Baysox vs. Richmond

2019 Record: 0-0

In Case You Missed It: The Baysox salvaged the final game of a four-game set in Harrisburg with a 6-2 win over the Senators on Sunday afternoon. Bowie jumped out to the early lead by scoring five runs in the third inning. **Rylan Bannon** had a three-run double and **Yusniel Diaz** hit a solo home run in that frame. **Preston Palmeiro** had the other RBI in the game on a single in the sixth inning. **Zac Lowther** put together the best start of the short season for a Baysox pitcher, tossing five scoreless innings in his AA debut. **Tanner Chleborad** pitched two scoreless innings out of the bullpen, striking out four.

Herb's Debut: **RHP Tyler Herb** makes his Orioles organizational debut tonight. Herb was acquired from the Giants in a trade for OF **Mike Yastrzemski** on March 23, 2019. The 26-year-old made 13 starts last year in AAA Sacramento, going 2-8 with a 5.35 ERA in 70.2 innings. Herb made 10 starts with Richmond in 2017, and posted a career-best 2.76 ERA in 65.1 innings. Herb has been named a Midseason All-Star twice in his career: in 2017 with Arkansas, Seattle's AA-affiliate, and in 2016 with High-A Bakersfield. Herb was drafted in the 29th round in 2014 by the Mariners out of Coastal Carolina, and was traded to the Giants in July of 2017 for **Chris Heston**.

In the Other Corner: **RHP Alfred Gutierrez** gets the ball for Richmond this evening. The Giants signed Gutierrez to a minor league contract in November of 2018. The 23-year-old spent the first seven years of his career in the Detroit organization, and pitched at three levels in 2018. Gutierrez made appearances in AAA Toledo, AA Erie and High-A Lakeland. Overall, he went 4-7 with a 4.20 ERA in 109.1 innings, striking out 110 batters. Gutierrez was named a Midseason All-Star in the Florida State League during his time in Lakeland.

Last Year in Richmond: The Flying Squirrels and Baysox played 20 games last season, with the Baysox winning 11 of them. Overall, Bowie is 105-104 in 209 all-time meetings with Richmond.

Power Play: The Baysox have showcased their power through the first four games of the season. Bowie hit a home run in each of the four games during the last series in Harrisburg...**Anderson Feliz** hit a two-run home run on Opening Day, **Ryan McKenna** hit a three-run blast in game two, **Rylan Bannon** had a first inning homer in the third game and **Yusniel Diaz** lined a two-run shot over the left field fence in the final game as part of a five-run inning.

Scoring First: Bowie scored first in each of the games in the series in Harrisburg. On Opening Day, **Cael Brockmeyer** had a sacrifice fly to begin the scoring. In game two, the Baysox scored five runs in the second inning. **Sean Miller** and **T.J. Nichting** each had RBI singles in that frame, and **Ryan McKenna** hit a three-run home run. In the third game, it was **Rylan Bannon** starting things with a solo home run. In the series finale on Sunday, Bowie scored five runs in the third inning, coming from a Bannon three-run double and a **Yusniel Diaz** two-run home run.

Top Tier Talent: The Bowie Baysox roster is filled with some of the top prospects in the Orioles' farm system. According to MLB.com, seven of the top 30 prospects in the organization will begin the season in Bowie. Outfielder **Yusniel Diaz** headlines the roster, coming into the year as Baltimore's number one prospect. Outfielder **Ryan McKenna** (#7) and Left-Handed Pitcher **Zac Lowther** (#8) also rank in the Orioles' top ten. Pitchers **Hunter Harvey** (#12), **Dillon Tate** (#18), **Zach Pop** (#20) and Infielder **Rylan Bannon** (#23) round out the top prospects that start the 2019 campaign with the Baysox.

The Buck Starts Here: 2019 marks Buck Britton's first season as manager of the Bowie Baysox. Britton replaces Gary Kendall, who was the head man in Bowie from 2011-2018. Britton picked up his first victory as a AA manager on April 7 against the Harrisburg Senators. Last season, Britton managed the Delmarva Shorebirds, leading the club to a 68-66 record. Prior to getting into coaching, Britton played nine seasons in Minor League Baseball, and spent parts of 2009, 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014 with the Baysox. Buck is the brother of former Baysox and Orioles' left-hander Zack Britton.

This Day in Baysox History: On April 9, 1997, the Baysox defeated Norwich by a final score of 2-0. RHP **Sidney Ponsen** fired a complete game two-hit shutout to lead Bowie to victory.

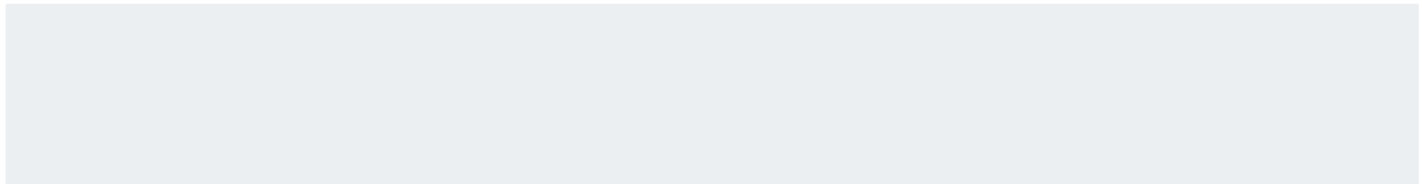
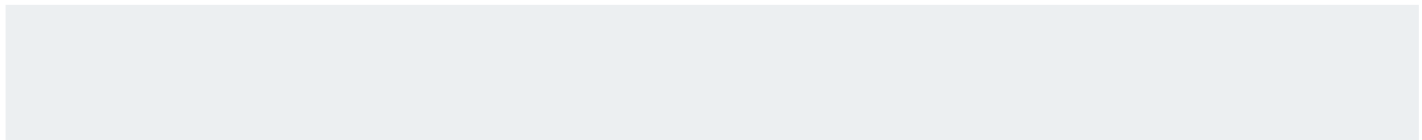
