LAST GAME: Trailing 5-3 in the eighth, the Lynchburg Hillcats batted around, scoring six times, en route to a 9-5 comeback win over the Potomac Nationals, Sunday, to sweep the rain-shortened two-game series. **Trenton Brooks** drove in three runs in the ballgame, including the game winning single in the eighth. **Emmanuel Tapia** blasted a three-run homer in the same frame to put the game out of reach. **Billy Strode** picked up his second win out of the season, as he pitched a scoreless seventh inning out of the bullpen. **Luke Wakamatsu** went 3-3 at the plate, reaching base all four times, and scored three runs in the win.

MORGAN MOVING UP: RHP Eli Morgan was called up to Lynchburg on Tuesday, and will make his Advanced-A debut tonight. The Rancho Palos Verdes, CA native has been outstanding at Single-A Lake County so far this season, posting a 2-0 record and a 1.83 ERA. In eight starts he has struck out 56, while walking just 8, in 44.1 innings. Opponents are hitting just .194 against him.

NEAR NO-NO SERVES AS WAKE UP CALL: After the Hillcats were two outs from being no-hit by Frederick last Tuesday, their bats have come alive at the plate. They have tallied 113 hits and 80 runs over their last nine ballgames, eight of which have been wins. They have boosted their team batting average from last in the league at .219 to .250, while lowering their ERA from 4.33 to 3.99.

WAKA WARMING UP: Hillcats SS Luke Wakamatsu is starting to heat up offensively. The switch-hitter is batting .406 (13-for-32) over his last eight games. He has three extra-base hits and has five RBI during that span. On May 8, Wakamatsu's batting average was .162, and he has since raised that to .205 (43 points). He has also hit safely in seven of his past eight games. Overall this season, he is hitting .205 with 12 RBI and seven doubles.

HOME COOKIN' FOR PLESAC: Zach Plesac has been excellent at City Stadium this season, as he has not allowed a run in his last 17 innings pitched, including his complete-game shutout against Myrtle Beach. Overall this season, Plesac is 3-1 at home, with a 2.35 ERA in five starts, with opponents hitting just .200 against him. The right-hander has had a tougher time on the road this season, where he owns an 0-1 record and a 8.22 ERA in three starts.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Hillcats have produced double-digit run outputs in four of their last eight games, including their 12-0 victory over Potomac Saturday night, despite failing to score in double-digits through their first 32 games of the season.

IT'S MILLER TIME: First baseman Anthony Miller has come alive at the plate, reaching base in his last seven games. He is riding a five game hitting streak on which he is 11-23 (.487), with two home run and nine runs driven in. He has raised his average from .200 to .302 over that span.

DILLON DOING WORK: Dillon Persinger is currently riding a seven-game hitting streak, a season-high. On the streak he is hitting .370 (11-27), with five RBI, increasing his average by 29 points from .231 to .260. Persinger was drafted by the Indians in the 18th round in the 2017 draft out of Cal State Fullerton.

CASH OR CHECK?: James Karinchak has been nearly perfect since being called up to the Hillcats on May 3rd. The Right-hander tossed a scoreless 9th inning on Saturday against Potomac, to give him 5.1 innings without allowing a run. He has struck out ten, while allowing just six base runners. Combined with his time in Lake County this season, the right-hander has recorded 30 strikeouts in 16.2 innings, while opponents are hitting just .190 against him. A 9th round pick out of Bryant in 2017, Karinchak boasts an ERA of 0.54 in 2018.

LEATHER CLEANER: Through 40 games this season, the Hillcats have committed 50 errors, tied for second-most in the Carolina League. Only the Myrtle Beach Pelicans have made more defensive errors with 63. Lynchburg has committed four errors in a game three times this season, while played just 11 errorless games. The Hillcats have largely been able to overcome the miscues, going 16-13 in games in which they commit an error.

TOP-30 IN LYNCHBURG: Conner Capel (No. 12), Sam Hentges (No. 17), Logan Ice (No. 21), Mitch Longo (No. 27) and Eli Morgan (No. 28) are all Hillcats players that are ranked on the Indians Top-30 prospect list. Capel, an outfielder, batted .246 with 22 HR and 61 RBI in 119 games for the Single-A Lake County Captains last season. Hentges, a left-hander, missed the majority of last season while he was rehabbing from Tommy John surgery. He appeared in 11 total games (all starts) and went 0-4 with a 3.23 ERA between the AZL Indians and short-season Mahoning Valley. Hentges struck out 41 in 30.2 IP. Ice, a catcher, spent last season with Lake County and hit .228 with 11 HR and 42 RBI in 93 games. Longo, an outfielder, battled injuries last season and appeared in just 60 games. While he was healthy, he hit a combined .376 with 4 HR and 28 RBI between Lake County and Lynchburg. Morgan spent all of last season with Short-Season Mahoning Valley. He appeared in 13 games (8 starts) and sported a 3-2 record with a 1.03 ERA over 35 innings. He walked just nine and struck out 58. He played his college ball at Gonzaga and was drafted in the 8th round of the 2017 MLB draft.

HILLCATS COACHING STAFF

Rougie Odor

Manager (1st Season)
 Career Record: 233-247

Odor is entering his 18th year coaching in the Indians organization. He played in the minor leagues for the Indians & Brewers from 1988-1995. Odor brings a decade of skipper experience to Lynchburg. He led San Felipe in the Venezuelan Summer League for two seasons from 1999-2000, the Burlington Indians for four seasons from 2001-2004, the Mahoning Valley Scorpions for two years from 2005-2006 and the Gulf Coast League Indians for two campaigns from 2007-2008. He spent the past three seasons as the hitting coach for the Columbus Clippers, Cleveland's Triple-A affiliate.

Tony Arnold

Pitching Coach (2nd season)
 26th overall

Arnold returns to Lynchburg after serving as the pitching coach for the Hillcats in 2015. The former right-handed pitcher played collegiately at the University of Texas and was drafted by the Baltimore Orioles in the 10th round in the 1981 MLB Draft. The El Paso, Texas native played in parts of two MLB with the Orioles in 1986 and 1987. Arnold has coached in the Indians organization since 1992 and most recently was the pitching coach of the Akron Rubber-Ducks, Cleveland's Double-A affiliate, for the past two seasons.

Justin Toole

Hitting Coach (1st season)
 3rd overall

2018 marks Toole's first year on Lynchburg's coaching staff and third in the Indians organization. The former infielder played in parts of seven minor league seasons with Cleveland from 2009-2015, reaching Triple-A Columbus. The Council Bluffs, Iowa native worked as the hitting coach last year for Single-A Lake County.

Grant Fink

Bench Coach (1st season)
 2nd overall

Fink joins the Hillcats as bench coach for the first time in 2018, entering his second season as a coach in the Indians organization. The former infielder was drafted by Cleveland in the 23rd round of the 2013 MLB Draft out of Missouri Western State University. A native of St. Joseph, Mo., Fink played in parts of three minor league seasons for the Indians from 2013-2015, reaching Single-A Lake County. Fink was the bench coach last season for Short-Season Mahoning Valley.

Bobby Ruiz

Athletic Trainer (4th season)
 5th overall

Ruiz is in his eighth season in the Indians organization. He graduated from the University of La Verne in 2008. He spent two years at the University of Connecticut as a Graduate Assistant Athletic Trainer for the Huskies baseball team, while earning his Master's degree

Eric Oretego

Strength Coach (1st season)
 2nd overall

Oretego is in his second season in the Indians Organization. He graduated from the University of Louisiana at Lafayette in 2012. Following graduation, Oretego served as the Assistant Director of Strength and Conditioning at McNeese State.

Morgan was born in Rancho Palos Verdes, CA, and attended Palos Verdes Peninsula HS where he boasted a 1.23 ERA as a senior in 2014, earning Bay League Co-Pitcher of the Year Honors.
