SUNDAY FUNDAY: The Portland Sea Dogs and Trenton Thunder (Yankees affiliate) complete a three-game series on Sunday afternoon at Arm & Hammer Park... Portland is looking to salvage the series finale before a three-game set starting Monday night at Reading...Last time swept in a three-game series on the road: April 23-25 in Hartford...Right-hander **Denyi Reyes** makes his second Double-A start for the Sea Dogs.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP: Portland dropped two games on Saturday, falling 3-2 in 10-innings and 1-0 in the seven-inning game...The two teams resumed Friday night's suspended game in the bottom of the third with the Thunder leading 2-0...In the 10th, **Brandon Wagner** hit a walk-off sacrifice-fly...Wagner accounted for the lone run in the second game, leading off the fifth inning with a solo homer down the right-field line.

HART DOMINATES AGAIN: Despite the 1-0 loss, **Kyle Hart** fired his second career complete game, yielding just one run on two hits and fanning nine...The lefty has 20 strikeouts over two starts...Last year, Hart did not pick up his 20th strikeout until his fifth start of the season...**Garrett Whitlock** fired six scoreless in game two and earned his first win of the year.

WEIRD WAY TO END IT: In game one, Portland's bullpen retired the final 11 batters in the walk-off loss...**Matthew Gorst** has suffered both losses in extra-innings, both on consecutive Saturdays...**Matthew Kent** took over for **Dedgar Jimenez** and tied a career-high (as a reliever) with five innings on three hits, one walk and fanned four... Kent stranded two on and nobody out in the sixth and three on and nobody out in the seventh.

NEW SKIPPER IN TOWN: **Joe Oliver** begins his first year as Portland's Manager, replacing **Darren Fenster**, who was promoted to Boston's outfield/baserunning coordinator.

AGAINST THE OPPONENT: Portland is 7-13-5 All-Time in season series against Trenton...The Sea Dogs are 1-2-1 in the last four season series against the Thunder, and have not won a season series at Arm & Hammer Park since 2014.
