**PREVIOUSLY, WITH THE SALEM RED SOX....** The Sox broke out of an offensive malaise Sunday night with an astonishing rally in the eighth inning, but stranded the tying run in the eighth and ninth frames as they fell 4-3 to the Myrtle Beach Pelicans. Salem didn't have a hit until the fifth inning, but still made their hosts sweat in the game before ultimately falling. It was the first time the Pelicans had swept Salem since July 19-21 of 2015, and the first three-game road sweep Salem had suffered since July 4-6, 2017 at the Carolina Mudcats. Brett Netzer drove in two for the Sox, who fell to a season-worst three games below .500.

**TODAY'S STARTERS:** Jake Thompson gets the ball in the first game of the doubleheader Monday. The righty got the win in his last outing, holding the Winston-Salem Dash to two runs on five hits and two walks in six innings while fanning five. He's 3-3 with a 4.48 ERA, and is 1-0 with a 4.66 ERA against Potomac (2 GS). Jhonathan Diaz makes his Salem debut in the nightcap; the 21-year-old lefty is 2-5 with a 3.79 ERA in 11 starts for Low-A Greenville.

**STALLED IN THE CLUTCH:** Salem has a striking gap in performance with runners in scoring position this season. During their wins, the Sox have batted .328 with runners in scoring position, an admirable number. When they've lost, that number has dropped all the way to .211. On the whole, the Sox are hitting .271 with runners in scoring position, and just .232 when there are two outs.

**BOMBS AWAY, BOBBY:** For the third straight season, the Salem Red Sox have boasted a third baseman who could mash. After Rafael Devers blasted 11 homers in 2016 and Michael Chavis crushed 17 in 2017, Dalbec has already hit 13 homers, giving him a three-dinger edge over Potomac's Rhett Wiseman for the league lead. Dalbec has hit nine of those homers at Haley Toyota Field, and six of them have been multi-run shots. However, the Sox are just 7-6 when he homers.

**MAYBE BUILD A WIND FARM?:** The Red Sox struck out a whopping 1,195 times in 2017, smashing the Salem record of 1,072, set in 1984. They fell just short of the previous Carolina League high of 1,198, set by the 1990 Lynchburg Red Sox. The Carolina Mudcats broke the record with 1,245 whiffs. Salem's fanned 452 times this season in 59 games, on pace for 1,073 strikeouts.

**DIVISION DUELS ON TAP:** The Red Sox finish the first half with nine games in seven days, and all of them come against their main divisional rivals. The Sox will host the P-Nats for five games in three days, with doubleheaders bookending the series. They will then finish the first half with a four-game road series at Lynchburg, the first time that Salem has gone east to take on their local rivals in 2018.

**ALL-STAR SOX:** Five members of the Red Sox were named to the Carolina League All-Star Team for the Northern Division. Relievers Daniel Gonzalez and Matthew

Gorst each earned a nod, while catcher Roldani Baldwin and infielders Jerry Downs and Santiago Espinal comprised the hitting delegation for the Sox.

### SALEM ALUMNI REPORT:

- Andrew Benintendi doubled and scored a run, and Rafael Devers chipped in an RBI, but the Red Sox fell 5-2 to the White Sox. Yoan Moncada went 2-5 with a run scored for Chicago, and Brandon Workman struck out three batters in one inning for Boston.
- Anthony Rizzo singled and drove in the only run for the Chicago Cubs on Sunday as they fell 7-1 to the Pirates.
