Tonight: The Nuts open up a four-game road series in Kentucky against the Bowling Green Hot Rods, sending right-hander **Fitz Stadler** (followed by piggybacking tandem-mate **Cobi Johnson**) against Bowling Green right-hander **Caleb Sampen**. This is the first meeting of 17 between the Lugnuts and Hot Rods this year. Lansing is coming off a 3-3 home-stand, winning two of three against Dayton before dropping two of three against South Bend. The Hot Rods, meanwhile, have won five of their last seven games and just completed a 4-2 road trip, winning two of three games at both Great Lakes and Fort Wayne.

Yesterday: South Bend 10, Lansing 8. **Jordan Groshans** and **Alejandro Kirk** blasted two-run homers and **Reggie Pruitt** reached base five times on a single, double and three walks, but a six-run Cubs fifth proved the difference in the rubber match of a three-game series. The Cubs' **Delvin Zinn** went 5-for-5 with two singles, two doubles and a triple.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play through Sunday at Bowling Green Ballpark before enjoying an off day Monday. Interdivision play begins Tuesday at Cooley Law School Stadium, with the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers and Beloit Snappers coming to town for three-game series. May 3rd-5th sees the Lugnuts become the **Lansing Locos** for *Copa de la Diversión*.

First Rate: The Lugnuts' offense leads the Midwest League in batting average (.280), hits (185), total bases (283), on-base percentage (.369), slugging percentage (.428) and OPS (.797), and is tied for 1st in the league in home runs (17).

Individual Efforts: 19-year-old SS **Jordan Groshans**, the Blue Jays' 2018 1st-rounder (12th overall) and the youngest player on the Lugnuts, leads the MWL in batting average (.387), ranks 2nd in on-base percentage (.465), 3rd in hits (24), 5th in OPS (1.045) and tied for 5th in total bases (36). C **Alejandro Kirk** is 1st in OBP (.467), 3rd in OPS (1.067), tied for 3rd in walks (14), 4th in slugging percentage (.600) and tied for 5th in total bases (36). CF **Reggie Pruitt** is 1st in the league in base hits (27), tied for 2nd in runs scored (17), tied for 4th in stolen bases (6) and tied for 5th in total bases (36).

Night to Remember: On April 18th vs. Dayton, C/1B **Ryan Gold** hit for the 7th cycle in Lugnuts franchise history, going 4-for-5 with a double, triple, grand slam and seven RBIs in a 12-4 victory.

Big Picture: Tallest player in the Blue Jays organization as well as the tallest in Lugnuts history... one of two Illinois natives on the Lugnuts, along with fellow pitcher Connor Law... favorite player as a kid was Ken Griffey, Jr. ... enjoys watching Game of Thrones, Entourage and Peaky Blinders... roots for the Chicago Bears and Chicago Blackhawks... enjoys golfing... @FitzStadler_4.

Generation...: Fitz's grandfather, Bob Sullivan, played basketball at the University of Michigan... his father Matt was a three-time Big Ten champion and an All-American swimmer at Indiana, coached by the legendary Doc Counsilman... Counsilman coached swimming at Indiana from 1957-1990, taking the Hoosiers to 20 straight Big Ten wins, six straight national championships, and then coached Team USA men's swimming in 1964 and 1976, where Indiana's own Mark Spitz starred and Team USA won 12 of a possible 13 gold medals.

... to Generation: Fitz's older brothers Walker (a 6-foot-4 pitcher) and Sully (short for Sullivan, a 6-foot-4 outfielder/pitcher) each played baseball for the Indiana Hoosiers, with Sully playing from 2013-2017 before transferring to Xavier for his redshirt-senior year... Walker and Sully were teammates on the Hoosiers in 2013, with Kyle Schwarber on that same IU team... his mother and his older sister, both named Challen, also attended Indiana.

Glory Days: Attended Glenview South High School, just north of Chicago... captained football team in 2014 and 2015... captained baseball team in 2015... as a junior, went 9-0, 0.69, with 49 strikeouts in 39 2/3 innings... went 8-3, 1.22, 102 strikeouts in 60 1/3 innings as a senior... named Perfect Game All-American Honorable Mention, Perfect Game All-Midwest Region First Team, All-State Illinois, All-Area First Team - Chicago Tribune, All-Area First Team - Chicago Sun Times, and was rated the No. 6 high school baseball player in Illinois... threw a five-inning no-hitter, 4/7/15, striking out 11... drafted by the Cubs in the 32nd round but declined to sign, calling the pick a "courtesy pick."

Dancing with the Devils: Committed to Arizona State after Indiana head baseball coach Tracy Smith joined the Sun Devils... as a freshman in 2016, made 12 appearances, 1 start: 0-1, 9.35, 17 1/3 innings, 15 walks, 10 strikeouts... pitched in New England Collegiate League that summer (2.82, 22 1/3 innings, 13 walks, 18 strikeouts)... sophomore season in 2017 was limited to 13 innings (4.85 ERA, 7 strikeouts) due to injury... pitched in Cape Cod League (3.72, 19 1/3 innings, 7 walks, 13 strikeouts)... struggled again in junior year in 2018 at Arizona State: 5.56, 22 2/3 IP, 18 walks, 18 strikeouts... notable Sun Devils to make the Majors: Barry Bonds, Reggie Jackson, Rick Monday, and, more recently, Jason Kipnis, Mike Leake, Kole Calhoun, Ike Davis.

Draft Day: Drafted by Blue Jays in the 18th round, scouted by Darold Brown, and signed for \$100,000... one of five Sun Devils to be drafted, led by Nationals fifth-rounder Gage Canning.

Pro Debut - 2018: Assigned to Adv. Rookie Bluefield, dominated out of the bullpen: first four appearances totaled 8 2/3 inn., 3 hits, 0 runs, 2 walks, 11 strikeouts... gave up only run in final appearance, 7/6 vs. Pulaski, but still struck out six in 2 2/3 innings... right-handed batters went 2-for-28 with 12 strikeouts... promoted to Northwest League and debuted for Vancouver, 7/11/18... did not allow an earned run in first seven appearances (9 2/3 inn.)... 12 of 16 appearances in NWL (and 17 of 22 overall in 2018) were scoreless.

Midwest League - 2019: Pitching for Lugnuts in No. 5 slot in rotation, piggybacking with RHP Cobi Johnson... made first appearance in 2019 with four scoreless innings of relief, 4/9 vs. West Michigan, facing one above the minimum and tossing three 1-2-3 innings in completing three-hit 1-0 shutout victory... game was completed in 1:54... made first professional start, 4/13 at South Bend: retired first four batters, but allowed a second-inning run on three straight singles before giving up five hits and four runs in the third inning... Lugnuts were shut out on five hits, 6-0.
