Tonight... is the first day of the Lugnuts' eight-game road trip, with four-game series at Lake County and Bowling Green. These are the Nuts' final meetings of the season with the Lake County Captains; Lansing is 8-7 overall against the Captains this year, splitting three four-game series and winning two of three at Classic Park three weeks ago. The Nuts are coming off a three-game sweep at the hands of the South Bend Cubs at Cooley Law School Stadium, dropping them two games behind South Bend for the Eastern Division wild card.

Yesterday: Cubs 17, Lugnuts 8. South Bend scored 13 runs in the first four innings, including 11 against starter **Juan De Paula**, and added two two-run homers in the ninth inning, one by **Brennen Davis** and the other by **Cole Roederer**, to complete the sweep. **Clayton Daniel** and **Andy Weber** each went 5-for-6 to lead the Cubs, while **Jake Brodt** homered for the second straight day in the defeat.

On Deck: This series concludes Friday, with the Nuts proceeding to Bowling Green Ballpark from August 2-6. Then the Lugnuts return home August 7-9, hosting South Bend once more.

Bo to The Show: Last night, 2017 Lugnuts SS **Bo Bichette** made his Major League debut as the Toronto Blue Jays' starting shortstop, collecting a single in his first at-bat and finishing 1-for-4 in the Jays' 7-3 win at Kansas City. Bichette joined fellow former Lugnuts **Cavan Biggio**, **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.**, **Danny Jansen**, **Tim Mayza** and **Justin Shafer** in taking part in yesterday's victory, with former Lake County Captain **Thomas Pannone** serving as the starting pitcher for Toronto.

Team Goals: The Nuts' offense leads the Midwest League in total bases (1348), triples (44), stolen bases (141) and slugging percentage (.387), and ranks 2nd in base hits (869), 3rd in OPS (.716), 4th in home runs (75) and batting average (.249), and tied for 4th in doubles (166).

International Exposure: RHP **Will McAffer** has been placed on the Temporarily Inactive List while he competes on the Team Canada men's baseball team at the Pan-Am Games in Peru. Also on the team: Minnesota Twins top prospect pitcher **Jordan Balazovic** and former Lugnuts **Connor Panas** and **Michael Crouse**.

Playoff Picture: The Lugnuts didn't make the postseason in the first half, finishing fifth in the Eastern Division with a 32-37 record while Great Lakes and Lake County snagged the first two berths. That means that the Nuts have to finish among the top two teams in the East in the second half, excluding the Loons and Captains, in order to make their second straight postseason appearance.

One to Forget: In yesterday's slugfest defeat, the Lugnuts set season highs in most runs allowed (17) and most hits allowed (20). In addition, the entire series against the Cubs took nine hours and 57 minutes to play 27 innings (plus a 31-minute rain delay yesterday), with an average duration of 22 minutes per inning. Aaagh.

Big Picture: One of 13 players on the Lugnugs' roster drafted in 2018... joins fellow Texans Sean Wymer, Joey Pulido and (injured) Jordan Groshans... one of 12 2018 Bluefield Blue Jays on the Lugnugs' roster... Twitter: @2_troywatson.

Back Home: Gunter is located in northern Texas, 37 miles to the northeast from the University of North Texas and about 35 miles from the Oklahoma border... it was founded in 1902, with a population of 1,498 in the 2010 census.

Glory Days: Watson attended Gunter High School (the "Tigers"), where he played basketball (averaging 18.6 ppg), football and baseball... as a senior, he was named all-state as an infielder, batting .300 with nine doubles, 21 RBIs and 10 stolen bases; on the mound, he was even more noticeable: 7-0, 0.25, 56 2/3 innings, 107 strikeouts.

Bear Bound: Troy signed a national letter of intent to the University of Northern Colorado (the "Bears," located in Greeley, CO) in November 2015... as a freshman: 16 games, 8 starts, 4.99 ERA, 52 1/3 innings, 39 strikeouts / 33 walks... his sophomore season was injury-riddled: 7 games, 5 starts, 2.91, 34 innings, 24 strikeouts / 9 walks.

Draft Day: When Watson was selected by the Blue Jays in the 15th round in 2018, signing for \$100,000, he became the first UNC Bear to be drafted since Jensen Park in 2015 (32nd round, Colorado) and only the ninth UNC player drafted in the 21st century... only one drafted Bear has made the Majors, Mike Trujillo, who pitched from 1985-1989 with the Red Sox, Mariners and Tigers... nine UNC Bears have made it to MLB in total, none of them household names, with Trujillo the most recent.

Fried Pickle: "It's a very exciting moment for me right now," Watson told KXII after getting drafted. "My dad and I have been working on this ever sense I could pick up a baseball. I remember telling him when I was younger, that I'm going to be on TV one day. I never thought I would actually get to this point. But I'm here, and ready to get to work.... [His advisor] called me while I was in the middle of eating a fried pickle, and he's like, 'you're being taken by the Blue Jays right now!' And I was like, 'wait, what?!' My dad was watching the draft board and he goes, 'TROY WATSON!' He teared up a little bit. It kind of made me tear up because I mean, we made it. It all just happened so fast but excited."

Pro Debut: Watson made his pro debut with the Bluefield Blue Jays in their second game of the year, 6/20/18, allowing a run in the sixth inning to Johnson City in a 2-0 loss... current Lugnugs who played for Bluefield that day: LF Hunter Steinmetz, RF D.J. Neal, 3B Johnny Aiello, SS Luis De Los Santos, DH Hagen Danner and fellow relievers Cre Fin-frock and Fitz Stadler... his first pro start came next, 6/24 at Burlington, and it was better: three perfect innings with five strikeouts... he allowed two runs at most in one appearance (8/7 vs. Greenville, a career high five innings), allowed one run in three other appearances, and pitched shutout ball in the five remaining outings... the league batted just .138 against him, including a .123 batting average (7-for-57) by right-handed batters.

Midwest League (with a taste of the FSL) - 2019: Joined the Lugnugs from Extended Spring on May 20th, replacing the injured Juan De Paula in a piggybacking tandem with Josh Hiatt... earned first win, 5/30 at Dayton, allowing one hit and two unearned runs in five innings... 6/5 at Great Lakes, struck out five batters in four innings of relief, allowing two-run homer to Dillon Paulson... switched uniform number from 32 to 27 with the promotion of Jackson Rees to Dunedin on June 6th... 7/6 at LC, tossed six innings of one-run ball in 8-1 Lugnugs victory... promoted to A-Adv. Dunedin, July 18th, and made one start, allowing ten hits and four runs in six innings vs. Lakeland, 7/18... returned to Lansing, July 25th, making a relief appearance that same day vs. West Michigan (3 scoreless innings)... returns to the starting lineup tonight against Lake County... limiting MWL hitters to .209 average away from Cooley Law School Stadium (but .354 in Lansing).
