YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Tarpons split a doubleheader with the Lakeland Flying Tigers on Thursday, snapping a three-game skid with a 3-0 win in Game 1 before dropping the finale, 3-2...**Hoy Jun Park** (3-for-6, 2HR, 4RBI, 2R, SB) homered in both games, including a 2-run blast in Game 1 and a solo shot in Game 2...**Ben Ruta** (3-for-5, HR, BB, RBI, R, Sac-B, SB) hit a leadoff homer in the 1st inning of Game 1 and hit safely in both games...**Alexander Palma** (2-for-6) singled in each game...**RHP Nick Nelson** withstood a 53-minute rain delay in the 2nd inning of Game 1 and held the Flying Tigers scoreless for 4.1IP (3H, 4BB, 7K, WP)...**RHP David Sosebee** (W, 4-2) retired all five batters he faced (1.2IP, 1K) and **RHP Matt Wivinis** (SV, 3) tossed a scoreless 7th (1.0IP, 1H, 1K)...**RHP Shawn Semple** (L, 0-1) made a spot-start in Game 2 (4.0IP, 5H, 3ER, 1BB, 2K, PO)...**RHP Hobie Harris** logged 3.0 scoreless innings (3H, 2K).

ALL-STAR ANNOUNCED: Seven Tarpons were announced as Florida State League Mid-Season All-Stars on Friday: **RHP Trevor Stephan**, **RHP Michael King**, **RHP David Sosebee** and **C Francisco Diaz** were named despite having since been promoted to Double-A Trenton. Current Tampa players **RHP Nick Green**, **LHP Trevor Lane** and **INF Diego Castillo** were also selected.

VS. DUNEDIN: Tonight will be the fifth of 15 scheduled meetings between the Tampa Tarpons and Dunedin Blue Jays. The Tarpons currently lead the season-series, 3-1. Tampa won 3-of-4 when the teams first met at GMS Field on 5/15-17.

PALMA POWER: Over his last 11 games, **Alexander Palma** has logged four multi-hit games, including a pair of three-hit performances. The 22-year-old is batting .447 (14-for-49) in that span.

WALK THIS WAY: With two more walks on Sunday, **Hoy Jun Park** now leads the Florida State League with 31 bases on balls. Park has hit safely in 11 of his last 14 games, batting .386 (17-for-38) in that span.

GO, DIEGO, GO: **Diego Castillo** has hit safely in 17 of his last 22 games, batting .329 (25-for-76) in that span. The 20-year-old is also one of the toughest to strike out in the league, averaging 9.74 TPA/SO (2nd lowest in the FSL).

DOM'S BOMBS: Since being promoted to Tampa, **Dom Thompson-Williams** clubbed four home runs in his first 10 games. The 23-year-old hit five homers in 10 games with Single-A Charleston prior to his call-up, adding up to nine home runs in his first 20 games played in 2018. The Sioux, Iowa native hit just 3HR in 64G between short-season, Single-A Staten Island and Charleston in 2017.
