Tonight: The Lugnuts play the rubber match of a three-game series at the Dayton Dragons, sending right-hander **Troy Watson**, followed by piggyback tandem-mate **Josh Hiatt**, against Dragons right-hander **Jhon De Jesus**. The Lugnuts have won of three of the five meetings with Dayton this year, splitting the first two games of this series. Lansing has not won consecutive games on the road since April 16-17 in West Michigan.

Yesterday: Lugnuts 3, Dragons 1. RF **Griffin Conine** broke a scoreless tie in the sixth inning with an RBI single in his MWL debut, 1B **Jake Brodt** followed with a two-run homer, and **Josh Winckowski** fired seven scoreless innings with eight strikeouts to lift the Nuts to a Wednesday night win. The game was completed in two hours and 18 minutes.

Headlines:

WINckowski: P **Josh Winckowski** tossed his team-leading sixth quality start last night, blanking Dayton over seven frames. The 20-year-old right-hander, the youngest pitcher on the team, is now tied for 2nd in the Midwest League in victories (5), ranks 2nd in innings pitched (55 2/3), 4th in ERA (2.10), and leads the league in batters faced (230). Last year, Winckowski was named the Northwest League Pitcher of the Year.

Baseball Legacies: OF **Griffin Conine** joined the Lugnuts yesterday, delivering an RBI single in his third at-bat. Griffin is the son of 17-year Major Leaguer Jeff Conine, who was named to two All-Star teams and won the 1997 and 2003 World Series with the Florida Marlins. He is the latest second-generation player in the Blue Jays' system, joining the sons of Vladimir Guerrero, Craig Biggio, Dante Bichette and Roger Clemens. Conine is a top prospect in his own right, drafted 52nd overall in 2018 out of Duke and ranked the Blue Jays' No. 16 prospect in the organization.

Thieves in the Night: The Lugnuts lead the Midwest League with 72 steals, third-most in Minor League Baseball and 20 more steals than the MLB-leading Kansas City Royals. The Lugnuts led all of MLB/MiLB last year with 203 stolen bases.

Home Cooking: At Cooley Law School Stadium, the Lugnuts are slashing .278/.359/.435 with 53 doubles, 16 triples and 22 home runs in 29 games at home, averaging 5.7 runs, and are +4 in run differential. On the road, however, the club is hitting .218/.299/.306 with 31 doubles, four triples and eight homers in 22 games, averaging 2.9 runs, and are -29 in run differential.

In his professional debut last year in Bluefield, Rees had a 5.06 ERA between the GCL and Appalachian League.
- 20** Consecutive games that UT **Otto Lopez** has reached base, thanks to drawing a first-inning walk, the second-longest on-base streak on the Lugnuts this year behind **Nick Podkul**'s 24-game streak. During Lopez's streak, beginning on May 5th, he's batting .325/.386/.400.
- 21** Stolen bases for OF **Reggie Pruitt**, leading the Midwest League. Pruitt, who stole 37 bases for the Lugnuts last year, has had two separate three-steal games. The Kennesaw, Ga., native also leads the Midwest League with five triples.

Big Picture: Added to the roster May 20th from Extended Spring Training... one of 13 players on the Lugnuts' active roster drafted in 2018... joins fellow Texans Sean Wymer, Jordan Groshans and Joey Pulido... fellow pitcher Mike Pascoe, though a New Yorker, attended college in Texas (San Jacinto)... one of 15 2018 Bluefield Blue Jays... Twitter: @2_troywatson.

Back Home: Gunter is located in northern Texas, 37 miles to the northeast from the University of North Texas and about 35 miles from the Oklahoma border... it was founded in 1902, with a population of 1,498 in the 2010 census.

Glory Days: Watson attended Gunter High School (the "Tigers"), where he played basketball (averaging 18.6 ppg), football and baseball... as a senior, he was named all-state as an infielder, batting .300 with nine doubles, 21 RBIs and 10 stolen bases; on the mound, he was even more noticeable: 7-0, 0.25, 56 2/3 innings, 107 strikeouts.

Bear Bound: Troy signed a national letter of intent to the University of Northern Colorado (the "Bears," located in Greeley, CO) in November 2015... as a freshman: 16 games, 8 starts, 4.99 ERA, 52 1/3 innings, 39 strikeouts / 33 walks... his sophomore season was injury-riddled: 7 games, 5 starts, 2.91, 34 innings, 24 strikeouts / 9 walks.

Draft Day: When Watson was selected by the Blue Jays in the 15th round in 2018, signing for \$100,000, he became the first UNC Bear to be drafted since Jensen Park in 2015 (32nd round, Colorado) and only the ninth UNC player drafted in the 21st century... only one drafted Bear has made the Majors, Mike Trujillo, who pitched from 1985-1989 with the Red Sox, Mariners and Tigers... nine UNC Bears have made it to MLB in total, none of them household names, with Trujillo the most recent.

Fried Pickle: "It's a very exciting moment for me right now," Watson told KXII after getting drafted. "My dad and I have been working on this ever sense I could pick up a baseball. I remember telling him when I was younger, that I'm going to be on TV one day. I never thought I would actually get to this point. But I'm here, and ready to get to work.... [His advisor] called me while I was in the middle of eating a fried pickle, and he's like, 'you're being taken by the Blue Jays right now!' And I was like, 'wait, what?!' My dad was watching the draft board and he goes, 'TROY WATSON!' He teared up a little bit. It kind of made me tear up because I mean, we made it. It all just happened so fast but excited."

Pro Debut: Watson made his pro debut with the Bluefield Blue Jays in their second game of the year, 6/20/18, allowing a run in the sixth inning to Johnson City in a 2-0 loss... current Lugnuts who played for Bluefield that day: LF Hunter Steinmetz, RF D.J. Neal, 3B Johnny Aiello, SS Luis De Los Santos, DH Hagen Danner and fellow relievers Cre Finrock and Fitz Stadler... his first pro start came next, 6/24 at Burlington, and it was better: three perfect innings with five strikeouts... he allowed two runs at most in one appearance (8/7 vs. Greeneville, a career high five innings), allowed one run in three other appearances, and pitched shutout ball in the five remaining outings... the league batted just .138 against him, including a .123 batting average (7-for-57) by right-handed batters.

Visit to the Mound: From an interview in the Charlotte Observer, Josh "has pitched since he was 10, or about two years after his father, Earl, returned home from work one day and asked his son if he wanted to throw and catch. 'I fell in love with it instantly,' Hiatt said. At 10, Hiatt began working with Alan Mills, a former Charlotte 49ers pitcher and Boston Red Sox draft pick."

Glory Days: He starred at Providence High School, where he was named All-Star and a Louisville Slugger 1st Team All-American and was ranked the No. 5 pitcher and No. 17 overall player in North Carolina... he batted .474 with four home runs and nine doubles during his senior year, playing shortstop when he wasn't pitching... remembers a streak of "12 or 13 at-bats" consecutively reaching base... "spectacular" inside-the-park home run in a seven-run sixth inning in Game 3 of the 2015 state championship series, as Providence beat Millbrook, 10-2, to win its first title since 1995.

Heel Turn: Grew up a Tar Heels fan, specifically basketball... redshirted his first year with UNC, spending the summer in the Coastal Plain League: 4.35 ERA, 41 1/3 innings, 39 K / 25 walks... as a redshirt freshman in 2017, he excelled, leading the Heels with 32 appearances and earning a nod as a 1st Team Baseball America and NCBWA All-American as UNC's closer: 13 saves, 1.90 ERA, 0.98 WHIP, 52 innings, 64 K / 20 walks... for his efforts, he was named UNC's co-most valuable pitcher with J.B. Bukauskas... pitched in the Cape Cod League that summer: 2.74 ERA, 0.91 WHIP, 23 innings, 26 K / 10 walks... drafted following his redshirt sophomore year: 3.73 ERA, 1.28 WHIP, 50 2/3 innings, 52 K / 19 walks.

Draft Day: Taken in the 16th round in 2018, Hiatt signed for \$50,000 with Toronto.

Good Company: Josh Hiatt was one of 10 Tar Heels drafted last year, topped by Yankees sixth-rounder Rodney Hutchison. A year earlier, in 2017, three UNC players were taken in the 1st round: J.B. Bukauskas (Houston, 15th), Logan Warmoth (Toronto, 22nd), and Brian Miller (Miami, 36th). Other former Tar Heels include current Jays starter Trent Thornton, Matt Harvey, Colin Moran, Kyle Seager, Andrew Miller, and former Whitecap Luke Putkonen.

2019 - Midwest League: This is Hiatt's first professional season, after an injury caused him to miss 2018 in the minors, debuting as part of a piggyback tandem with right-hander Juan De Paula... in his first minor league appearance, Hiatt pitched 3 2/3 innings in relief 4/6 vs. Fort Wayne, allowing five runs, including a three-run homer by Luis Almanzar; Hiatt was given a no-decision in the Lugnuts' 8-4 loss to the TinCaps... he made his first professional start, 4/11 vs. West Michigan, allowing three runs in four innings in suffering the loss... earned first save, 4/17 at West Michigan, with four innings of relief following up Juan De Paula's five innings of one-run ball in an 8-2 victory over the Whitecaps... notched first professional victory with career high eight strikeouts, 5/25 vs. Lake County, allowing only a solo home run to Hosea Nelson... as a reliever: 2.37, 5 games, 19 IP, 15 K / 6 walks, .216, 2.31 GO/AO... as a starter: 3.60, 5 games, 20 IP, 21 K / 11 walks, .250, 1.13 GO/AO.
