**Welcome to Opening Night...** Welcome to the 19th Opening Day in BlueClaws history as the BlueClaws open the season against Hickory (Rangers) tonight at FirstEnergy Park.

**On Opening Day...** The BlueClaws are 8-10 all-time on Opening Day, including a 2015 walk-off win (Carlos Tocci RBI single over Kannapolis)...Last year, Lakewood dropped their opener 4-3 in Kannapolis... Lakewood is 4-14 all-time in home openers but 4-4 in the last eight years after an 0-10 start...Last year, Lakewood topped Delmarva 2-0 in the home opener behind six scoreless innings from Will Stewart.

**Well Regarded...** The BlueClaws have six players ranked among the top 30 prospects in the system per Baseball America; #2 Alec Bohm, #3 Luis Garcia, #10 Francisco Morales, #13 Colton Eastman, #25 Rafael Marchan, and #30 James McArthur.

**The First-Round...** 3B Alec Bohm, taken third overall last year, is the 11th former first-round pick to play for the BlueClaws (Gavin Floyd, Cole Hamels, Greg Golson, Kyle Drabek, Anthony Hewitt, Jesse Biddle, JP Crawford, Cornelius Randolph, Mickey Moniak, Adam Haseley)...Bohm is the second-highest drafted player in BlueClaws history (Moniak was the first overall pick in the 2016 draft and a 2017 BlueClaw).

**Garcia Crushes Pro Debut...** Luis Garcia hit .369 as a 17-year old in the Gulf Coast League last year to win that league's batting crown...He also led the league in hits (62) and was third in on-base percentage at .433...Last year was Garcia's professional debut after signing in 2017.

**Youth Is Served...** Luis Garcia and Victor Santos are the first two BlueClaws born in the year 2000 and are the 16th and 17th players to play for the BlueClaws at age 18 (the other 15 are Freddy Galvis, Anthony Gose, Zach Collier, Jason Knapp, Sebastian Valle, Jonathan Singleton, Jonathan Villar, Domingo Santana, Maikel Franco, JP Crawford, Carlos Tocci, Deivi Grullon, Cornelius Randolph, Mickey Moniak, and Sixto Sanchez)...Galvis, Santana, and Tocci are the only 17-year olds.

**How Young Are They...** Luis Garcia was born on 10/1/2000, 33 days after the original BlueClaws logo was unveiled to the public in a downtown Lakewood ceremony on 8/29/2000...Garcia and Victor Santos are the first two BlueClaws that were born after Geoff Brown began as the BlueClaws General Manager on 11/19/1999.

**From Last Year's Draft...** The BlueClaws have nine players from last year's Phillies draft class, led by Bohm (3rd overall)...RHP Colton Eastman was the Phillies 4th round pick but second player taken by the team...RHP Dominic Pipkin was the team's 9th round pick...OF Matt Vierling (5th round) and IF Madison Stokes (10th round) finished last year with the BlueClaws and open this year with Clearwater.

**From the Yankees...** RHP Gilmael Troya began his career with the Yankees in 2015 and was acquired by the Phillies in the AAA-phase of the Rule-5 Draft...He pitched each of the last two years in Pulaski (Appalachian League)...Last year, he went 2-0, 1.63 with 55 strikeouts in 38.2 innings pitched.

**Gowdy Ready To Resume...** Kevin Gowdy, who was the Phillies 2nd round pick in the 2016 draft, did not pitch in 2017 or 2018 after having Tommy John Surgery in August of 2017...Entering the season, he had not pitched since August 27, 2016...Gowdy committed to UCLA before signing with the Phillies and played with 2016 Phillies first-round pick Mickey Moniak on a Team USA U-18 team that won a gold medal in Japan.

#### From Player to Coach

Pitching coach Matt Hockenberry is the first former BlueClaws player to coach the team (he made his coaching debut in the Gulf Coast League last year)...Former Phillies minor leaguer Christian Marrero is the hitting coach and Adam Godwin is the bench coach for the BlueClaws this year.

#### Upcoming

The BlueClaws will start their first road trip of the season on Thursday, April 11th in Delmarva...After four games against the Shorebirds, they'll play three at West Virginia before returning home.

**From The Shore to the Show...**In 2018, nine former BlueClaws made big league debuts including Phillies Scott Kingery and Seranthony Dominguez (both of whom will be honored with BlueClaws bobbleheads this year)...89 former BlueClaws have gone *From the Shore to the Show* beginning with Ryan Howard and Gavin Floyd in 2004.
