## TRIBE TIPS

**THE INDIANS...** Held on to defeat Columbus, 5-4, snapping a three-game skid against the Clippers ... Now sit 5.0 games behind Columbus ... Enter their 114th season of continuous operation this year since the current franchise was established in 1902 ... The team traces its roots back to 1887, making it 126 years of professional baseball in the Circle City.

**MEET THE NEW GUY:** Drew Hutchison is making his Pirates/Indianapolis debut after beginning the 2016 campaign with Buffalo ... The right-hander has made three MLB appearances this season (2 GS), recording a 4.97 ERA ... His presence adds to an already strong Indianapolis rotation that has impressed all season long.

**OUTFIELD ARMS:** Willy Garcia picked up his IL-leading 13th outfield assist in yesterday's game ... He has 50 OFAs since the start of the 2014 season - most in MiLB ... Josh Bell added an OFA of his own, his first since 7/27/14 with Double-A Altoona.

**GIFT GOES YARD:** Gift Ngoepe's homer in yesterday's game was just his second hit in his last 10 contests ... Both of those hits have been home runs ... While his six bombs are three shy of his career high (9), his 17 doubles this season match his career best total and check in tied for third on the team.

**BACK-TO-BACK:** Danny Ortiz and Gift Ngoepe homered back-to-back with two outs in the second inning of yesterday's game ... It was the first pair of consecutive blasts for the Tribe since 4/26 (Garcia/Florimon) ... The twin shots were the third instance for Indy this season, with Josh Bell and Jason Rogers belting consecutive home runs on 4/20.

**CLIPPING THE LEAD:** With 33 games remaining in the season including today, Indy finds itself 5.0 games out of first place in the West behind Columbus ... Tribe is currently 11.5 games back of the Wild Card ... Five games remain against Columbus.

**MEADOWS MAKES HIS WAY:** Top outfield prospect Austin Meadows is in the midst of a rehab stint with Short-A West Virginia ... Started in center field for three games with the Black Bears, going 2-for-10 with a double entering today.

**THE BIG DEBUT:** Max Moroff appeared in last Sunday's game with the Pirates for his MLB debut ... He is the 10th player to come through Indianapolis to make his big league debut this season ... The Tribe is one shy of matching its highest season debut total (11) since starting the Pirates affiliation in 2005 ... 10 pre-September debuts are most for the Bucs since 1995.

Was acquired from Buffalo as part of the deadline deal which sent Francisco Liriano, Reese McGuire, and Harold Ramirez to Toronto ... Hutchison won a career-high 13 games with the Blue Jays in 2015 ... Made a career-high 32 starts with 184.2 innings in Toronto the year before ... Made his MLB debut in 2012 while only 21 years old ... Has appeared in 76 career big league games ... Has never faced Indianapolis in his 24 IL outings ... Has tallied a quality start in six of his last seven outings with the Bisons ... Fourth in the IL in strikeouts and opponent average ... Originally selected by Toronto in the 15th Rd of the 2009 FYPD.
