- ♦ The Blue Jays offense knocked 17 hits in the team's biggest win of the year, beating Bradenton 11-1. LHP Tayler Saucedo continued his torrid streak, allowing just one run on three hits over 7.0 IP while striking out 7.
- ♦ Saucedo allowed the first runner of the game to reach and score, but was lights out after, not allowing another hit until the seventh inning after giving up a double in the first. RHP William Ouellette and RHP Jonny Cheshire each tossed a scoreless inning of relief.
- ♦ After taking a 5-1 lead, the Jays opened the seventh inning by stringing together seven consecutive base hits, scoring six times before Bradenton recorded the first out of the inning. Eduard Pinto and Kevin Smith each had three hits. Josh Palacios, David Jacob, Alberto Mineo, and John La Prise had two apiece.

Around the Farm

- ♦ Buffalo allowed four runs in the 8th in a 5-4 loss to Syracuse. Anthony Alford had three hits, falling a triple shy of a cycle. Lourdes Gurriel doubled in a 2-5 day.
- ♦ Bo Bichette had three hits including a double and HR (8), scored three times, and drove in two in New Hampshire's 7-6 loss to Trenton. Harold Ramirez was 2-3 with a HR (4).
- ♦ The Lansing Lugnuts beat Great Lakes 3-1. Kevin Vicuna had two knocks while Maverick Buffo tossed 7.0 scoreless innings to earn his 9th win of the season. Brett Wright HR'd (1) and Will McAffer threw 3.1 hitless in relief to pick up his third win.
- ♦ Vancouver beat Salem-Keizer 11-1. Bryan Lizardo was 4-4 with 3 runs and 3 RBI. Griffin Conine went 3-5 with 2 RBI, 2 runs, and a triple.
- ♦ Bluefield scored 21 times on 20 hits in a 21-11 win over Greenville. Otto Lopez was 5-6 with 2 2Bs and a triple. Luis De Los Santos HR'd (4) and tripled and John Aiello HR'd. Josh Almonte threw 2.0 hitless innings of relief, striking out 3.

- ♦ The Blue Jays are 1-5 against Bradenton entering this season despite a 2.65 team ERA against the Marauders. In his first outing against Bradenton this season, LHP Tayler Saucedo tossed 8.0 IP, allowing just 4 hits and no earned runs.
- ♦ Dunedin has hit .244 against Bradenton entering this series. Eduard Pinto (.316) and Josh Palacios (.300) have paced the offense.

- ♦ The Blue Jays will host their annual Princesses and Pirates Night this evening. The kid-friendly promotion will feature numerous princesses and pirates in costume to meet young fans, a bounce house and pirate ship, face painting, balloon animals, a costume contest, and kids run the bases post-game.
- ♦ The Blue Jays will follow with Canada Day on Sunday and Hometown USA on Tuesday.

Big Month For Big Murph

- ♦ RHP Patrick Murphy has been lights out in the month of June. In five starts, Murphy holds a 2-0 record and 0.93 ERA, throwing 29.0 IP, striking out 28, and holding opposing hitters to a .219 average.

Blue Jays Acquire Santiago Espinal

- ♦ On Thursday, the Blue Jays swapped veteran IF/OF Steve Pearce for Red Sox prospect IF Santiago Espinal. After hitting .280 with 4 HR for the Greenville Drive in 2017, Espinal broke out as a legitimate prospect in 2018, slashing .313/.363/.477 with 7 HR in 65 games for the A+ Salem Red Sox. The right-handed hitting former 10th round pick from Miami Dade CC crushes left-handed pitching (.360/.392/.653) and has played short, third, and second this season.

Pinto Promoted

- ♦ Eduard Pinto has been promoted to AA-New Hampshire. Pinto led the Blue Jays with a .308 average in 63 games in 2018, knocking a team-high 15 doubles and stealing 8 bases. Pinto hit .462 over his last ten games with Dunedin.
- ♦ Pinto has been the hardest batter to strike out in the Florida State League by a significant margin in 2018. Averaging 16.7 plate appearances per strikeout, Pinto has struck out just 16 times in 229 at-bats.

Emerging Power

- ♦ Dunedin has average 4.9 runs per game in June, up from 3.8 per game in May, thanks to an uptick in power. The Blue Jays have hit as many HR (16) in June than they did in April (10) and May (6) combined.
- ♦ Dunedin is hitting .272 in the month of June, up from .243 in May and .253 in April.

Palacios In The Clutch

- ♦ The bigger the situation, the better Josh Palacios has been this season. Hitting just .227 with the bases empty, Palacios has hit .350 with runners on (103 at-bats). More impressively, Palacios is hitting .379 with runners in scoring position (66 ABs) and .433 with runners in scoring position and two outs (30 ABs).

Too Much Sauce

- ♦ Following a tough April (6.00 ERA), Jays LHP Tayler Saucedo made minor mechanical changes with pitching coach Mark Riggins that have led to stellar results. Since May 1st, Tayler Saucedo has been one of the FSL's top starting pitchers. In 10 starts, he's picked up 5 wins, thrown 61.0 IP, and holds a 2.51 ERA and 0.98 WHIP.

Mineo Factor

- ♦ The Blue Jays acquired C Alberto Mineo in last December's MiLB Rule 5 Draft, expecting him to be a strong defender behind the dish and the results have been spectacular. Blue Jays pitchers have a 2.66 ERA when pitching to Mineo (compared to a 3.83 ERA when throwing to other catchers). At the plate, Mineo has hit .284 and reached base at a .383 clip.

Patience At The Plate

- ♦ As a team, the Jays are tied for the Florida State League lead in walks (253).

Re-stocked with Fish

- ♦ After one shutout outing with the AAA Buffalo Bisons, LHP Jake Fishman returned to the Blue Jays yesterday. Since May 1st, Fishman has posted a 0.87 ERA in 16 appearances for the D-Jays, striking out 25 in 20.2 IP and allowing just 2 earned runs.

Keeping It Close

- ♦ The Blue Jays have played in 33 one-run games during the 2018 season, the most in the Florida State League. Dunedin has gone 14-19 in those games. 48 of the team's 76 games have been decided by two runs or less.

- Since his selection in the draft, has had Tommy John surgery, thoracic outlet syndrome surgery, and a nerve moved in his right elbow, limiting him to just 44 appearances in the 5 seasons since the 2013 draft.

- Split the 2017 season between the GCL and R-Bluefield, posting a 1.48 ERA in 24.1 IP while striking out 31 batters.
- Made 13 appearances in the first half, throwing 21.1 innings, going 4-0 with a 2.95 ERA.

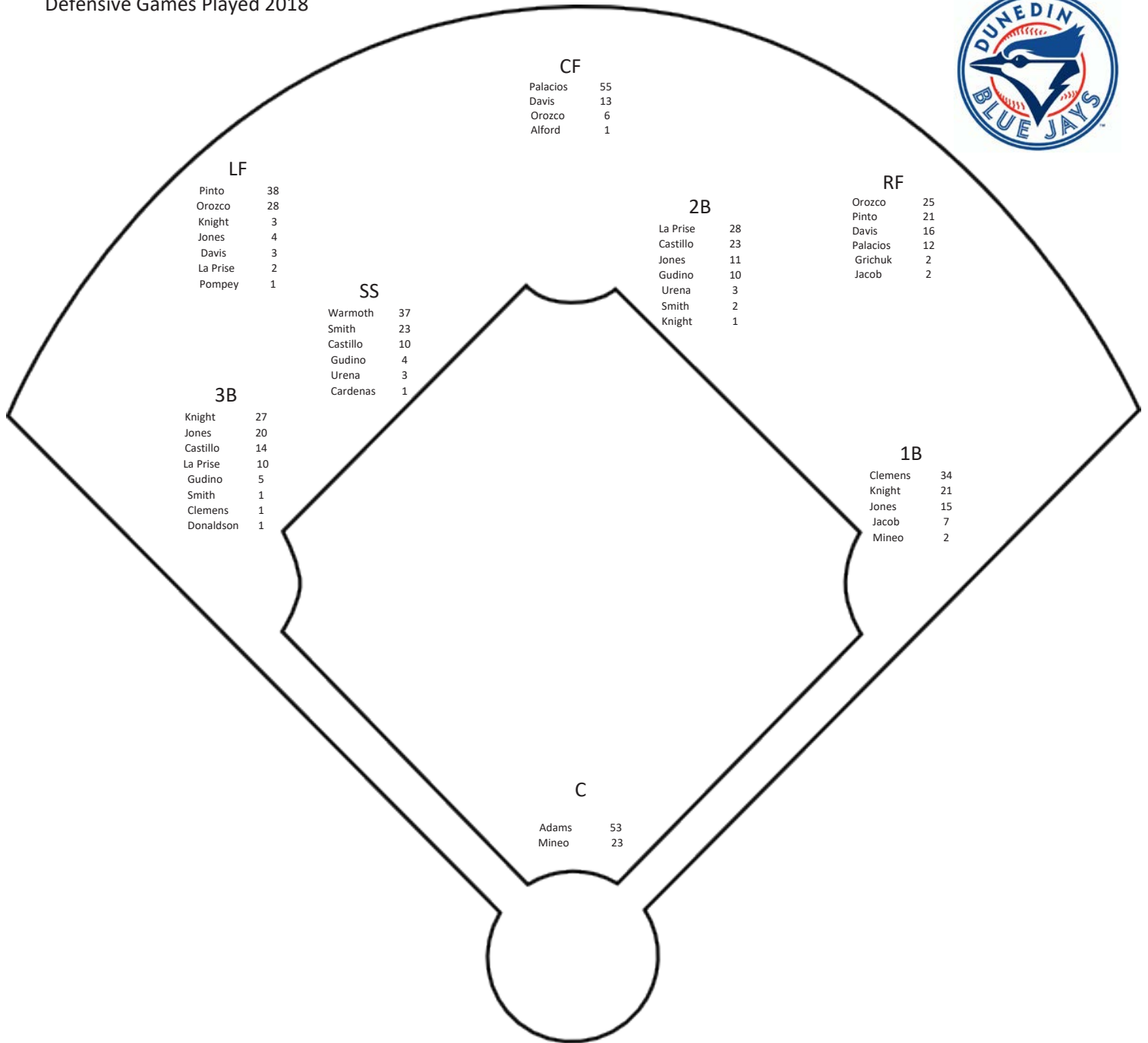
