**Tonight:** The Lugnuts open a 10-day, nine-game road trip with the first of three tilts against the Captains. The two clubs have evenly split their 12 meetings this year -- because they've split three straight four-game series. This weekend, however, there can be only one winner. It's a matchup of right-handers this evening, as the Lugnuts' **Troy Watson** takes on the Captains' **Juan Mota**. The Nuts are coming off winning three of four games against the Great Lakes Loons.

Last Night: Lugnuts 5, Loons 4. RF Griffin Conine went 3-for-4 with a single, two doubles, two runs scored and three runs batted in, powering the Lugnuts' offense to victory. Great Lakes scored a run in the eighth and two in the ninth to make things tense before Cre Finfrock struck out Hunter Feduccia and Jacob Amaya to seal up his 10th save.

On Deck: The Nuts play the Captains tomorrow afternoon and Monday night before traveling during Tuesday's day off to the Western Division and playing three-game sets at Peoria and Cedar Rapids next week. The Lugnuts' next homestand will stretch from July 17th-22nd against the Burlington Bees and Clinton LumberKings, wrapping up interdivision play.

Playoff Push: The Eastern Division's two first-half playoff berths fell to Great Lakes (division champion) and Lake County (wild card), leaving the Lugnuts competing against West Michigan, South Bend, Fort Wayne, Dayton and Bowling Green for the final two playoff slots available. The Lugs made the playoffs last year in the first half but lost to eventual champion Bowling Green in the opening round (0-2). Lansing has won two Midwest League titles in franchise history, in 1997 and 2003, and has made the playoffs 14 times in 23 seasons.



Team Goals: The Lugnuts' offense leads the Midwest League in triples (38) and stolen bases (118), ranks 3rd in base hits (686), total bases (1061), slugging percentage (.384) and OPS (.714), and 5th in batting average (.249) and on-base percentage (.330).



Individual Efforts: CF Reggie Pruitt tops the league in both stolen bases (32) and triples (8) and is tied for 3rd in runs scored (51). C/1B Hagen Danner is tied for 4th in home runs (11). RHP Cre Finfrock is tied for 2nd in saves (10).



Bem Vinda, Senhor: RHP Eric Pardinho, the highest-paid free agent in the history of Brazilian baseball and No. 4 prospect in the Blue Jays' system, made his Lugnuts debut last Tuesday night, allowing two runs in four innings while striking out four. The 18-year-old, who received \$1.4 million to sign on July 2, 2017, is ranked the No. 99 prospect in baseball. He is slated to start every six games for the Lugnuts.



All-Star Game Recap: Five Nuts competed in the MWL All-Star Game in South Bend on June 18th, with the Eastern Division winning on a Home Run Derby tiebreaker, 4-3. Jake Brodt started at 18 and batted 5th (2-3, two singles, two runs); he also competed in the Home Run Derby Monday night and made it to the second round before falling to eventual champion Chris Betts (Bowling Green). Josh Winckowski started the game and pitched a perfect 1st inning, striking out one. Ryan Gold (0-2, K) and Nick Podkul (0-1, K) entered as reserves, and Cobi Johnson entered in the 7th and recorded two outs, one via strikeout, allowing one hit.

### By the Numbers:

- Wins for the Lugnuts in 38 games when trailing after eight innings this year, notched on Tuesday night in Great Lakes. The Nuts trailed 3-0 entering the 7th and 3-2 entering the 9th before **DJ Neal**'s two-run double down the first-base line gave the Nuts a stunning 4-3 victory.

**Big Picture:** One of 13 players on the Lugnuts' roster drafted in 2018... joins fellow Texans Sean Wymer, Joey Pulido and (injured) Jordan Groshans... one of 12 2018 Bluefield Blue Jays on the Lugnuts' roster... Twitter: @2 troywatson.

**Back Home:** Gunter is located in northern Texas, 37 miles to the northeast from the University of North Texas and about 35 miles from the Oklahoma border... it was founded in 1902, with a population of 1,498 in the 2010 census.

**Glory Days:** Watson attended Gunter High School (the "Tigers"), where he played basketball (averaging 18.6 ppg), football and baseball... as a senior, he was named all-state as an infielder, batting .300 with nine doubles, 21 RBIs and 10 stolen bases; on the mound, he was even more noticeable: 7-0, 0.25, 56 2/3 innings, 107 strikeouts.

**Bear Bound:** Troy signed a national letter of intent to the University of Northern Colorado (the "Bears," located in Greeley, CO) in November 2015... as a freshman: 16 games, 8 starts, 4.99 ERA, 52 1/3 innings, 39 strikeouts / 33 walks... his sophomore season was injury-riddled: 7 games, 5 starts, 2.91, 34 innings, 24 strikeouts / 9 walks.

**Draft Day:** When Watson was selected by the Blue Jays in the 15th round in 2018, signing for \$100,000, he became the first UNC Bear to be drafted since Jensen Park in 2015 (32nd round, Colorado) and only the ninth UNC player drafted in the 21st century... only one drafted Bear has made the Majors, Mike Trujillo, who pitched from 1985-1989 with the Red Sox, Mariners and Tigers... nine UNC Bears have made it to MLB in total, none of them household names, with Trujillo the most recent.

Fried Pickle: "It's a very exciting moment for me right now," Watson told KXII after getting drafted. "My dad and I have been working on this ever sense I could pick up a baseball. I remember telling him when I was younger, that I'm going to be on TV one day. I never thought I would actually get to this point. But I'm here, and ready to get to work.... [His advisor] called me while I was in the middle of eating a fried pickle, and he's like, 'you're being taken by the Blue Jays right now!' And I was like, 'wait, what?!' My dad was watching the draft board and he goes, 'TROY WATSON!' He teared up a little bit. It kind of made me tear up because I mean, we made it. It all just happened so fast but excited."

**Pro Debut:** Watson made his pro debut with the Bluefield Blue Jays in their second game of the year, 6/20/18, allowing a run in the sixth inning to Johnson City in a 2-0 loss... current Lugnuts who played for Bluefield that day: LF Hunter Steinmetz, RF D.J. Neal, 3B Johnny Aiello, SS Luis De Los Santos, DH Hagen Danner and fellow relievers Cre Finfrock and Fitz Stadler... his first pro start came next, 6/24 at Burlington, and it was better: three perfect innings with five strikeouts... he allowed two runs at most in one appearance (8/7 vs. Greeneville, a career high five innings), allowed one run in three other appearances, and pitched shutout ball in the five remaining outings... the league batted just .138 against him, including a .123 batting average (7-for-57) by right-handed batters.

Midwest League - 2019: Joined the Lugnuts from Extended Spring on May 20th, replacing the injured Juan De Paula in a piggybacking tandem with Josh Hiatt... earned first win, 5/30 at Dayton, allowing one hit and two unearned runs in five innings... 6/5 at Great Lakes, struck out five batters in four innings of relief, allowing two-run homer to Dillon Paulson... switched uniform number from 32 to 27 with the promotion of Jackson Rees to Dunedin on June 6th... in two starts in the second half: 1-0, 1.64, 11 IP, 2 R, 2 BB, 1 IBB, 7 K, .268... batters are hitting .258/.372/.470 with bases empty, compared to .311/.328/.475 with runners on base.
