MYRTLE BEACH PELICANS (17-26) VS LYNCHBURG HILLCATS (22-18)

RHP Tyson Miller (3-4, 3.58) vs RHP Eli Morgan (0-0, -.--/2-0, 1.83 w/LC)

LAST GAME: Trailing 5-3 in the eighth, the Lynchburg Hillcats batted around, scoring six times, en route to a 9-5 comeback win over the Potomac Nationals, Sunday, to sweep the rain-shortened two-game series. Trenton Brooks drove in three runs in the ballgame, including the game winning single in the eighth. Emmanuel Tapia blasted a three-run homer in the same frame to put the game out of reach. Billy Strode picked up his second win out of the season, as he pitched a scoreless seventh inning out of the bullpen. Luke Wakamatsu went 3-3 at the plate, reaching base all four times, and scored three runs in the win.

MORGAN MOVING UP: RHP Eli Morgan was called up to Lynchburg on Tuesday, and will make his Advanced-A debut tonight. The Rancho Palos Verdes, CA native has been outstanding at Single-A Lake County so far this season, posting a 2-0 record and a 1.83 ERA. In eight starts he has stuck out 56, while walking just 8, in 44.1 innings. Opponents are hitting just .194 against him.

NEAR NO-NO SERVES AS WAKE UP CALL: After the Hillcats were two outs from being no-hit by Frederick last Tuesday, their bats have come alive at the plate. They have tallied 113 hits and 80 runs over their last nine ballgames, eight of which have been wins. They have boosted their team batting average from last in the league at .219 to .fifth best at .250, while lowering their ERA from 4.33 to 3.99.

WAKA WARMING UP: Hillcats SS Luke Wakamatsu is starting to heat up offensively. The switch-hitter is batting .406 (13-for-32) over his last eight games. He has three extra-base hits and has five RBI during that span. On May 8, Wakamatsu's batting average was '162, and he has since raised that to .205 (43 points). He has also hit safely in seven of his past eight games. Overall this season, he is hitting .205 with 12 RBI and seven doubles.

HOME COOKIN' FOR PLESAC: Zach Plesac been excellent at City Stadium this season, as he has not allowed a run in his last 17 innings pitched, including his complete-game shutout against Myrtle Beach. Overall this season, Plesac is 3-1 at home, with a 2.35 ERA in five starts, with opponents hitting just .200 against him. The right-hander has had a tougher time on the road this season, where he owns an 0-1 record and a 8.22 ERA in three starts.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Hillcats have produced double-digit run outputs in four of their last eight games, including their 12-0 victory over Potomac Saturday night, despite failing to score in double-digits through their first 32 games of the season.

IT'S MILLER TIME: First baseman Anthony Miller has come alive at the plate, reaching base in his last seven games. He is riding a five game hitting streak on which he is 11-23 (.487), with two home run and nine runs driven in. He has raised his average from .200 to .302 over that span.

DILLON DOING WORK: Dillon Persinger is currently riding a seven-game hitting streak, a season-high. On the streak he is hitting .370 (11-27), with five RBI, increasing his average by 29 points from .231 to .260. Persinger was drafted by the Indians in the 18th round in the 2017 draft out of Cal State Fullerton.

CASH OR CHECK?: James Karinchak has been nearly perfect since being called up to the Hillcats on May 3rd. The Right-hander tossed a scoreless 9th inning on Saturday against Potorecorded 30 strikeouts in 16.2 innings, while opponents are hitting just .190 against him. A 9th round pick out of Bryant in 2017, Karinchak boasts an ERA of 0.54 in 2018.

LEATHER CLEANER: Through 40 games this season, the Hillcats have committed 50 errors, tied for second-most in the Carolina League. Only the Myrtle Beach Pelicans have made more defensive errors with 63. Lynchburg has committed four errors in a game three times this season, while played just 11 errorless games. The Hillcats have largely been able to overcome the miscues, going 16-13 in games in which they commit an error.

TOP-30 IN LYNCHBURG: Conner Capel (No. 12), Sam Hentges (No. 17), Logan Ice (No. 21), Mitch Longo (No. 27) and Eli Morgan (No. 28) are all Hillcats players that are ranked on the Indians Top-30 prospect list. Capel, an outfielder, batted .246 with 22 HR and 61 RBI in 119 games for the Single-A Lake County Captains last season. Hentges, a left-hander, missed the majority of fast season while he was rehabling from Tommy John surgery. He appeared in 11 total games (all starts) and went 0-4 with a 3.23 ERA between the AZL Indians and short-season Mahoning Valley. Hentges struck out 41 in 30.2 IP. Ice, a catcher, spent last season with Lake County and hit .228 with 11 HR and 42 RBI in 93 games. Longo, an outfielder, battled injuries last season and appeared in just 60 games. While he was healthy, he hit a combined .376 with 4 HR and 28 RBI between Lake County and Lynchburg. Morgan spent all of last season with Short-Season Mahoning Valley. He appeared in 13 games (8 starts) and sported a 3-2 record with a 1.03 ERA over 35 innings. He walked just nine and struck out 58. He played his college ball at Gonzaga and was drafted in the 8th round of the 2017 MLB draft.
