**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Lynchburg Hillcats squandered an early 5-0 lead, as the Potomac Nationals scored six unanswered taking the lead in the tenth, before Trenton Brooks lifted a sac fly in the bottom of the tenth to walk it off, 7-6. Nolan Jones led the way again for Lynchburg, finishing a triple shy of the cycle, while driving in a career-high four runs. Ben Krauth fired three scoreless innings in relief, striking out a season-high six. Kyle Nelson picked up the win picking up the final out of the tenth to earn his second win in as many outings.

**CRUISE CONTROL:** The Hillcats have now won 11 of their last 12 games, and now have a season-best 7.5 game lead in the Northern Division. At 36-21 the Hillcats have the best second half record of any team in the Carolina League, half a game better than Winston-Salem and Buies Creek.

**HOME SWEET HOME:** In the month of August, the Hillcats have enjoyed playing at City Stadium, where the club is 9-1. It is a big turn around from the rest of the season, when Lynchburg never had a record better than two games over .500 at home. In July, the club went 7-9 at City Stadium. The team hits 20 points better (.256 to .236 at home).

**IN THE DRIVERS SEAT:** With less than two weeks remaining the regular season, the push for the playoffs is on. The Hillcats are currently in first place in the Carolina League North Division, 7.5 games ahead of Wilmington with 13 games remaining. In order for Lynchburg to make the playoffs and have a chance to defend their 2017 Championship, they will have to win the division. Potomac has already qualified for the post-season by winning the division in the first half, and the second-half North winner will play the P-Nats in the first round, beginning on September 5.

**JONESIN ALONG:** Third baseman Nolan Jones has been a catalyst for the Hillcats at the plate as of late. He has hit safely in five straight games, going 10-for-17 with four doubles, two home runs, eight RBI and five walks. The Indians #2 ranked prospect has hit safely in nine of his last 12 games, batting .375 (15-40) and has walked 12 times in comparison to nine strikeouts. He also has an OPS of 1.013 since joining Lynchburg and has collected an RBI in four consecutive contests.

**OVER THE HUMP:** In the second half, the Hillcats are a season-best 15 games over the .500 mark at 36-21. In the first half of the season, Lynchburg never made it more than five games over .500. At one point, the Hillcats were 10 games under during the first half but have not dipped below .500 baseball in the entire second half.

**AWESOME AUGUST:** The Hillcats have excelled so far in the month of August. Despite hitting just .220 as a team, Lynchburg has gone 14-4 this month. They also have a team ERA of 3.50, which includes the game in which they allowed 17 earned runs to the Buies Creek Astros on August 5. Kirk McCarty has given up a run in two starts this month, while Sam Hentges has posted a 2.35 ERA through three August starts.

**McCARTY PARTY:** Kirk McCarty has been sensational through two Carolina League starts. In his debut against the Wood Ducks August 11 he fired six scoreless innings, allowing just two hits while striking out six. McCarty followed it up with seven innings of one run ball in his second start, August 18 vs Frederick. A 7th Round pick out of Southern Mississippi in 2017, McCarty began the year in Lake County, where he struck out 132 batters while walking just 34 in 22 starts.

**BRILLIANT BEN:** Ben Krauth continues to dominate out of the Hillcats bullpen. The left-hander has racked up the most strikeouts of any Lynchburg reliever (92). He has allowed just five earned runs over his last 34.2 IP (1.30) ERA. His .185 opponents batting average is tied for the lowest in the Carolina League, he also has the highest strikeouts/9 IP ratio (13.21), and league lead in holds (8). Krauth has allowed the third fewest base runners per 9 IP, at 9.77.

**LUCKY NUMBER 7:** When a Hillcats starting pitcher has gone at least seven innings this season, it's led to wins. In fact, the Hillcats are undefeated with a 10-0 record in such a scenario. Zach Plesac and Tanner Tully each lead the Hillcats with three outings of seven innings or more.

**I'VE GOT THE POWER!:** After belting just 25 home runs in the first half of the season, the Hillcats have already hit 42 long balls in the club's first 57 games of the second half. Jodd Carter has seven to lead the way, while Li-Jen Chu has gone deep six times in the second half of play. Lynchburg hit a season-high five home runs in the July 2 win against the Keys, including three in one inning. Additionally after tallying just six multi-homer games in the first half, they have accounted for six in the second half.

**TOP-30 IN THE HILL CITY:** Nolan Jones (No. 2), Sam Hentges (No. 8), Eli Morgan (No. 16), Nick Sandlin (No. 18), and Mitch Longo (No. 23) are all Hillcats players that are ranked on the Indians Top-30 prospect list. Jones, the Tribe's 2nd round pick in 2016, batted .317 with four HR and 33 RBI with Short-season Mahoning Valley last season. This year, his power numbers jumped to 16 HR and 49 RBI, while hitting .279 for Lake County before his promotion to Lynchburg on August 3. Hentges, a left-hander, missed the majority of last season while he was rehabbing from Tommy John surgery, but leads the Hillcats in strikeouts this season. With Mahoning Valley, Morgan appeared in 13 games (8 starts) and sported a 3-2 record with a 1.03 ERA over 35 innings. He played at Gonzaga and was drafted in the 8th round of the 2017 MLB draft. Sandlin was drafted in 2018 out of Southern Mississippi, where he went 10-0 with a 1.06 ERA as a junior. His success continued with Lake County posting a 1.74 ERA in ten appearances. Longo, an outfielder, battled injuries last season, but while he was healthy, he hit a combined .376 with 4 HR and 28 RBI between Lake County and Lynchburg, helping the Hillcats to a Carolina League Championship.

<b>Rougie Odor</b> Manager (1st Season) Career Record: 289-301  Odor is in his 18th year coaching in the Indians organization. He played in the minor leagues for the Indians & Brewers from 1988-1995. Odor brings a decade of skipper experience to Lynchburg. He led San Felipe in the Venezuelan Summer League for two seasons from 1999-2000, the Burlington Indians for four seasons from 2001-2004, the Mahoning Valley Scrapper for two years from 2005-2006 and the Gulf Coast League Indians for two campaigns from 2007-2008. He spent the past three seasons as the hitting coach for the Columbus Clippers, Cleveland's Triple-A affiliate.	<b>Tony Arnold</b> Pitching Coach (2nd season) 26th overall  Arnold returns to Lynchburg after serving as the pitching coach for the Hillcats in 2015. The former right-handed pitcher played collegiately at the University of Texas and was drafted by the Baltimore Orioles in the 10th round in the 1981 MLB Draft. The El Paso, Texas native played in parts of two MLB with the Orioles in 1986 and 1987. Arnold has coached in the Indians organization since 1992 and most recently was the pitching coach of the Akron RubberDucks, Cleveland's Double-A affiliate, for the past two seasons.	<b>Justin Toole</b> Hitting Coach (1st season) 3rd overall  2018 marks Toole's first year on Lynchburg's coaching staff and third in the Indians organization. The former infielder played in parts of seven minor league seasons with Cleveland from 2009-2015, reaching Triple-A Columbus. The Council Bluffs, Iowa native worked as the hitting coach last year for Single-A Lake County.	<b>Grant Fink</b> Bench Coach (1st season) 2nd overall  Fink joins the Hillcats as bench coach for the first time in 2018, entering his second season as a coach in the Indians organization. The former infielder was drafted by Cleveland in the 23rd round of the 2013 MLB Draft out of Missouri Western State University. A native of St. Joseph, Mo., Fink played in parts of three minor league seasons for the Indians from 2013-2015, reaching Single-A Lake County. Fink was the bench coach last season for Short-Season Mahoning Valley.	<b>Bobby Ruiz</b> Athletic Trainer (4th season) 5th overall Ruiz is in his eighth season in the Indians organization. He graduated from the University of La Verne in 2008. He spent two years at the University of Connecticut as a Graduate Assistant Athletic Trainer for the Huskies baseball team, while earning his Master's degree  <b>Eric Ortego</b> Strength Coach (1st season) 2nd overall Ortego is in his second season in the Indians Organization. Cleveland Indians 16th-best prospect as ranked by *Baseball America*...Drafted by the Indians in the 8th Round in 2017 out of Gonzaga University

At Gonzaga was named a First Team All-American by Perfect Game and Rawlings in 2017 as a junior, as well as First Team All-WCC...He Posted a 2.86 ERA, striking out 138 in 100.2 IP. His strikeout mark ranked 3rd in the nation.

In his first pro season with Mahoning Valley in 2017, Morgan ranked 3rd in the New York-Penn League with a 1.03 ERA (min. 35 IP), while posting a k/9 IP of 14.9.

Morgan was born in Rancho Palos Verdes, CA, and attended Palos Verdes Peninsula HS where he boasted a 1.23 ERA as a senior in 2014, earning Bay League Co-Pitcher of the Year Honors.
