- Josh Palacios (3-5, 2B, RBI, R), Yeltsin Gudino (3-3), and Riley Adams (3-3, 2B, 2R) each had 3 hits in G1. LHP Zach Logue allowed 2 earned over 3.2 IP on 9 hits. Trailing 6-1 in the 7th, the Blue Jays brought 11 men to the plate, knocking six hits and working 3 walks to score 7 times.

- In their 4 previous matchups, the Blue Jays have hit .231 against Palm Beach. Nash Knight and Rodrigo Orozco each hold a .333 average entering this series
- The Blue jays staff has a 4.25 ERA against Palm Beach entering this series.

Batting Title Chase

- Rodrigo Oroxoo is in a four-way tie for the Florida State League Batting Title with a .301 average. He's tied with Jose Pujols (CLR), Taylor Grzelakowski (FTM), and Jesus Sanchez (CHA). Ivan Castillo is sixth at .293 while Josh Palacios is seventh at .292.
- Orozco is hitting .395 over his last 10 games, .321 in the month of August (he hit .338 in July), and .335 in the second half. He has hits in 18 of his last 21 games

The Blue Jays lead the Florida State League in batting average (.284) and runs scored (126) in the month of August.

Hit King

- OF Josh Palacios leads the Florida State League with 142 hits this season. Palacios needs 5 more hits this season to move into the Top 10 for hits in a single-season in Dunedin history.
- Palacios also leads the league in RBI (72) despite batting leadoff in 106 games this season. In addition, he leads the FSL in total bases (199), games (120) and at-bats (486).

- Since June 1, RHP Patrick Murphy is 8-1 with a 1.83 ERA, best in the FSL, and he leads the FSL with 91 Ks in
- Murphy leads the Florida State League with 130 strikeouts this season. The last Dunedin pitcher to lead the in K's was Taylor Cole in 2014 (171)
- Murphy needs just 2 strikeouts to move into the Top 10 in Dunedin history for strikeouts in a season.

- CF Josh Palacios has hits in 22 of his last 24 games, hitting .377 (40-106) with 23 RBI and 17 runs over that stretch (July 29-present). Palacios holds a .378 batting average so far in the month of August. He's reached base at a .430 clip and slugged .571 this month, leading the league in hits (37).
- Riley Adams has hit .356 in 17 August games, raising his second half average to .270 (he hit .227 in the first

Jays Lead Minors In Food Drive Donations

Minor League Baseball and BUSH's Beans announced on Tuesday that the Blue Jays were the top contributing team in the 2018 "Team Up Against Hunger" July food drive initiative. Dunedin fans donated 1,126 pounds of non-perishable food items at the team's July 3 Hometown USA celebration. MiLB Charities/BUSH's will match the donation, which will go to the Dunedin Cares, Inc. Food Pantry.

Tice Posting Ty-ny ERA

In 12 outings since July 15, RHP Ty Tice has allowed just 4 earned runs in 24.0 IP, good for a 1.50 ERA. Each of his last 12 appearances have been for longer than 1.0 innings.

Dunedin catchers have caught 42% of attempted base stealers in 2018, the best percentage in the league. Riley Adams leads all qualified catchers with a 46% CS rate.

Smith Joins 20/20 Club

- With a three-run shot on August 1st, Kevin Smith became just the third player in the minors to have joined the 20/20 club in 2018 (Casey Golden, Rockies, Corey Ray, Brewens). Smith became the first Blue Jays prosper since Chad Mottola in 2000 to hit 20 home runs and steal 20 bases in a season and just the seventh Toronto prospect to do so in the last 30 seasons.
- With 29 steals this season, Smith could soon become just the third Toronto prospect in three decades to have a 20-30 season (Chad Mottola, 2000, 33-30, Rick Hollfield, 1993, 20-30).

The Blue Jays have played in 52 one-run games this season, second most in the FSL. Over half of Dunedin's games this season (72 of 130) have been decided by two runs or less.

Promoted to AAA-Buffalo on August 23, C Alberto Mineo has at least one hit in every game he's played with the Bisons, hitting .400 (4-10) in 3 games.

Ivan Castillo went deep in the 5th and 7th innings of game 2 of yesterday's double header against Bradenton. It was Castillo's first multi-homer game since August 10, 2014 when he homered twice while playing for the Lake County Captains. Castillo becomes the first D-Jay to have a multi-HR game this season.


