- The Blue Jays stayed alive in the North Division with a 4-1 win over Clearwater. Rodrigo Orozco continued his torrid second half with a 2-5 night that included a HR and 3 RBI. RHP Patrick Murphy remained untouchable in the second half with 5.0 shutout innings, striking out 5 while allowing just 3 hits.
- Orozco got Dunedin on the board first with a two-run shot in the third. The score remained 2-0 until the eighth when Riley knocked an RBI single. Clearwater scored their only run in the bottom of the eighth, but Dunedin added an insurance run in the ninth on an RBI single by Orozco.
- RHP William Ouellette followed Murphy with 2.0 hitless innings of relief. RHP Claudio Custodio allowed an eighth inning run, but picked up the save with 2.0 innings of relief to finish the game.

Logue On Strikeout Binge

- Over his last six outings, LHP Zach Logue has averaged 13.1 K/9. Over those six appearances, Logue has thrown 24.2 innings and struck out 36 batters, including a career high 10 on August 13 against Jupiter.

Batting Title Chase

- With 2 hits Thursday, OF Rodrigo Orozco improved his average to .305, second best in the FSL in 2018 behind Fort Myers' Taylor Grzelakoski (.308).
- Orozco is hitting .405 over his last 10 games, .342 in the month of August (he hit .338 in July), and .344 in the second half. He has hits in 17 of his last 19 games.

Hit King

- OF Josh Palacios leads the Florida State League with 137 hits this season. Palacios needs 10 more hits this season to move into the Top 10 for hits in a single-season in Dunedin history.
- Palacios also leads the league in RBI (71) despite batting leadoff in 104 games this season. In addition, he leads the FSL in total bases (193), games (118) and at-bats (477).

Murphy's Quality Streak

- Since June 1, RHP Patrick Murphy is 8-1 with a 1.83 ERA, best in the FSL, and he leads the FSL with 91 Ks in 93.1 IP.
- Murphy leads the Florida State League with 130 strikeouts this season. The last Dunedin pitcher to lead the league in K's was Taylor Cole in 2014 (171).
- Murphy needs just 2 strikeouts to move into the Top 10 in Dunedin history for strikeouts in a season.

August All-Star

- CF Josh Palacios has hits in 20 of his last 22 games, hitting .361 (35-97) with 22 RBI and 15 runs over that stretch (July 29-present).
- Palacios holds a .360 batting average so far in the month of August. He's reached base at a .418 clip and slugged .562 this month, leading the league in hits (32) and RBI (22).

Jays Lead Minors in Food Drive Donations

- Minor League Baseball and BUSH's Beans announced on Tuesday that the Blue Jays were the top contributing team in the 2018 "Team Up Against Hunger" July food drive initiative. Dunedin fans donated 1,126 pounds of non-perishable food items at the team's July 3 Hometown USA celebration. MiLB Charities/BUSH's will match the donation, which will go to the Dunedin Cares, Inc. Food Pantry.

Tice Posting Ty-ny ERA

- In 12 outings since July 15, RHP Ty Tice has allowed just 4 earned runs in 24.0 IP, good for a 1.50 ERA. Each of his last 12 appearances have been for longer than 1.0 innings.

Stellar Eller

- RHP Connor Eller was pushed into spot-start duty thanks to a string of injuries and call-ups earlier this season and has shined. In 10 starts, the righty has a 2.88 ERA and .242 average against in 40.2 IP, as a reliever this season, Eller has a 3.94 ERA and .319 average against in 32.0 IP.

Hit Parade

- The Blue Jays lead the Florida State League in batting average (.278) and are second in runs scored (112) in the month of August.

Caught Red-Handed

- Dunedin catchers have caught 43% of attempted base stealers in 2018, the best percentage in the league. Riley Adams leads all qualified catchers with a 48% CS rate.

Smith Joins 20/20 Club

- With a three-run shot on August 1st, Kevin Smith became just the third player in the minors to have joined the 20/20 club in 2018 (Casey Golden, Rockies, Corey Ray, Brewers). Smith became the first Blue Jays prospect since Chad Mottola in 2000 to hit 20 home runs and steal 20 bases in a season and just the seventh Toronto prospect to do so in the last 30 seasons.
- With 29 steals this season, Smith could soon become just the third Toronto prospect in three decades to have a 20-30 season (Chad Mottola, 2000, 33-30, Rick Holifield, 1993, 20-30).

Keeping It Close

- The Blue Jays have played in 52 one-run games this season, second most in the FSL. Over half of Dunedin's games this season (72 of 128) have been decided by two runs or less.

- Acquired from Colorado as the final piece in the Seunghwan Oh trade on August 14. Originally an 11th round pick by the Rockies in the 2016 draft from North Florida.
- Prior to the trade, was 4-2 with a 3.80 ERA in 43 games with A+ Lancaster. In 45.0 IP with the JetHawks, struck out 58 batters.
- Attended Choctawhatchee High School in Fort Walton Beach, FL before attending UNF in Jacksonville where he was a 3-time Atlantic Sun Conference Academic Honor Roll athlete and 2-time All-Conference pitcher.

Jonny CHESHIRE, RHP, #18

- Sidearmer was a 36th round pick from Davenport University (NAIA, MI) where he had walked on before setting school records for strikeouts (224), saves (34), appearances (126) and opposing batting average (.224) while going 18-8 with a 2.44 ERA.
- Split the 2017 season between the GCL and R-Bluefield, posting a 1.48 ERA in 24.1 IP while striking out 31 batters.
- Made 13 appearances in the first half, throwing 21.1 innings, going 4-0 with a 2.95 ERA.

Claudio CUSTODIO, RHP, #16

- Signed by the Blue Jays as a free agent in April 2018. Previously had been pitching in the unpaid Intercounty Baseball League in Ontario where he was discovered by a Blue Jays intern working as a broadcaster in the league.
- Formerly the NY Yankees #14 overall prospect as a middle infielder, hit .244 in 6 seasons as a position player before converting to the mound in 2015.
- Posted a 2.66 ERA in 13 games with A-Lansing before joining Dunedin in 2018. Has made 5 appearances for AAA-Buffalo, allowing 5 runs in 10.0 IP (4.50 ERA) while striking out 8.

Jake FISHMAN, LHP, #26

2018: 2-2, 8 SV, 41 G, 53.0 IP, 46 H, 17 ER, 11 BB, 53 K, 2.89 ERA, 1.08 WHIP

- 30th round selection in the 2016 draft out of Union College (NY) made his full-season debut in 2017, combining to post a 1.79 ERA between the GCL, A-Vancouver, and A-Lansing.
- In a statistical oddity, struck out 7 batters over 2.0 innings with Lansing on 8/26/17 thanks to a dropped third strike, King 4 in the 8th inning and 3 more in the 9th.
- Put up a 2.45 ERA in the first half, allowing just one earned run from May 1st through the end of the half. Made 21 total appearances and threw 29.1 IP.

Nick HARTMAN, RHP, #19

2018: 1-1, 2 SV, 17 G, 26.2 IP, 36 H, 16 ER, 9 BB, 34 K, 5.40 ERA, 1.69 WHIP

Versus Left: .298 AVG Versus Right: .349 AVG

- 9th round pick in 2016 from Old Dominion where he was named as the 2nd best pitching prospect in Conference USA by Baseball Draft Report.
- Made 4 appearances for Dunedin in 2017, throwing 7.1 innings and not allowing a hit, picking up his 1st FSL win on 8/29 vs. the Fire Frogs with 2.2 shutout innings of relief.
- In 18 appearances for AA-New Hampshire in 2018, posted a 5.40 ERA over 28.1 IP.

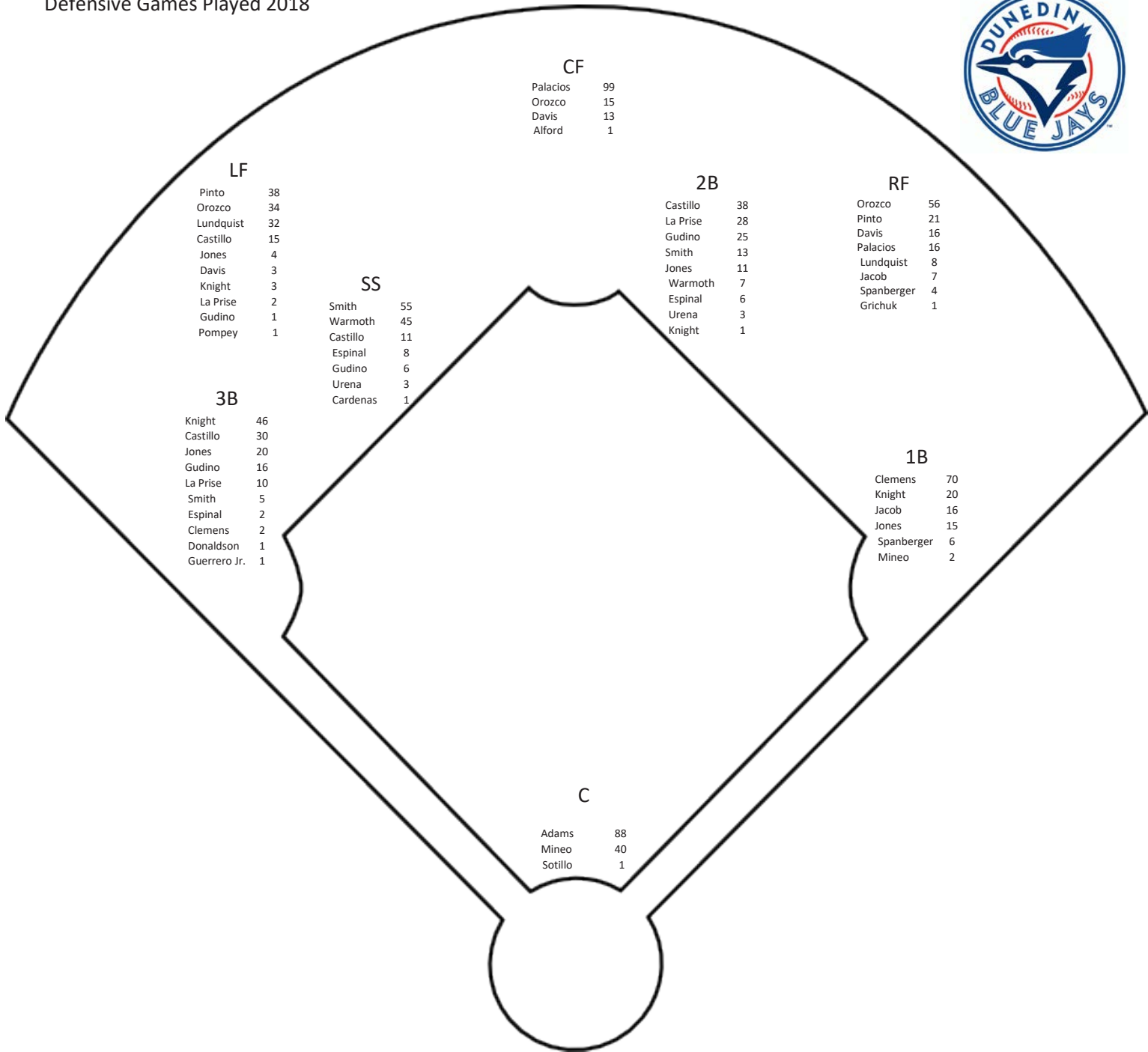
