, allowing 2 runs on 5 hits.
- New Hampshire fell to Portland 4-3. Bo Bichette was 3-5 with 2 RBIs. Jon Berti was 2-4 with 2 SBs. RHP Aaron Sanchez allowed 3 earned (4 runs) over 4.1 IP on 6 hits and 4 BBs while striking out 4 in a rehab assignment. Recently acquired RHP Hector Perez tossed 3.0 scoreless, striking out 3.
- Lansing beat Fort Wayne 5-4. Chavez Young (8) and Samad Taylor (8) each went deep off top prospect McKenzie Gore. RHP Maximo Castillo allowed 4 runs in 5.0 IP while striking out 7, picking up his 10th win of the season.
- Vancouver fell 10-2 to Tri-City. Brandon Polizzi and Sterig Guzman each had two hits. Elio Silva took the loss despite only allowing 1 earned over 5.0 IP on 3 hits.
- Bluefield fell to Princeton 8-7. Luis De Los Santos hit a three-run shot (6). DJ Daniels worked 3 walks, stole 2 bases, and scored 3 R.

**BLUE JAYS vs. THRESHERS**

**2017: 9-6**

- The Blue Jays and Threshers will play 22 times during the 2018 season.
- In their 19 matchups prior to this series, the Blue Jays have hit .255 as a team and scored 81 runs (4.3 per game) against Clearwater this season. Ivan Castillo has hit .333 (17-51) against the Threshers in 2018.
- The Blue Jays staff holds a 3.32 ERA against the Threshers entering this series. In four appearances, The projected rotation for this series (Eller/Buffo/Murphy) has combined to throw 43.0 innings against Clearwater this season and have allowed just 10 runs, good for a 2.09 ERA.

**Late-Season Slump**

- After beginning the month of August on an 8-game winning streak, Dunedin has lost 12 of 14 games to tumble from first place to third in the North. Entering this three-game series against division-leading Clearwater, the Jays are 7 games from elimination with 13 to play.
- During the past 14 games, Blue Jays starting pitchers have a 6.24 ERA and the offense has hit .251. The bullpen has a strong 3.47 ERA, but relievers have taken seven losses during the stretch.

**Tice Posting Ty-ny ERA**

- Over his last 10 outings, RHP Ty Tice has allowed just 4 earned runs in 20.0 IP, good for a 1.80 ERA. Each of his last 10 appearances have been for longer than 1.0 innings.

**Logue On Strikeout Binge**

- Over his last six outings, LHP Zach Logue has averaged 13.1 K/9. Over those six appearances, Logue has thrown 24.2 innings and struck out 36 batters, including a career high 10 on August 13 against Jupiter.

**Batting Title Chase**

- With 13 games left to play in the 2018 season, IF Ivan Castillo sits two points out of the FSL's Batting Title chase. Hitting .299 this year, Castillo sits fifth in the league in average, behind Jose Pujols and Jesus Sanchez at .301 and Adam Hasely and Taylor Grzelakowski at .300.
- OF Rodrigo Orozco sits directly behind Castillo in the standings at .298.

**Hit King**

- OF Josh Palacios leads the Florida State League with 131 hits this season. Palacios needs 16 more hits this season to move into the Top 10 for hits in a single-season in Dunedin history.

**Murphy's Quality Streak**

- Since June 1, RHP Patrick Murphy is 7-1 with a 1.94 ERA and leads the FSL with 86 Ks in 88.1 IP.
- Murphy leads the Florida State League with 125 strikeouts this season. The last Dunedin pitcher to lead the league in K's was Taylor Cole in 2014 (171).
- Murphy needs 7 strikeouts to move into the Top 10 in Dunedin history for strikeouts in a season.

**Injury Notes**

- RHP Nate Pearson threw off a mound yesterday for the first time since suffering a non-displaced fracture in his right forearm in May.
- LHP Kelyn Jose was transferred to the GCL on a rehab assignment. The hard-throwing lefty has not pitched yet in 2018.

**August All-Star**

- CF Josh Palacios has hits in 17 of his last 19 games, hitting .354 (29-82) with 21 RBI and 15 runs over that stretch (July 29-present).
- Palacios holds a .351 batting average so far in the month of August. He's reached base at a .422 clip and slugged .568 this month.

**Hit Parade**

- The Blue Jays lead the Florida State League in batting average (.275) and runs scored (99) in the month of August.

**Caught Red-Handed**

- Dunedin catchers have caught 43% of attempted base stealers in 2018, the best percentage in the league. Riley Adams leads all qualified catchers with a 47% CS rate. Alberto Mineo has caught 35% of attempted base steals, which would be good for second in the league if he had enough games played to qualify for the defensive leaderboard.

**Smith Joins 20/20 Club**

- With a three-run shot on August 1st, Kevin Smith became just the third player in the minors to have joined the 20/20 club in 2018 (Casey Golden, Rockies, Corey Ray, Brewers). Smith became the first Blue Jays prospect since Chad Mottola in 2000 to hit 20 home runs and steal 20 bases in a season and just the seventh Toronto prospect to do so in the last 30 seasons.
- With 28 steals this season, Smith could soon become just the third Toronto prospect in three decades to have a 20-30 season (Chad Mottola, 2000, 33-30, Rick Holifield, 1993, 20-30).

**Keeping It Close**

- The Blue Jays have played in 51 one-run games this season, second most in the FSL. Over half of Dunedin's games this season (71 of 125) have been decided by two runs or less.

Acquired from Colorado as the final piece in the Seunghwan Oh trade on August 14. Originally an 11th round pick by the Rockies in the 2016 draft from North Florida.  
Prior to the trade, was 4-2 with a 3.80 ERA in 43 games with A+ Lancaster. In 45.0 IP with the JetHawks, struck out 58 batters.  
Attended Choctawhatchee High School in Fort Walton Beach, FL before attending UNF in Jacksonville where he was a 3-time Atlantic Sun Conference Academic Honor Roll athlete and 2-time All-Conference pitcher.

Jonny CHESHIRE, RHP, #18

Sidearmer was a 36th round pick from Davenport University (NAIA, MI) where he had walked on before setting school records for strikeouts (224), saves (34), appearances (126) and opposing batting average (.224) while going 18-8 with a 2.44 ERA.  
Split the 2017 season between the GCL and R-Bluefield, posting a 1.48 ERA in 24.1 IP while striking out 31 batters.  
Made 13 appearances in the first half, throwing 21.1 innings, going 4-0 with a 2.95 ERA.

Claudio CUSTODIO, RHP, #16

Formerly the NY Yankees #14 overall prospect as a middle infielder, hit .244 in 6 seasons as a position player before converting to the mound in 2015.  
Posted a 2.66 ERA in 13 games with A-Lansing before joining Dunedin in 2018. Has made 5 appearances for AAA-Buffalo, allowing 5 runs in 10.0 IP (4.50 ERA) while striking out 8.

Jake FISHMAN, LHP, #26

Put up a 2.45 ERA in the first half, allowing just one earned run from May 1<sup>st</sup> through the end of the half. Made 21 total appearances and threw 29.1 IP.


