YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Tarpons scored three runs in the 1st and took a 5-3 lead into the 8th before the Fire Frogs rallied for a 6-5 win on Saturday evening...was Tampa's first loss when leading after six innings...RHP Adonis Rosa made his fourth start (ninth appearance) and held Florida to 3R/OER in 4.1IP (4H, 3BB, 5K)...Diego Castillo (2-for-5, 2B, R), Alexander Palma (2-for-3, 2B, BB, RB), 2R) and Hoy Jun Park (2-for-4, 2B, 2RBI) had multi-hit games...RHP Hobie Harris logged a scoreless outing (2.2IP, 1H, 1BB, 5K)...RHP Matt Frawley (BS, 1)(L, 0-2) took the loss in relief (1.0IP, 2H, 3ER, 2BB, 1K).

THE NEW GUY: Since his call-up from Single-A Charleston, Dom Thompson-Williams has immediately made his presence known. The 23-year-old has 3HR and 7RBI in his first six games with the Tarpons. DTW began the season with the RiverDogs and, despite a month on the disabled list, batted .378/.425/.811 (14-for-37) with 7R, 1 double, 5HR, 9RBI, 2BB and 3SB in 10 games. The Sioux City, lowa native hit all five homers in a three-game span, slugging 2HR on 5/13 before adding 3HR in a doubleheader on 5/15 (2HR in G1).

WALK THIS WAY: With another walk on Friday, Hoy Jun Park is now tied for first in the Florida State League with 29 bases on balls. Park has hit safely in eight of his last nine games, batting .400 (12-for-30) in that span. The 22-year-old is also tied for fourth in the league with 11 stolen bases.

GO, DIEGO, GO: Diego Castillo has hit safely in 13 of his last 17 games, batting .333 (20-for-60) in that span. The 20-year-old is also one of the toughest to strike out in the league, averaging 9.22 TPA/SO (3rd lowest in the FSL).

VS. FLORIDA: Today will be the 10th of 14 scheduled meetings between the Tampa Tarpons and Florida Fire Frogs. Florida currently leads the season-series, 5-4. The Tarpons are 2-4 at Osceola County Stadium. **Diego Castillo** is batting .357 (10-for-28, 4R, 3 2B's, 3RBI, BB) in seven games against the Fire Frogs. As a team, Tampa batters are hitting .222 against Fire Frog pitching.

A WALK-OFF...WHAT? The Tarpons won, 3-2, on Tuesday thanks to a game-ending catcher's interference call with the bases loaded in the 10th inning. Tampa and Charlotte took a 1-1 tie into extras and the Stone Crabs scored a run in the top of the 10th. A walk and a single loaded the bases with no outs in the bottom of the frame for Tampa. After a game-tying RBI single by Alexander Palma, the winning run scored when Dom Thompson-Williams swung late and clipped the glove of Charlotte catcher Zacrey Law. DTW had also reached on catcher's interference in the 6th inning of the game.

FOR STARTERS: RHP Albert Abreu (1-1, 5.40) will make his fifth start of the season. Last time out, took the loss vs. Charlotte on 5/21 after allowing a season-high 7ER in 4.0IP (4H, 2BB, 6K, 4HR, 1HB, 1WP, 81P/44S)...began the season on the disabled list after undergoing an emergency appendectomy in February.

2017: Began the season with Single-A Charleston, going 1-0 with a 1.84 ERA (14.2IP, 3ER) in three games (two starts) before being promoted to Tampa on 4/23, where he went 1-3 with a 4.19 ERA (34.1IP, 16ER) in nine starts...
