BATS STRUGGLE IN SAN ANTONIO: The Hooks dropped their second straight at Wolff Stadium on Sunday afternoon, falling 4-1. Hooks starter Ryan Hartman allowed a run in the first inning. The lefty hit Fernando Tatis, Jr. to begin the game and Tatis would eventually score on a ground ball double play. The Missions made it a 2-0 advantage in the third on Auston Bousfield's RBI double. San Antonio righty Jesse Scholtens tossed six scoreless frames before allowing a run on Josh Rojas' sac fly to put the Hooks on the board in the seventh.

Brock Dykxhoorn replaced Hartman and spun scoreless frames in the sixth and seventh. In the eighth, Dykxhoorn allowed a double Kyle Overstreet and a walk to Michael Gettys to put a pair on the bases. Peter Van Gansen hit a shallow pop up into left field that dropped between Randy Cesar and Yordan Alvarez as the two collided. A run came into score to extend San Antonio's lead to 3-1. Cesar stayed in the game while Alvarez came out. Alvarez walked to the Hooks dugout under his own power. After the Missions tacked on another run, Brad Wieck tossed a scoreless eighth while Jose Castillo fired a scoreless ninth for his third save.

WHERE DID THE BATS GO?: After scoring 8 runs in San Antonio on Saturday, the Hooks were held to just a single tally on Sunday afternoon. It was the third game this season that Corpus Christi was held to only 1 run.

ON THE OFFENSIVE: Despite yesterday's performance, the Hooks still maintain the best Texas League offensive stats in a number of different categories: team batting average (.288), runs scored (172), triples (11), walks (113), and on-base percentage (.364).

STAY AWAY FROM THREE: The Hooks have now dropped back-to-back games on 4 occasions so far this season, including the last 2 games in San Antonio. Corpus Christi has only lost 3 in a row once, coming on April 8-10 at Arkansas.

CAN'T STOP THE BROCK: Corpus Christi's pitching staff has a combined 3.84 ERA, which ranks 2nd among Texas League ranks. A big reason for that success has been the early season performance of veteran RHP Brock Dykxhoorn, who allowed 2 ER in 3 innings on Sunday in San Antonio. Dykxhoorn is now 2-0 with a 1.71 ERA in 26.1 IP. He ranks 2nd among Texas League arms in ERA.

YA GOTTA HAVE HART: Left-hander Ryan Hartman also was solid on Sunday at Wolff Stadium, tossing 5 innings while giving up just 2 ER. Hartman is now 1-1 with a 2.19 ERA in 24.2 IP. His ERA ranks 5th-best in the Texas League.

JAMES GOES WEST: RHP Josh James was promoted to AAA Fresno prior to Sunday's contest. James posted a 2.49 ERA in 21.1 IP with the Hooks. James earned Texas League Midseason All-Star honors in 2017, going 4-8 with a 4.38 ERA in 21 games (11 GS) with Corpus Christi.

In a corresponding move, RHP Riley Ferrell was activated from the disabled list. Ferrell last appeared for the Hooks on April 19. Prior to the injury, he was 1-1 with a 1.59 ERA in 6 appearances (5.2 IP).

RUN, RUN, RUN: Corpus Christi continues to lead the Texas League with 42 stolen bases. The Hooks have the top-2 stolen base leaders in the circuit with Myles Straw (15) and Stephen Wrenn (8).

DROPPIN' DIMES: Myles Straw has recorded 3 outfield assists in the last 3 games. The Bradenton, FL native now leads the Texas League with 7 outfield assists and is on pace to shatter the franchise's single-season record for outfield assists. Ramon Leaureano (2017) and Jon Gaston (2010) are tied for the single-season record with 16 outfield assists.

BULLPEN OVERLOAD: Corpus Christi's bullpen has chewed up 23.2 IP over the last 3 games.

TOO MANY WALKS: While Hooks pitching has posted a 3.84 ERA as a staff, the group leads the Texas League with 131 walks issued in 29 games.

THE JONES SHOW: Despite going 0-3 on Sunday, 1B Taylor Jones continues to lead the Texas League in batting average at .386. He has 11 hits in his last 23 at-bats. He went 8-for-15 with a home run and 4 RBIs in the 4-game series at Midland. He also paces the circuit with a .486 OBP and a .682 slugging percentage. The Gonzaga product continues to mash on the road, hitting .491 with 8 doubles, 4 home runs, 17 RBIs, and a 1.424 OPS.

NEW GUY UP THE MIDDLE: IF Josh Rojas joined the Hooks last week from High-A Buiies Creek. He's 5-for-16 with 1 double, 1 triple and 3 RBIs in 4 games to begin his Hooks tenure. Rojasbatted .311 with 20 runs, 11 doubles, 2 triples, 1 home run, and 10 RBIs in 24 games for Buiies Creek to start the season. The Arizona native worked 15 walks against 13 strikeouts in A-ball. Rojas also swiped 12 bags without being caught for the BC Astros. The 23-year-old was taken last year in the 26th round out of the University of Hawaii. Rojas played in 52 games for Quad Cities after being drafted, and closed out his first pro campaign by going 4-for-12 in the Pacific Coast League with Fresno.
