- The Blue Jays split a doubleheader in Bradenton. In G1, Dunedin scored 7 runs in the final inning for an improbable 8-6 comeback win. In G2, Dunedin scored 5 times in the final inning, but it wasn't enough in an 11-6 loss.
- Josh Palacios (3-5, 2B, RBI, R), Yeltsin Gudino (3-3), and Riley Adams (3-3, 2B, 2 R) each had 3 hits in G1. LHP Zach Logue allowed 2 earned over 3.2 IP on 9 hits. Trailing 6-1 in the 7th, the Blue Jays brought 11 men to the plate, knocking six hits and working 3 walks to score 7 times.
- Palacios (2-4, R), Kevin Smith (2-4, HR, 3 RBI), and Ivan Castillo (2-3, 2 HR, 2 RBI, 2 R) each had two hits in G2. RHP Connor Eller allowed 7 earned in 2.2 IP and RHP William Ouellette allowed 4 more in 1.0 IP to put Dunedin behind big early.

 - The Blue Jays and Cardinals will play 8 times in 2018.
 - Dunedin and Palm Beach shared the 2017 Florida State League Championship.
 - In their 4 previous matchups, the Blue Jays have hit .231 against Palm Beach. Nash Knight and Rodrigo Orozco each hold a .333 average entering this series.
 - The Blue Jays staff has a 4.25 ERA against Palm Beach entering this series.

Batting Title Chase

- Rodrigo Orozco is in a four-way tie for the Florida State League Batting Title with a .301 average. He's tied with Jose Pujols (CLR), Taylor Grzelakowski (FTM), and Jesus Sanchez (CHA). Ivan Castillo is sixth at .293 while Josh Palacios is seventh at .292.
- Orozco is hitting .395 over his last 10 games, .321 in the month of August (he hit .338 in July), and .335 in the second half. He has hits in 18 of his last 21 games.

Hit Parade

- The Blue Jays lead the Florida State League in batting average (.284) and runs scored (126) in the month of August.

Hit King

- OF Josh Palacios leads the Florida State League with 142 hits this season. Palacios needs 5 more hits this season to move into the Top 10 for hits in a single-season in Dunedin history.
- Palacios also leads the league in RBI (72) despite batting leadoff in 106 games this season. In addition, he leads the FSL in total bases (199), games (120) and at-bats (486).

Murphy's Quality Streak

- Since June 1, RHP Patrick Murphy is 8-1 with a 1.83 ERA, best in the FSL, and he leads the FSL with 91 Ks in 93.1 IP.
- Murphy leads the Florida State League with 130 strikeouts this season. The last Dunedin pitcher to lead the league in K's was Taylor Cole in 2014 (171).
- Murphy needs just 2 strikeouts to move into the Top 10 in Dunedin history for strikeouts in a season.

August All-Stars

- CF Josh Palacios has hits in 22 of his last 24 games, hitting .377 (40-106) with 23 RBI and 17 runs over that stretch (July 29-present). Palacios holds a .378 batting average so far in the month of August. He's reached base at a .430 clip and slugged .571 this month, leading the league in hits (37).
- Riley Adams has hit .356 in 17 August games, raising his second half average to .270 (he hit .227 in the first half).

Jays Lead Minors in Food Drive Donations

- Minor League Baseball and BUSH's Beans announced on Tuesday that the Blue Jays were the top contributing team in the 2018 "Team Up Against Hunger" July food drive initiative. Dunedin fans donated 1,126 pounds of non-perishable food items at the team's July 3 Hometown USA celebration. MiLB Charities/BUSH's will match the donation, which will go to the Dunedin Cares, Inc. Food Pantry.

Tice Posting Ty-nv ERA

- In 12 outings since July 15, RHP Ty Tice has allowed just 4 earned runs in 24.0 IP, good for a 1.50 ERA. Each of his last 12 appearances have been for longer than 1.0 innings.

Caught Red-Handed

- Dunedin catchers have caught 42% of attempted base stealers in 2018, the best percentage in the league. Riley Adams leads all qualified catchers with a 46% CS rate.

Smith Joins 20/20 Club

- With a three-run shot on August 1st, Kevin Smith became just the third player in the minors to have joined the 20/20 club in 2018 (Casey Golden, Rockies, Corey Ray, Brewers). Smith became the first Blue Jays prospect since Chad Mottola in 2000 to hit 20 home runs and steal 20 bases in a season and just the seventh Toronto prospect to do so in the last 30 seasons.
- With 29 steals this season, Smith could soon become just the third Toronto prospect in three decades to have a 20-30 season (Chad Mottola, 2000, 33-30, Rick Hoffield, 1993, 20-30).

Keeping It Close

- The Blue Jays have played in 52 one-run games this season, second most in the FSL. Over half of Dunedin's games this season (72 of 130) have been decided by two runs or less.

Double Duty

- 3B Nash Knight made his third relief outing for Dunedin against Bradenton on Sunday, throwing a shutout inning. Knight has thrown 2.1 innings for the Jays this season, allowing no runs on three hits. He also made one relief appearance for AA-New Hampshire.

Mineo Making The Most Of AAA Opportunity

- Promoted to AAA-Buffalo on August 23, C Alberto Mineo has at least one hit in every game he's played with the Bisons, hitting .400 (4-10) in 3 games.

Castillo Homers Twice

- Ivan Castillo went deep in the 5th and 7th innings of game 2 of yesterday's double header against Bradenton. It was Castillo's first multi-homer game since August 10, 2014 when he homered twice while playing for the Lake County Captains. Castillo becomes the first D-Jay to have a multi-HR game this season.

- ★ Rated as the #30 prospect in the Blue Jays system entering the season by Baseball America.
- ★ Arsenal features a fastball that can reach the mid-90s and a developing curve and changeup. Despite being a fly ball pitcher (44% in 2018) has only allowed 0.7 HR/9 this season.
- ★ Held opponent hitters to a miniscule .135 average at A-Lansing in 2018 prior to his promotion.
- ★ In an impressive opener to the season, struck out 10 over 5.2 shutout innings while allowing just one hit on April 5th at Great Lakes.

- Acquired from Colorado as the final piece in the Seungwhan Oh trade on August 14. Originally an 11th round pick by the Rockies in the 2016 draft from North Florida.
- Prior to the trade, was 4-2 with a 3.80 ERA in 43 games with A+ Lancaster. In 45.0 IP with the JetHawks, struck out 58 batters.
- Attended Choctawhatchee High School in Fort Walton Beach, FL before attending UNF in Jacksonville where he was a 3-time Atlantic Sun Conference Academic Honor Roll athlete and 2-time All-Conference pitcher.

Jonny CHESHIRE, RHP, #18

- Sidearm was a 36th round pick from Davenport University (NAIA, MI) where he had walked on before setting school records for strikeouts (224), saves (34), appearances (126) and opposing batting average (.224) while going 18-8 with a 2.44 ERA.
- Split the 2017 season between the GCL and R-Bluefield, posting a 1.48 ERA in 24.1 IP while striking out 31 batters.
- Made 13 appearances in the first half, throwing 21.1 innings, going 4-0 with a 2.95 ERA.

Claudio CUSTODIO, RHP, #16

- Signed by the Blue Jays as a free agent in April 2018. Previously had been pitching in the unpaid Intercounty Baseball League in Ontario where he was discovered by a Blue Jays intern working as a broadcaster in the league.
- Formerly the NY Yankees #14 overall prospect as a middle infielder, hit .244 in 6 seasons as a position player before converting to the mound in 2015.
- Posted a 2.66 ERA in 13 games with A-Lansing before joining Dunedin in 2018. Has made 5 appearances for AAA-Buffalo, allowing 5 runs in 10.0 IP (4.50 ERA) while striking out 8.

Jake FISHMAN, LHP, #26

- 30th round selection in the 2016 draft out of Union College (NY) made his full-season debut in 2017, combining to post a 1.79 ERA between the GCL, A-Vancouver, and A-Lansing.
- In a statistical oddity, struck out 7 batters over 2.0 innings with Lansing on 8/26/17 thanks to a dropped third strike, K'ing 4 in the 8th inning and 3 more in the 9th.
- Put up a 2.45 ERA in the first half, allowing just one earned run from May 1st through the end of the half. Made 21 total appearances and threw 29.1 IP.

- 9th round pick in 2016 from Old Dominion where he was named as the 2nd best pitching prospect in Conference USA by Baseball Draft Report.
- Made 4 appearances for Dunedin in 2017, throwing 7.1 innings and not allowing a hit, picking up his 1st FSL win on 8/29 vs. the Fire Frogs with 2.2 shutout innings of relief.
- In 18 appearances for AA-New Hampshire in 2018, posted a 5.40 ERA over 28.1 IP.

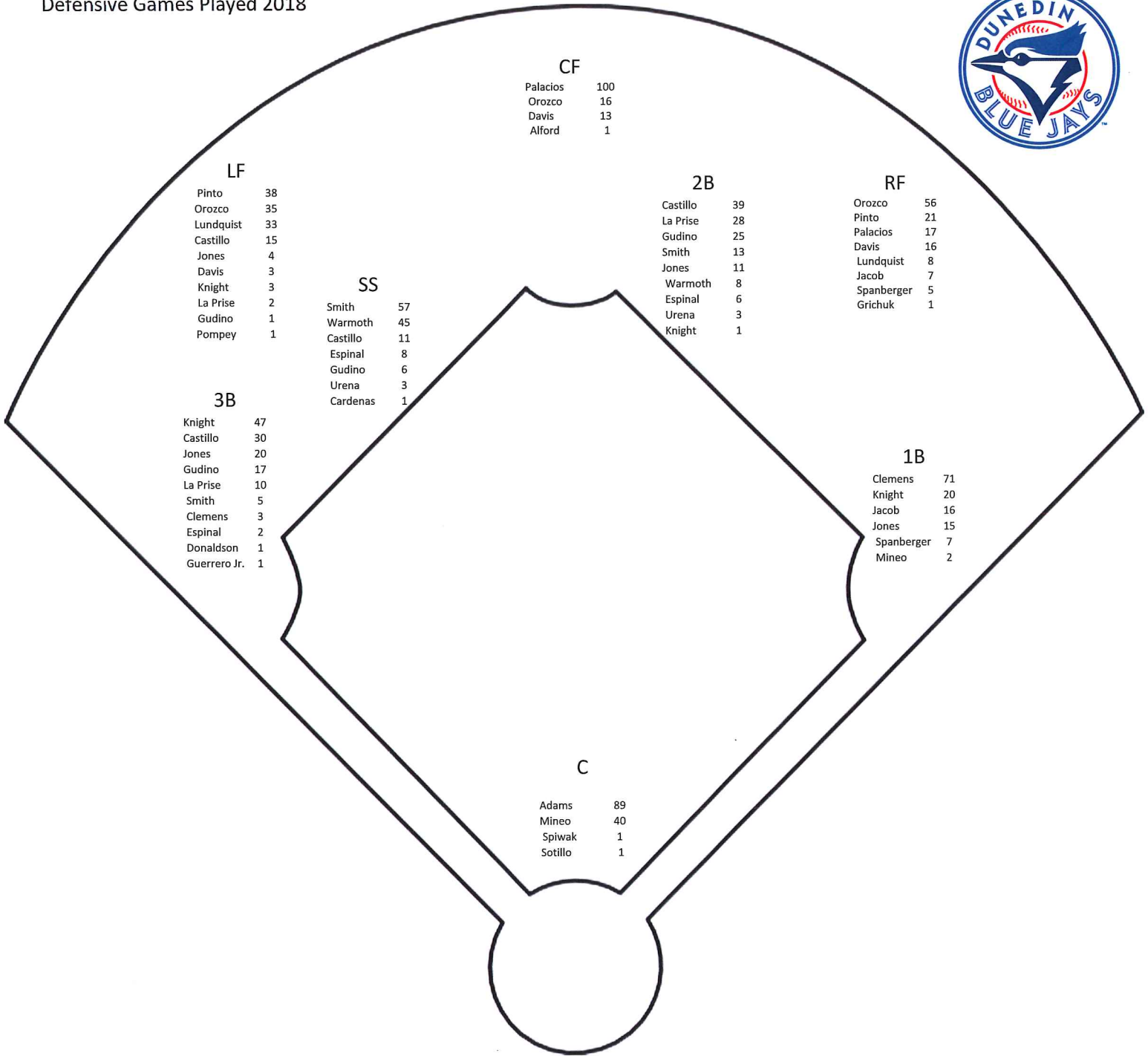
