- ♦ The Blue Jays extended their winning streak to 8 games with their second consecutive shutout of the Clearwater Threshers, winning 6-0 on Tuesday evening. RHP Connor Eller tossed a gem in a spot start, throwing 5.2 scoreless innings in his longest career outing, allowing 5 hits and striking out 4. RHP Jonny Cheshire and RHP Jackson McClelland finished the shutout with 3.1 innings of relief combined.
- ♦ The Jays used back-to-back-to-back doubles in the fourth inning to score four times. A C Riley Adams RBI single in the fifth extended the lead to 5-0, and 1B David Jacob led off the sixth with a solo HR (4) to make it 6-0.
- ♦ Adams was 2-4 with an RBI. Rodrigo Orozco was also 2-4, doubling and driving in 2.

- ♦ Tomorrow (July 12), the Blue Jays will take the field wearing specialty Dunedin Orange jerseys. The artwork on the jerseys was painted by local artist Steve Spathef, whose work can be found on buildings and murals across the city of Dunedin.

Big Month For Big Murph

- ♦ Since June 1, RHP Patrick Murphy has gone 4-0 with a 1.51 ERA in 7 starts. Murph has struck out 38 batters in 41.2 IP over that stretch and held opposing hitters to a .212 average.

Success Against Paulino

- ♦ In five games against Clearwater SP Felix Paulino, the Blue Jays have hit .349 and scored 10 runs in 10.2 innings.

Spot Start Success

- ♦ RHP Connor Eller has provided the Blue Jays with four impressive spot starts this year. As a starter, he holds a 0.60 ERA, having allowed just 1 run in 15.0 IP.

Eight-Game Winning Streak

- ♦ Over the last eight games, the Blue Jays have allowed just 8 earned runs in 62.0 IP, good for a 1.16 team ERA. As a team, the Blue Jays have hit .294 and scored 5.3 runs per game during the streak.

Hot Start For Lundquist

- ♦ Since being promoted from A-Lansing on July 3rd, Brock Lundquist has hit .524 in a Dunedin uniform, going 11-21 in 7 games.

Castillo Crushing It

- ♦ IF Ivan Castillo has multiple hits in 8 of his last 11 games. Over his last 10, he's hit .424 (14-33). After hitting a strong .282 in the first half, he's been on a tear (.350/.381/.533) in the second half.
- ♦ The FSL announced this morning that Castillo has been named Player of the Week for July 2-8, the second straight week a Blue Jays has been honored (Kevin Smith).

Improved Defense

- ♦ After committing the most errors in the league in both April and May (55 in 51 games), the Blue Jays were tied for the fewest errors committed in the FSL in June (14).

Emerging Power

- ♦ Dunedin averaged 5.1 runs per game in June, up from 3.8 per game in May, thanks to an uptick in power. The Blue Jays hit more HR (17) in June than they did in April (10) and May (6) combined. Dunedin hit .275 as a team in June, up from .243 in May and .253 in April.
- ♦ The Blue Jays are hitting .294 so far in July, the best team average in the league. Dunedin has more HR (9) in 10 July games than they did in the month of May (6).

Palacios In The Clutch

- ♦ The bigger the situation, the better Josh Palacios has been this season. Hitting just .237 with the bases empty, Palacios has hit .333 with runners on (123 at-bats). More impressively, Palacios is hitting .354 with runners in scoring position (79 ABs) and .382 with runners in scoring position and two outs (34 ABs).

Hitters Going Fishing

- ♦ Since May 1st, Jake Fishman has posted a 0.73 ERA in 19 appearances for the D-Jays, striking out 30 in 24.2 IP and allowing just 2 earned runs.

Clutch Catchers

- ♦ Riley Adams and Alberto Mineo have combined to hit .302 with runners on (46/152), .319 with runners in scoring position (29/91), and .342 with RISP/2O (13-38).

- ✦ Since his selection in the draft, has had Tommy John surgery, thoracic outlet syndrome surgery, and a nerve moved in his right elbow, limiting him to just 44 appearances in the 5 seasons since the 2013 draft.

Versus Left: .310 AVG Versus Right: .167 AVG

- Sidearm was a 36th round pick from Davenport University (NAIA, MI) where he had walked on before setting school records for strikeouts (224), saves (34), appearances (126) and opposing batting average (.224) while going 18-8 with a 2.44 ERA.
- Split the 2017 season between the GCL and R-Bluefield, posting a 1.48 ERA in 24.1 IP while striking out 31 batters.
- Made 13 appearances in the first half, throwing 21.1 innings, going 4-0 with a 2.95 ERA.

Claudio CUSTODIO, RHP, #16

2018: A+, 1-0, 1 G, 2.0 IP, 1 H, 0 ER, 0 BB, 2 K, 0.00 ERA, 0.50 WHIP

- A former top prospect as a Yankees infielder, reached as high as #14 on their Top 30 prospects list. Hit .244 in his minor league career as a position player.
- Converted to the mound in 2015, pitching in the Yankees system in 2015 and 2016. Became a free agent in 2017 and pitched for the Barrie Baycats in the Intercountry Baseball League (Canada) where he was spotted by a Blue Jays intern working as a broadcaster in the league.
- Posted a 2.66 ERA in 13 appearances for A-Lansing in 2018, earning a promotion to Dunedin.

- Made 12 appearances with Dunedin in 2017, throwing 19.1 innings and pitching to a 5.12 ERA. Struggled with control with the DJays, walking 18 in his 19.1 innings.
- Went 2-2 with a 4.33 ERA in the first half, making 19 appearances (including 2 starts) and throwing 27.0 innings.

- In a statistical oddity, struck out 7 batters over 2.0 innings with Lansing on 8/26/17 thanks to a dropped third strike, K'ing 4 in the 8th inning and 3 more in the 9th.
- Put up a 2.45 ERA in the first half, allowing just one earned run from May 1st through the end of the half. Made 21 total appearances and threw 29.1 IP.

- Made 4 appearances for Dunedin in 2017, throwing 7.1 innings and not allowing a hit, picking up his 1st FSL win on 8/29 vs. the Fire Frogs with 2.2 shutout innings of relief.
- In 32 appearances for A-Lansing in 2017, pitched to a 3.29 ERA, striking out 37 in 38.1 IP.

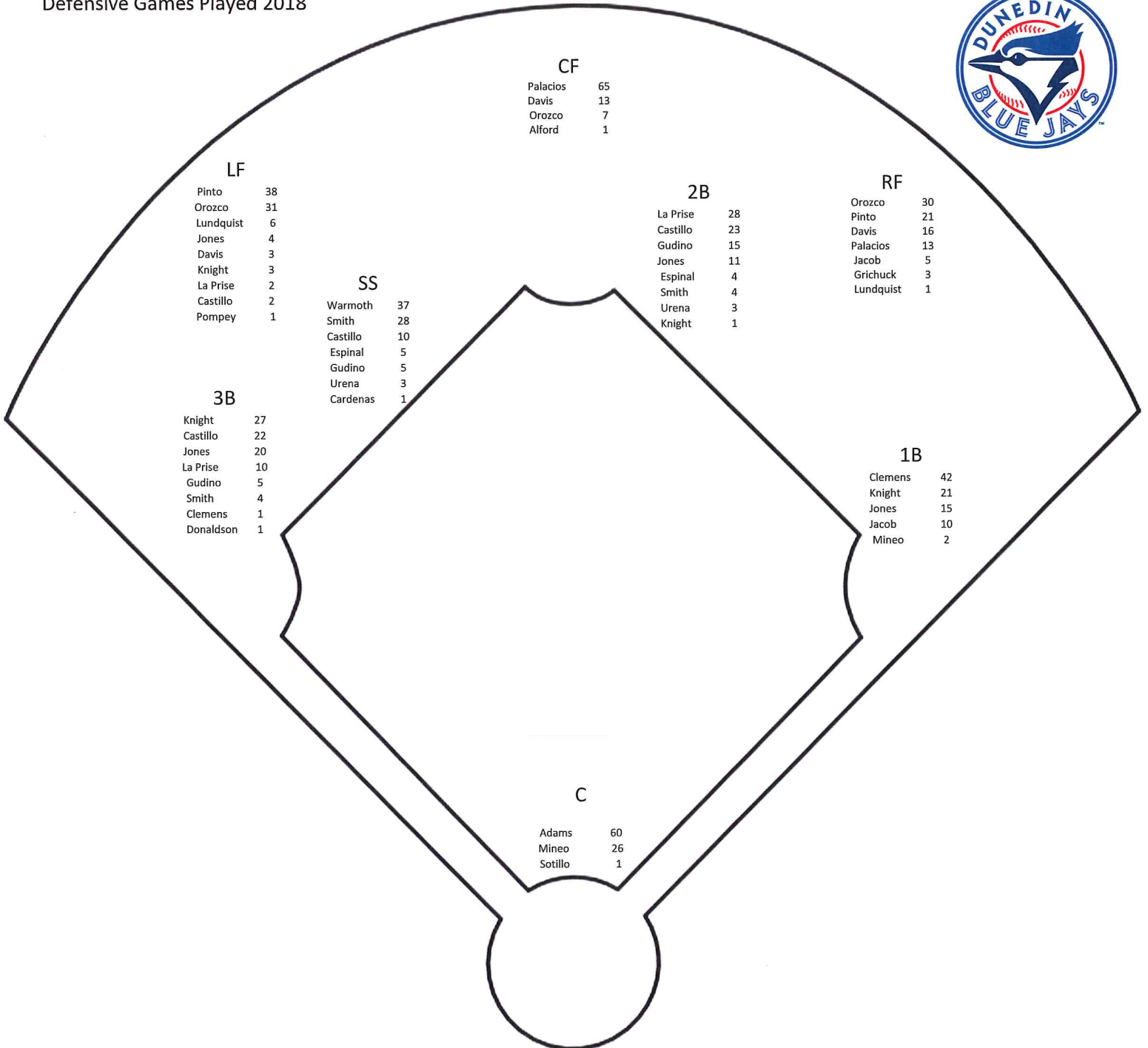
