RALLY STOPS SHORT: The Travelers withstood a late Corpus Christi surge Sunday to secure the series opener with a 7-5 victory at Dickey Stephens Park. Trailing 7-0, the Hooks worked a pair of bases-loaded walks from Spencer Herrmann to begin the ninth inning. Consecutive RBI singles by Yuli Gurriel, Jordan Alvarez, and Randy Cesar. Nick Tanielu, facing Matt Walker, ripped a double into the left-field gap to plate two, making it a two-run game. Walker responded by retiring the next three hitters to record the save.

Johendi Jiminian, making his debut as a Seattle farmhand, retired 18 of the 20 men he faced. Jiminian struck out five a permitted one hit, a Gurriel two-out double in the fourth. Corpus Christi managed just two knocks prior to its uprising in the ninth. The Travs used a 12-hit attack against Akeem Bostick (3.2 IP), Kevin Hill (1.1 IP), and Ralph Garza (3.0 IP). This production includes six doubles notched from the fourth through the sixth.

YULI ON REHAB: Astros 1B Yuli Gurriel is 6-for-12 with 2 doubles, 3 RBIs and 3 runs scored in 3 rehab games with Corpus Christi. Gurriel, who underwent surgery Feb. 28 to remove the hook of the hamate bone in his left hand, is playing 3rd base and batting 3rd this evening.

Gurriel finished fourth in American League Rookie of the Year voting last year, hitting .299 with 43 doubles, 18 home runs, and 75 RBIs in 139 games for the defending World Series champion Houston Astros. The 33-year-old right-handed batter set franchise rookie records for doubles, total bases (257), extra-base hits (62) and slugging percentage (.485). His 43 doubles were the most by an AL rookie since Nomar Garciaparra hit 44 in 1997.

Gurriel hit .529 during the ALDS vs. Boston, and notched three-run bases-loaded double in Game 4 of the ALCS at New York. He belted two home runs during the Fall Classic vs. Los Angeles, including a game-tying, three-run shot off LHP Clayton Kershaw in Game 5 of the World Series. Gurriel is one of 10 former Hooks who were included on the Astros' World Series roster.

LATE MAGIC: Yesterday, the Hooks were 2 runs shy of completing another improbable 9th-inning comeback. Corpus Christi scored 6 times in the final frame Friday night at NW Arkansas, turning a 9-5 deficit into an 11-9 victory. Through the first 4 games, the Hooks have outscored their opposition 12-1 in the 9th inning.

IN THE CLUTCH: The Hooks have made the most of their offensive opportunities to start the season, leading the Texas League with a .302 batting average with men in scoring position. Corpus Christi also owns the circuit's top on-base percentage at .390, and have drawn the 2nd-most walks (21).

RACKIN' UP THE MILES: OF Myles Straw worked 2 more free passes yesterday, giving him a Texas League best 8 walks on the season. Straw boasts a .667 OBP, which is tied for 2nd in the circuit. He is 5-for-12 (.417) at the plate with 5 runs scored. The speedy centerfielder is the only Texas Leaguer with more than 2 steals. Straw has 5 thefts in as many attempts.

DINGER DROUGHT: Corpus Christi is the only Texas League club without a home run in 2018. This 4-game homer drought is the longest by a Hooks team to start the season. The 2017, 2014, and 2008 clubs didn't hit their first long ball until Game 3. Tulsa leads the circuit with 7 dingers. Braden Bishop has hit the only Travs home run in 2018.
